Noakhali. She had started around 9:00pm Friday after watching news. Little did she know that another blockade would be announced only about half an hour later.

"We are now trying to find shelter here, as going to my destination will not be possible for the next few days," she said.

Announced by the 18party opposition alliance, the blockade has put thousands of people in harm's way, giving them little time to change their plans.

Shahidul Islam, who works at Keraniganj, was stranded at Kamalapur railway station. He said, "My daughter is terribly sick at home in Kishoreganj. I have to go there but no bus is plying today."

Sohrab Hossain and five other day labourers, who work at a ship-breaking yard in Chittagong, stopped at the station at 7:00am. They were headed for their Bogra

home where they would harvest paddy.

"The next train is supposed to depart at 7:00pm today. We do not have any choice but to wait here until then," said Sohrab, adding that in Dhaka they do not have any relatives who can put them up for now.

Mohammad Shamim, who works at a private firm, had started his journey on a bus from Cox's Bazar yesterday afternoon. The driver refused to go anywhere else as soon as it stopped at Sayedabad bus terminal at daybreak.

"I am in a terrible situation with my infant daughters because I do not have any relatives here," he said.

Nineteen labourers were also waiting at the bus terminal helplessly. For them, yesterday was the last date to join work at a brick kiln in Feni.

Mosharraf Hossain, one of the labourers from Jessore, said, "We have to reach Feni by any means. If we fail, it might cost us our

Living in anarchy

criminal hurls a petrol bomb at a woman's head. She dies after hours of agony. The image of her weeping daughter moves citizens everywhere. It does not move those who have set this violence into motion. Outside the capital, ruffi-

ans and brigands tear out, in the interest of "credible elections", railway tracks with not a thought to the safety of passengers on incoming trains. Moving buses come under attack. Individually owned cars are cheerfully mutilated into objects that speak of a country at war with itself. The blockade, or aborodh, has turned into a game of the macabre sort. There are all the tell-tale signs of its mutating into terrorism, of the kind that afflicts and has afflicted nations not ours.

Students in schools, colleges and universities keep praying and hoping the blockade politicians will give them enough of a break for them to finish their ongoing classes and examinations. That wish turns out to have been misplaced. Education, in the face of bombs and stones and arson, has gone comatose. Ask the blockade engineers. They have a single answer: let there be a caretaker government first. Education be damned.

The economy is as good as dead. Businesses are in intensive care, with no sign of a recovery soon. Business leaders, having consistently urged a proper political solution to the crisis, have given up. Soon, as seems likely, Bangladesh will be a lost cause in the global economic scheme because the production of goods has taken a back seat to the manufacture of chaos.

Not a word of regret or contri-

tion on the deaths of citizens, on the troubles afflicting the country, comes from those who call the general strikes and the blockades.

The leader of the opposition speaks of a "movement" going on until the government concedes the demand for a caretaker government. She does not appear in public. Neither do most of her party colleagues, who are on the run from the police.

The acting secretary general of the BNP makes the outlandish claim that those who have died in recent days were victims of police attacks. He has no time to explain how the police and other security forces have been throwing bombs into moving vehicles and killing innocent citizens. But he has time enough to get on a motorbike, head draped in helmet, to get away after a gayebana janaza before the police can come after him.

Day after day, night after night, Ruhul Kabir Rizvi of the BNP pushes blockades down the throats of the nation, with nary a thought to the sufferings of people. People, of course, matter little. Citizens die on the streets. Those who have called for demonstrations on the streets are nowhere to be seen. Fakhrul Islam Alamgir promised to cripple the country once an election schedule had been announced. He has kept his promise. Politics has been replaced by anarchy.

The ruling Awami League, like the opposition, remains unmoved at the ballooning tragedy. It cheerfully picks up opposition politicians, hauls them to court in triumph and demands that they be placed on remand. Humiliating

elderly leaders is what it does. A bus burns on the streets. Former ministers are charged with having ignited the flames even as the criminal elements in its own yard, having played havoc with tenders, share markets, etc. remain untouched

Partisan cheers are heard as the ruling party announces the names of its nominees for the general elections. Some of the more notorious of party members -- with their record of intimidation, alleged links to murder, corruption -- have come by party tickets. How notoriety helps democracy is not explained. A sense of complacence

overwhelms the ruling circles. The lesson seems to be simple: let the opposition carry on with its mayhem, let the nation and the world count the number of the rising dead, let disgust with the opposition hit the peaks -- and then all will be well. Meanwhile, a whole country drifts. The realities, in the end,

could well turn out different The facts on the ground bear all the signs of impending disaster.

EPILOGUE

The state of Bangladesh is in a state of anarchy. Democracy has gone fugitive, morality has died a slow death, politics has come to mean an unbridled race to seize the corridors of power.

The gods are in their heavens; and everything is wrong with our world.

Principles have been twisted out of shape, in the way the lives of citizens have been twisted into images of horror and blood and death -in a land that once was a proud victor in a twilight struggle for liberty and pluralistic expression.

"A behind-the-curtain dialogue is going on. If it yields a positive outcome, people of the country will get some respite. And if anything as such happens, the opposition leaders will no longer stay behind bars," he told a press conference at the secretariat yesterday.

When his attention was drawn to this, Inspector General of Police Hasan Mahmud Khandaker said he had no idea about what the minister said on the release of opposition leaders, and thus, he would not make any comment on this.

When asked why the dialogue was taking place "behind the curtains", Obaidul Quader said political talks first take place behind the curtains and then they are made public if they yield positive results.

"I hope there will be a positive result but I am not one hundred percent sure," he told reporters.

While giving an account of losses Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation incurred due to vandalism and arson during the opposition's blockade, Quader urged BNP to shun the path of destruction and try to reach a consensus with the government. The minister said BNP made

two mistakes-- first, they did not participate in the process of amending the constitution and second, they rejected the prime minister's call for a dialogue. He hoped BNP would realise

its mistakes and make amends in the interests of the people.

Asked whether there was any mistake on the part of the government, he said nobody was above mistakes, but did not mention any.

Railway service was the main target of the blockaders during last week's blockade enforced by BNP-Jamaat. Train services were severely disrupted as they uprooted lines and fishplates, damaged rail bridges and vandalised and torched

Around 1,376-metre tracks were uprooted between Koshba and monitoring risky tracks with Akhaura. Tracks were also ripped in Lalmonirhat, Comilla and Rajendrapur, resulting in derailment of trains that injured dozens. Three coaches of Sirajganj Express were burned down in Ishwardi last week.

"Attacks on rail tracks took place in 40 places during the four-day blockade last week. The estimated loss was Tk 6 crore," said the railway DG, adding, they had incurred a loss of Tk 26 crore during attacks by Jamaat-Shibir after their leader Delawar Hossain Sayedee was sentenced to death in a war crimes case.

The state-run Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation (BRTC) has incurred a loss of Tk 41.68 crore between April 2012 and November 2013 due to the opposition-called programmes like hartal and blockade.




