creating the crisis in a planned way, and the latest resignation drama was a part of the plot.

"People have understood that the government is applying various tricks instead of resolving the crisis," he said.

He reiterated the opposition's appeal to the government to sit in a dialogue over the formation of a non-party interim government to hold the next general election in a free and fair way.

"The government is barring us from holding peaceful rallies and processions. Law enforcers have also confined BNP's central office," he alleged.

He, however, hoped that the government would shun the path of oppression, and take initiative to hold a dialogue with the opposition to ensure a participatory election.

"Otherwise, we will realise our demand for holding the next general election under a non-party caretaker government through mass uprising on streets," Fakhrul warned.

PM and her delegation as there is no regular flight of Biman to Colombo. Boeing 737 has a capacity of over 160 passengers.

Diplomatic sources said this year Britain's Prince Charles will represent his mother, the Queen, in the Colombo summit. The 87-year-old queen has missed the biennial summit only once -- when it was first held in 1971.

Canadian Prime Minister Stephen Harper is boycotting the three-day CHOGM, which begins Friday morning, over alleged crimes and rights abuses during and after Sri Lanka's civil war.

While External Affairs

Minister Salman Khurshid will head the Indian delegation at the CHOGM with Prime Minister Manmohan Singh deciding against undertaking the visit in the face of the opposition by parties in Tamil Nadu as well as a section in Congress.

As per the programme schedule, the PM will attend the opening ceremony of CHOGM and take part in other conventional programmes.

On its sidelines, Hasina will meet Sri Lankan President Mahindra Rajapaksa for 15 minutes and New Zealand Prime Minister John Key for 25 minutes on Friday.

# Section 144 imposed in Rajshahi

Local administration imposed section 144 in Shingahat area in Durgapur upazila of Rajshahi as both the ruling Awami League and main opposition BNP called separate programmes at the same venue and same time yesterday.

To avert unwanted situations, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Aktarun Nahar announced the ban at noon yesterday as AL and BNP units of the upazila called for rallies in the area at 3:00pm.

The ban is indefinite and will be removed once the authorities feel the situation is under control, said Saiful Islam, officer-in-charge of Durgapur Police Station.

after seeing the burnt girl and that he could not think of it as himself being the father of a seven-year-old daughter.

"I expect that none will set fire to little kids like Sumi and no such indents [arsons during hartal] will ever occur in the country."

The premier's son promised legal actions against those involved in these heinous acts.

Replying to a question, he said such kind of atrocity had never taken place since the country's Liberation War in 1971. "This is no hartal. This is terrorism."

At the DMCH burn unit, Joy talked to Sumi, Montu Das who sustained 90 percent burns in the capital's Laxmi Bazar on Monday, and few others fighting for life there.

Joy assured some relatives of the victims of taking action against the culprits and donated Tk 20,000 to 30,000 each to several patients including Sumi, her grandmother, and Montu.

Meanwhile, families of some patients said they faced hurdles in meeting

their relatives at the burn unit due to Joy's visit, as law enforcers obstructed them on security grounds.


Hundreds of Bangladesh Chhatra League men of DMCH and Dhaka University welcomed Joy amid tight security.

Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu, Health Minister AFM Ruhul Haque and Prime Minister's Health Adviser Syed Modasser Ali also visited the burns patients and talked to them, pledging better treatment.

Speaking at a press briefing there, Inu said BNP had been involved in the politics of killing through arsons. He urged opposition leader Khaleda Zia to be kind and allow those burns patients to visit hospitals by withdrawing the ongoing hartal.

Call off hartal and sit for dialogue to resolve the political crisis, he said.

Echoing Inu, Ruhul Haque said the opposition had the right to enforce hartal but not to burn people to death. He said the government was providing free treatment to those burnt during hartal.
