SYMPHONY XPLORER Z II POWERPLAYER OR NOT?

Let's start with the good things first. It has a bright super AMOLED screen with 306ppi. The gorilla glass gives it a smooth, cool and tactile feel. It's light and at 10mm it is thin enough so it can be easily carried in the pocket. Although the 4.8 inch screen surrounded by a thick bezel means it is not for totally one handed operation.

1Gig RAM is contemporary enough but not so for something marketed as a flagship. Everybody else has moved to 2GB. But for now, it suffices. The Quad core Cortex A7 1.2 GHz coupled with the mid range GPU is fast enough for most games out there. Asphalt 6 ? Runs smooth as Vin Diesels head.

The speaker is louder than the average ones. The 2200mAh battery will last the entire day on average use. As for connectivity, it is 3G enabled with simple tethering software and bandwidth control. It comes with Android JB 4.2.1 out of the box and is upgradeable to 4.2.2 now.

Camera app is full of features. It has 1080p video recording and a 5MP front

camera for better 'selfies'. The rear sports a 13MP camera with auto focus, geo-tagging etc.

Now comes the bad part. Megapixels don't make a great camera unless the sensor is updated. In case of Z2, the camera takes very good pictures in bright daylight. As light conditions deteriorate, so does picture quality. So does the auto-focus . So if you plan to take pictures after dusk, forget about it.

Volume buttons are hard to get at but that's just a personal quibble. The launcher is terrible and great at the same time. If you love iPhone, you'll love this. Otherwise, you'll hate the same old look. The auto brightness feature is supposed to help save battery life but it simply doesn't work; the screen only flickers. The frame rate is surprisingly low for a quad core unit. Benchmark tests show about 40fps whereas it's expected to give at least 50fps. So far Symphony has not provided any firmware update which might have fixed this issue. Maybe they should take a page from similarly spec-ed Walton phones and provide more regular updates so that

Symphony sets don't feel outdated a few months into the purchase.

The phone comes overloaded with bloatware and apps. Factory reset doesn't remove installed apps. Aside from the camera issues, this is a great performing phone. In my opinion, this phone would be better if it came with vanilla android, meaning the version they release for Nexus devices. We contacted Symphony about rooting the device and they removed our question from their website which leads me to believe they have no expertise to deal with such tasks.

It is common practice to install custom ROM on android devices but it doesn't look like the Symphony phone will allow it. But I have found a way to root it and remove all the bloat ware. Step A. Turn on, connect to WiFi or the newly available 3G.

Step B. Enter Gmail info and register device with Google.

Step C. Let the already installed apps update.

Step 1. Install any other launcher (nova, go, sicknessy, aviate) from play store.

Step 2. Disable as many of the thousand of apps already installed, as you can (the non system ones)

Step 3. Uninstall the half games and get what you want.

Step 4, choose a black wallpaper (requires less battery)

Step 5. Brightness should be at the lowest.

Step 6. Copy some music and videos to it or don't.

Step 7. Reboot phone and I think you're good to go

SAY HELLO TO THE OCULUS RIFT

Oculus Rift. The name sounds surreal. The experience it provides is just that. The Oculus Rift is a Kickstarter success story, when funding seemed inadequate; they raised \$2.4 Million via crowdfunding. With everything almost complete and development kits already shipping out, expect it in the market sometime in 2014.

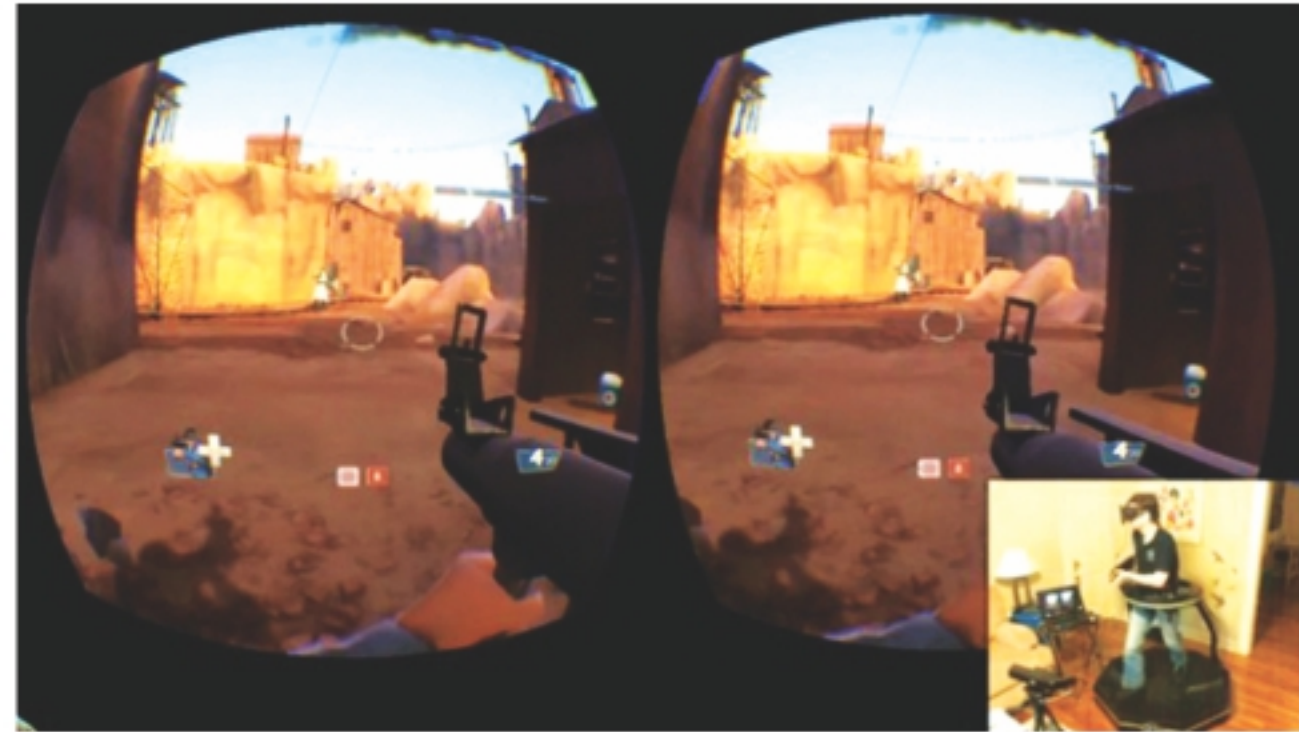


So what is the Oculus Rift? It's a head mounted display, which does things we imagined as children. Imagine you're playing Project Cars, the best looking car game if screenshots are to be believed. You're sitting there in a first person view, looking at your steering wheel and dash. Still, something isn't quite right. You're constricted to a single monitor. Maybe 3 if you're lucky. The environment is amazingly detailed, but the experience is lacking.

Even if you've got a Racing kit: Steering wheel, gear box, brakes, the works. You're still staring at a screen. Now imagine that you're wearing the Oculus Rift. It eliminates the need for a monitor. The screen is in front of your eyes. You are in the drivers seat. It's going to be annoying to look

around, with gears and a steering on your hands, how do you look around? It's not real enough, right?

Wrong. The Oculus Rift has a head tracker. You look right, your perspective shifts to the right. You look up, your screen moves up. It's the ultimate set up. It's puts you in that seat, it lets you look around. This works well with FPS games too.



Online multiplayer, you don't have time to look and aim. So just look around with your head, like you would in real life. It's real, but a virtual reality. So if you're playing Battlefield online, just put on your Rift and fire away.

The Oculus Rift, with the potential that it has, can turn the gaming world on its head. As of now, it's only available for PC's but we should expect that to change. In the meantime you can just grab a regular head tracker for around \$300. Or you can wait and see if the Oculus Rift delivers what it promises, and if it does, be ready to get sucked into games in a way you could only imagine before.

Rumble the RED PHONE

If you are a follower of the politics of this great nation of ours, you surely have heard about the RED PHONE. If not, then I would request you to check back the news headlines of the last two weeks to soak in to the context.

Well, coming to the point; Red Phone! Red Phone is a land-lined phone that connects the government's policymaking top brasses via a secured network. But in 1950's Red Phone had a totally different meaning. In fact, the term 'Red Phone' derived from the cold war era when Washington and Moscow had a secured Teletype Link. Many citations often misinterpret the term by saying Red Phone was an actual 'PHONE' that made direct connection between Washington and Moscow. In actuality, any US presidents' calling any head of the state is a direct call itself. You might be wondering then why 'Red Phone'? The significance of Red Phone is, it was the most secured type of communication with the then USSR. To even make sure more protection, Red Phone was always kept disconnected when the US president was away from the Oval Office. Adding to that, 'Red Phone' handset's where not even of red color. Commissioner Gordon contacted Batman via the red BATPHONE.

In Bangladesh, all the Red Phones are connect via a Red Exchange. Red Exchange is the special exchange dedicated for all Red Phones connected in the network. It is situated in the Sher-E-Bangla Nagar Zone and all the technical support to keep this phone up and running is provided by BTCL. But the main switching station is situated in the Prime Minister's Office (PMO). To reach out other parts of the capital, there are some remote connections with other important Exchanges as well. The entire Red Exchange was updated few of years back. Most of the copper wires where replaced with optical fiber to ensure voice clarity and security. Moreover the connection capacity of the Red Exchange was increased from 500 to more than 1500 lines. Also, now most of the connections come with secured broadband now. Since the Red Phone and Red

Exchange carries high volume of sensitive traffic, thus it requires special kind of security. It is the duty of Forces Signal Intelligence Bureau [a department of Directorate General of Forces Intelligence (DGFI)] to keep these connections secure from prying ears.

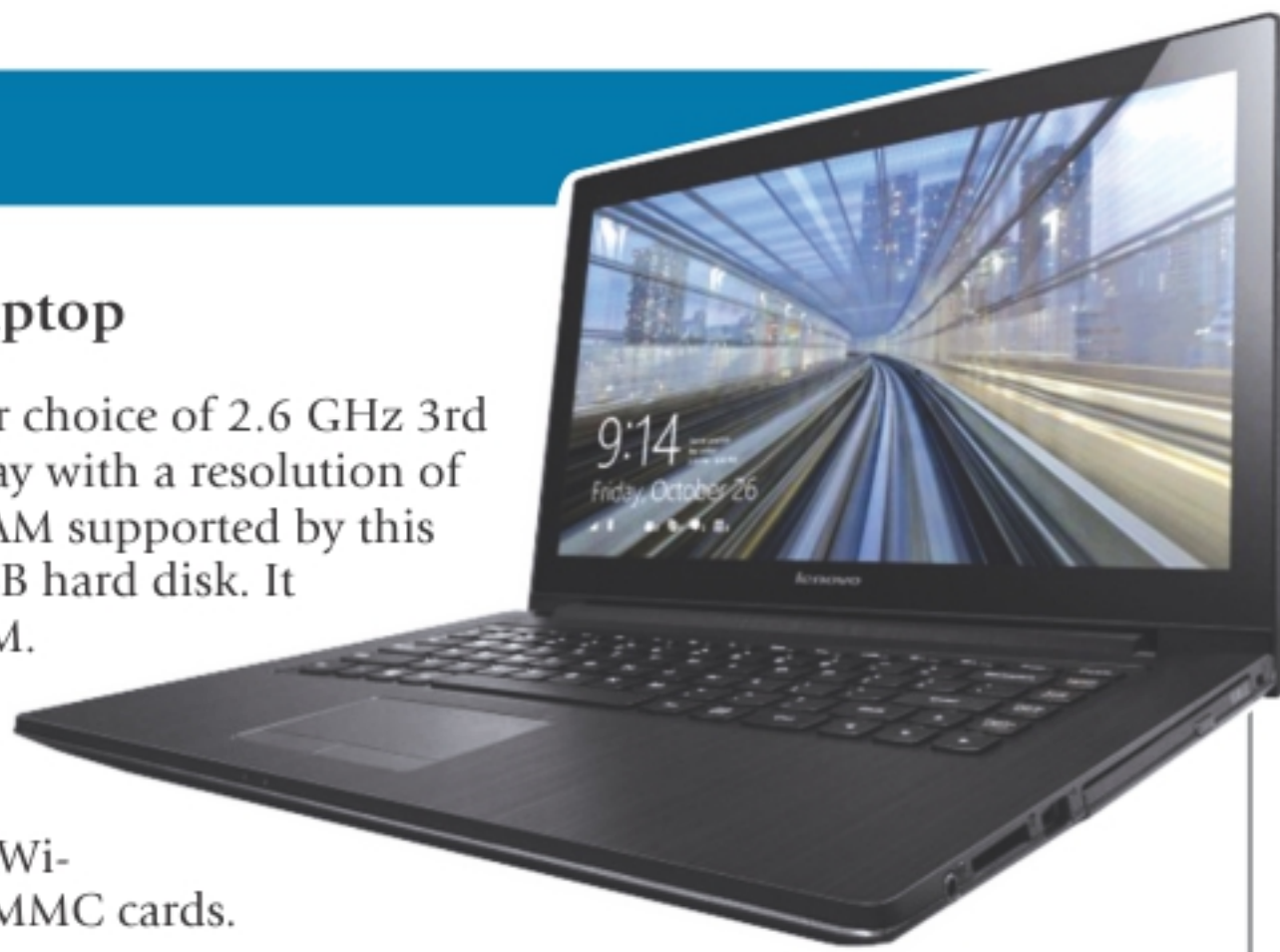
