

The arrestees are Mozammel Hossain Monju, 40, assistant secretary of ward unit Jamaat of R-Ataikula union, Badsha Malik, 40, of Padmabila village and Johurul Islam, 22, of Masterpara in Bonogram under the upazila.

With the three, police have so far arrested 16 people for their involvement in the attack. Of them, one has already made confessional statement, police said. A group of youths

attacked and looted houses of Hindus in the area after creating sensation by saying that one Rajib Saha Officer-in-Charge Rezaul maligned Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) in a Facebook page.

Rajib, son of Babul Saha, a shop owner at Bonogram bazar, is a class-X student of Bonogram Miapur High School.

The gang set fire to Babul Saha's house and vandalised and looted about 26 houses. Babul was mercilessly hit and kicked upon. At one stage, some locals intervened to save him and confined him to a shop.

On information, over 150 Rab and police personnel arrived at the bazaar. As they brought Babul out of the shop, the mob started throwing brick chips and other objects at them.


