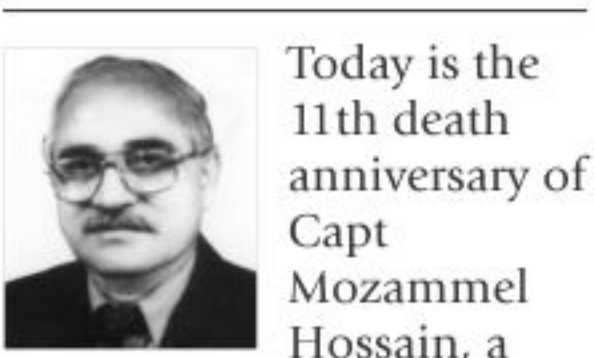

5 cases filed over violence

One of the cases accusing 67 BNP leaders and activists was filed for arson attack on a CNG-run auto-rickshaw that injured two passengers in Chatteshwari intersection, said Sub-Inspector of Chawkbazar Police Station Towhidul Anwar.

Another case filed with Kotwali Police Station accused 73 people, including the BNP-Jamaat leaders, of vandalism and arson attacks in the city. Police arrested 21 people in the case including Golam Akbar Khandakar.

A case accusing about 300 unnamed and 13 named

people was filed with Pahartali Police Station for vandalism and clash with police. Ten people have been arrested.

Another case, accusing 52 named and about 500 unnamed people, was filed with Akbar Shah Police Station in connection with vandalism, arson attacks and clashes with police and obstructing them from discharging their duties.

Another case was filed with Bandar Police Station for vandalising over 30 vehicles at Nimtola. The case was filed against 30 named and about 300 unnamed people.

In 1995, a Channel 4 Dispatches documentary "War Crimes File" presented a series of evidence and eyewitnesses that directly implicated Chowdhury Mueenuddin as the leader of the gang responsible for disappearances and killing of Bangalee intellectuals.

During the one and a half hours of demonstration, it was also demanded that the UK government revoke Mueen's British citizenship, uphold its principle that no war criminals will be given a safe haven in the UK, and send him back to Bangladesh.

The demo was organised by ICT Support Forum, a platform of 71 UK-based pro-liberation Bangladeshi organisations.

Some of British parliamentarians and citizens who attended and addressed the rally in solidarity were Jim Fitzpatrick, MP, Poplar and Limehouse; Vice Chair of All Party Parliamentary Group on Bangladesh Jeremy Corbyn, MP, Islington North; Sheikh Muhammad Al Hussaini, Westminster Institute; Sam Westrop, Stand for Peace; and Gita Sahgal, producer of "War Crimes File", among others.

Koli Aktar, and grandmother Boru Khatun.

The witness found his mother Rahima Begum with her back riddled with bullets and wounded hand of his younger sister Sheuli. He also found four other bullet-hit persons.

Hafizur's mother was treated but she has been suffering the injuries till date.

The witness said he saw the body of Afzal Mia in a jute field near the Madrassa and Shukur Sheikh's house.

Shukur's son Alauddin Sheikh, also the ninth prosecution witness against Khokon, also testified yesterday and corroborated Hafizur's deposition on the incident of that day.

Alauddin was asked to carry the looted goods. As he refused, Khokon hit him in the back with a rifle.

Following their depositions, the defence counsel cross-examined them.

The proceeding of the case was adjourned until December 3.

CHANNEL 24

The tribunal yesterday fixed December 24 for hearing a show cause notice issued to four officials of Channel 24 and two guests and the moderator of a talk show, Muktoabaak, over making of contemptuous remarks in the show's September 18 episode.

In a petition on September 28, the prosecution said both the guests—Gonosasthya Kendra Trustee Zafullah Chowdhury and Secretary General of Centre for Sustainable Development Mahfuz Ullah—claimed that the rights of Salauddin Quader Chowdhury, now a war crimes convict, were violated as the tribunal did

not allow him to produce defence witnesses.

Nagorik Oikya Convener Mahmudur Rahman Manna moderated the talk show.

In his reply yesterday, Mahfuz Ullah said he sought unconditional apology if the judges found that his comments scandalised the tribunal, said his counsel Tarikul Islam.

Tarik sought a week's adjournment for hearing, as his client could not come due to unavoidable circumstances yesterday, the day fixed for the personal appearance of Mahfuz.

The tribunal observed that since the issuance of the show cause notice, Mahfuz never attended the court ignoring political programmes like hartal or blockade.

The tribunal then fixed December 1 for the personal appearance of Mahfuz only.
