The 85th birth anniversary of Chitra Bhattacharya, a former parliamentarian and leader of women's rights movement, will be observed today.

Social and religious memorial events will be organised in Ellenga, Kalihati, Tangail on behalf of the Justice Debesh Bhattacharya and Chitra Bhattacharya MP Foundation.

Chitra Bhattacharya was a lawmaker from Tangail against the reserved seat for women during 1996-2001 as an Awami League candidate. She was also a member of the Parliamentary Standing Committee for Finance, says a press release.

As the vice president and later an Advisory Council member of Bangladesh Mahila Parishad, she was deeply involved in women's rights movements. She also made great contributions as a leading member of the parishad's Legal Aid Committee.

She was also associated with many educational, social and philanthropic organisations, including Ramkrishna Mission, Dhaka Orphanage Society, Bangladesh Hindu-Buddhist-Christian Oikya Parishad, and Bangladesh Puja Uddjapan Parishad.

Salimullah medical college closes for indefinite period

Following a two-day stand-off between the students and staff of Sir Salimullah Medical College Mitford Hospital, the college in the capital was declared closed yesterday for an indefinite period.

The institution will not open "until the situation becomes normal", Principal Prof Dilip Kumar Dhar told journalists.

He also asked all the residential students to leave the campus by 7:00am today.

Meanwhile, the class IV employees who have been abstaining from work since Tuesday morning will not resume their work "unless their safety is ensured by the authorities," said Jahangir Alam, general secretary of Class IV Employees Association.

After the clash between the employees and interns early Tuesday, all the medical services at the hospital were disrupted.

Some employees said they could not join their work due to a fear of further violence.

The clash left at least 20 injured with two class IV employees admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.
