Student hacked to death

Criminals hacked a student to death at Falia village in Shailkupa upazila of the district on Tuesday night. The boy was identified as Sabuj Hossain 16 son of Akkaj Ali of the village. He was a student of Class Ten at Falia secondary school. Officer in-charge Anwar Hossain of Shailkupa police station said, Sabuj went 'missing' on Tuesday evening. Yesterday morning, locals found his body at a banana orchard owned by Abdul Malek of the village and informed police. His hands and legs were tied with rope, police said.

Newsmen stage protest

Local journalists formed a human chain in front of Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital yesterday, protesting negligence of doctors of providing treatment and misbehaving with patients. They also demanded removal of Dr Abdus Salam of the hospital. They submitted memorandum to the deputy commissioner, civil surgeon and superintendent of police in this regard as well. The participants said the doctors and staffs often showed negligence to the patients and misbehaved with them. On December 1, three people, including Monsur Ali, 57, district correspondent of Karotoa, were injured in a road accident in the town. When Monsur Ali was brought to hospital Dr Abdus Salam misbehaved with him and his relatives.

Cattle trader abducted

A cattle trader was abducted by criminals for ransom from Dewli village in Damurhuda upazila of the district on Tuesday night. Victim is Anwar Hossain, 35, son of Azim Uddin of the village. Family sources said when Anwar along with family members at his house a gang numbering 8-10 entered into the room and picked up him at gunpoint. Later they demanded Tk 8 lakh as ransom from the victim's family members over mobile phone.

Schoolgirl raped

A schoolgirl was raped in Phulbari upazila of the district on Tuesday afternoon. The father of the girl filed a rape case with Phulbari police station accusing four people. Police arrested key suspect Safayet after the case. According to the FIR, the accused forcibly picked up the girl, a class nine student, on Tuesday afternoon while she was returning from her school. They took her to a house and raped

Mob beats up Rab men, sources in Meherpur

Three Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) personnel, and three sources of the elite forces were injured in a mob beating at Rajnagar village in Sadar upazila of Meherpur district on Tuesday night.

The angry mob also torched three motorbikes of the Rab-6 men, snatched their firearms and confined them to a house for about an hour.

Police said, a team in

plainclothes, led by DAD Zakir Hossain, along with their sources in a drive arrested Sheregul Islam, an alleged drug peddler, at the village around 7:30pm and assaulted him during primary interrogation.

Hearing the hue and cry, the villagers encircled them and gave the six a good beating, branding them as robbers.

The injured are Rab DAD Zaikir Hossain, ASI Shariful Islam, constable Azizul Lavlu and sources Sunnat

Ali, Biplob Hossain and Minarul Hossain.

On information, additional Rab and some BGB men rushed to the spot and rescued the victims. They also opened fire to disperse the angry villagers.

The law enforcers later recovered the firearms after three hours of frantic search, said Reazul Islam, officer in-charge of Meherpur Sadar police station.

None was arrested till filing of this report yesterday noon.

FF brutally killed allegedly by Jamaat-Shibir activists

An elderly freedom fighter, who was injured in an attack allegedly by the activists of Jamaat-e-Islami and Islami Chhatra Shibir at Bhara-Simla village in Kaliganj upazila on Tuesday midnight, died at upazila health complex on Wednesday morning.

The deceased was identified as Alauddin Khokon, 65, of Bhara-Simulia village in the upazila.

Officer in-charge of Kaliganj police station Ali

Azam Khan said a gang attacked Alauddin Tuesday midnight and stabbed him indiscriminately with sharp weapons while he was sleeping on the verandah of his house.

Later the gang dumped him in a nearby ditch thinking that Alauddin had died in the attack.

Critically injured Alauddin was rushed to Kaliganj health complex where he died at about 7:30 am.

Assistant police super

intendent Laskar Tajul Islam (Debhata-Kaliganj circle) said they suspect that Jamaat-Shibir men hacked Alauddin to death.

Police are trying to arrest the accused, said Laskar Tajul Islam.

Kaliganj upazila AL president and former FF commandar also said that Alauddin was killed by Jamaat-Shibir men 'in a planned way'.

Contacted, Sathkira district Jamaat publicity secretary Azizur Rahman denied the allegation.

Land disputes leave five killed in four districts

At least five people were killed in separate incidents of clashes over disputed lands in four districts yesterday and the day before.

An elderly man was killed in a dispute over land in Chakoria upazila of Cox's Bazar district yesterday, reports our correspondent.

Mohammad Hossain, 60, of Khilsadek village under Koirbil union was attacked by rivals when he was working at his crop land at around 12:30pm.

Critically injured after being hit by a spade, he was rushed to Chakaria Health Complex where he died after sometime.

In Narail, two people were killed and 12 others were injured in a clash between two groups over a land dispute at Kagojipara village

under Hobokhali union of Sadar upazila on Monday.

The village is about 20 kilometers away from the district headquarters, reports our correspondent.

The deceased were identified as Aksir Mollah, son of Tobibor Mollah and Shofiar Mridha, son of Moksed Mridha of the village.

Police quoting locals said, there was a long-standing dispute between Sidique Sikder and Hobokhali union parishad member Mohasin Mollah over ownership of a piece of land.

On Monday morning, Sidique Sikder with his men went to the disputed land and started to harvest aman paddy. Hearing this, Mohasin and his supporters, equipped with lethal weapons, locked in a fierce clash with their rivals, leaving at least 13 people

injured.

Critically injured Aksir died on the way to Jessore Sadar Hospital while shofiar died in the morning. Other injured were admitted to Narail Sadar Hospital.

In Moulvibazar, a man killed his elder brother in a clash over a piece of land at Hamidpur village in Srimongal upazila on Mondaynoon.

The deceased was identified as Basoy Miah, 55, elder brother of Sahed Miah of the village in Sindurkhan union.

Contacted, Abdullah Al Helal, chairman of Sindurkhan union parishad said, that at one stage of clash, Sahed hit his brother with bamboo stick in the head.

Basoy died on the spot, police said.

RU teachers protest crimes during blockades
