

Lalmonirhat rly station now criminals' den

Selling and taking of hemp and phensidyl, mugging, stealing of railway goods and different anti-social activities go on almost openly in Lalmonirhat railway station area.

A few days ago, railway security men Kabir Hossain, 25, and Anwarul Islam, 26, got hospitalised as criminals attacked them after the two prevented their drug taking beside the station platform. Three of the gang members were arrested later.

Locals have alleged indifference of the railway authorities concerned for continued criminal activities in the station area.

"During the night organised criminals roam around the station and commit different crimes but there is hardly any action as law enforcers are often bribed,"

said Saleh Uddin, 55, a resident of the town.

In anonymity, a hemp trader in the station area said, criminal activities occur as railway security personnel can be easily managed.

It is duty of railway police to keep the station area free from criminal activities, said Nizam Uddin, railway stationmaster.

Shamsul Alam Shah, officer in charge of Government Railway Police station at Lalmonirhat, said, "Railway police are trying hard to free the station area from criminal activities. Mobile court drives are conducted regularly for the purpose."

Mohammad Fattah Bhuiyan, commandant of Lalmonirhat Railway Divisional security forces, said, "I have already ordered the railway security personnel not to tolerate any criminals in the station area. Now I will personally see the matter."

'Aloron' paddy helps farmers recoup losses from cyclones

An excellent yield of 'Aloron' paddy during the current aush season in the district so far has come as an upbeat message to the farmers.

In Barguna, where 90 percent farmers could not cultivate aush this season for the onslaught of cyclonic storm 'Mahasen', large scale production of the high-yielding 'Aloron' variety could largely help cover the paddy shortfall.

When the farmers in the coastal belt are yet to get back to normalcy from the losses they suffered during cyclones Sidr and Aila, 'Masasen' dealt them a further blow by damaging huge aush seedbeds this season.

Now the boom in production of 'Aloron' paddy has made the farmers confident that they would be able to recoup the losses largely.

Farmers at Parboti village in Barguna Sadar union said, taking all risks, at least 37 farmers cultivated 'Aloron' collectively on

30.70 acres of land.

They are now reaping 80 to 90 maunds of paddy per acre.

Usually, they do not get more than 30 maunds of paddy per acre from other varieties.

Farmer Mostafa Khan said, usually they cultivated one crop in their land and did not get good production but they are now getting a double yield by cultivating 'Aloron' paddy.

At the initiative of Brac, a programme on agriculture and food security is being implemented simultaneously in 50 upazilas of 12 districts from July 2012.

This programme is now expanding and its activities will reach all the 64 districts by 2015.

In Barguna, 3,160 farmers in 81 villages are cultivating 'Aloron' paddy on 1826.24 acres during the aush season.

Brac's Agriculture and Food Security Programme sources said Tk 9,000 is given to each farmer to cultivate 'Aloron' paddy.

Three shops gutted

At least three shops were gutted in a fire at Patgati Bazar in Tungipara upazila early yesterday. Fire service sources said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at a shop and soon engulfed the adjoining shops. On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after one hour of frantic efforts. The affected shop owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 10 lakh.

'Robber' beaten dead

A 'robber' was killed in a mob beating at Thanarhat in Sonaimuri upazila of the district on Tuesday night.

The deceased was identified as Munna, 35, ring leader of notorious Munna Bahini. He hailed from Laxmipur district.

According to police, a gang of armed robbers were fleeing the area after committing robberies at two jewellery shops at Thanarhat Bazar under Jayag union at around 8:00pm.

As the shop owners raised a hue and cry, locals besieged the robbers and the gang started firing at them.

At one stage, locals caught Munna, one of the robbers, after a hot chase and gave him a good beating, leaving him dead on the spot.

Two locals -- Abdur Rashid and Hawlder -- were injured in the incident.

Four housewives murdered

Four housewives were murdered in Bhola, Comilla and Habiganj districts in the last two days.

A gang of thieves strangled a woman and took away gold ornaments from her house at Boro Lamchi Dholi village in Daulatkhan upazila of Bhola on Tuesday.

The deceased was identified as Noni Bala, 50, wife of Gouranga Majhi of the village, reports our correspondent.

Son of the deceased, Shyamal Majhi, said he found the body lying on the floor after returning from work place at 8:00pm. The gang also broke open an almirah and took away the gold ornaments, he said.

Away in Comilla, a housewife was murdered over a family feud at her in-law's house at Elais village in Laksam upazila on Monday morning.

The deceased is Aysha Begum, 28, wife of Ahsan Habib, a Dubai expatriate, of the village, reports our correspondent.

Abul Kaiher, officer in-charge of Laksam police

station, said after marriage, Habib often tortured Aysa over trivial matter.

On the fateful day, Habib beat her up mercilessly following an altercation. Failing to bear his torture anymore, she committed suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room, said the OC.

In Habiganj, two housewives were killed allegedly by their husbands for dowry in Baniachanj and Nobiganj village in Baniachanj upazila on Monday, reports our Moulvibazar correspondent.

Police and locals said, Shafiqul Alam of Mondori village in Baniachanj upazila often tortured his wife Tulona Akter, 28, for dowry.

Shafiqul beat Tulona up mercilessly, leaving her dead on the spot following an altercation over the issue early Monday.

On the other hand, Tamanna Akter, 20, was beaten to death allegedly by her husband Abu Bakkor of Pitua village in Nobiganj upazila for Tk 50,000 dowry.

Abu Bakkor went into hiding after the incident, said Samsul Islam, officer in-charge of Nobiganj police station.

They catch fish while the farmers suffer

Some local influential people have blocked the flow of Bolai Khal, a stream flowing through the hills, at Banglabazar village in Jaintapur upazila for catching fish, causing immense sufferings to the farmers.

During the dry season, the farmers use water for their vegetable lands from the half-kilometre stream from the Dibir haor area to Sari River, said Abdul Barik of Lakshmipur village.

But, due to the blockade, they are now deprived of the

scope of farming vegetables, he said.

Local BNP activist Abdul Ahad, younger brother of Jaintapur union parishad former chairman Ekhlashur Rahman and upazila AL vice president, was leading the group, alleged locals.

Abdul Ahad said they put up the barricade for facilitating irrigation on 500 bighas of land of the villagers.

Contacted, upazila nirbahi officer Rashedul Islam yesterday said, stern action would be taken against those responsible for the offence after investigating the matter, said the UNO.
