The trial court is preparing to send the list of condemned to the High Court as soon as possible, said a court official. The trial court will send records and a copy of the verdict to the High Court in a week to decide on the next course of action. In the historic judgement, the court also sentenced 161

others, including ex-BNP lawmaker Nasiruddin Ahmed Pintu and ward-level Awami League leader Torab Ali, to life imprisonment. The court also handed down rigorous imprisonment, ranging from three to 10 years, to another 256 people, mostly BDR jawans, in the BDR carnage case filed following the February 25-26 bloody mutiny that killed 74 people including 57 army officers.

Born in Gohira village of Chittagong's Raozan, Mahbubul started writing in his early life and joined the Quit India Movement at the age of 15.

He participated in most of the political and cultural movements until the Liberation War and continued his struggle for people's freedom throughout his life. In recognition he was posthumously awarded the "Ekushey Padak" in 2009. Mahbubul passed away in Dhaka on December 23, 2007.

It's making a smokescreen over the poll," said the BNP spokesperson. Earlier in the same venue, he said the BNP would remain hopeful about dialogue over an election-time government till the last moment. "The BNP believes in transfer of power through elections. But the whole process is uncertain now." Fakhru strongly criticised the prime minister and the state minister for law for their allegations that the BNP had

involvement in the February 2009 Pilkhana carnage. "In a planned manner, the prime minister blamed the BNP for the mutiny and then a minister said Pakistani intelligence agency ISI had instigated the carnage and spent money for it," he said. Citing a recent countrywide survey of The Daily Star, which shows 55 percent of the people believe in BNP's win, Fakhru said the study proved that his party was gaining popularity day by day. About the government's initiative to bring BNP Senior Vice Chairman Tarique Rahman back from London, he said such a step was aimed at diverting people's attention.
