BNP activists held with bomb-making materials

Over 200 sued for violence

Police arrested five BNP men and seized bomb making materials from their possession in Kalibazar Bus Stand area of Muktagachha upazila town Saturday night.

The arrestees were identified as Abdur Razzaq, 55, secretary of Ghoga union BNP unit in Muktagachha; Tuta Miah, 47, and Shakawat Hossain, 42, both ward secretaries of the union while union BNP unit members-Nurul Islam, 45, and Moshiur

Rahman, 42. On information, police raided Kalibazar Bus Stand area around 11:30pm Saturday and arrested the five along with the materials from the spot, said Mir Rakibul Haque, officer incharge of Muktagachha police station.

The arrestees confessed that they collected the materials to make bombs to use them during the coming 60hour hartal, police said, adding that five other culprits fled the scene.

A case was lodged and the arrestees were produced before a court in Mymensingh yesterday noon. The courts sent them to jail.

Away in Habiganj, police yesterday sued over 200 people of Jatiyatabadi Jubo Dal and JCD on charge of vandalism and blasting explosives in the district town on Thursday last, reports our staff correspondent in Sylhet.


