#### MOJAHEED'S DEATH SENTENCE SC seeks concise appeal statement from defence STAFF CORRESPONDENT

The Supreme Court on Wednesday directed lawyers representing war crimes convict Jamaat-e-Islami leader Ali Ahsan Muhammad Mojaheed to submit on December 19 a concise statement, containing the case summary and particular argument points, on his appeal challenging the death penalty.

A five-member bench of the SC Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice Muzammel Hossain passed the order.

The state counsels had submitted their concise statement against the appeal on November 24, Additional Attorney General and Coordinator of the prosecution team MK Rahman told The Daily Star.

Mojaheed filed the appeal with the SC on August 11. International Crimes Tribunal-2 on July 17 found the 65-year-old Jamaat secretary general guilty on five out of seven charges of crimes against

# Shahbagh prevails

For the first time, the slogan "Shahbagh triumphs" instead of "Hang Quader Mollah" reverberated Projonmo Chattar last night shortly after execution of the war criminal, whose life sentence gave birth to the Shahbagh movement 10 months ago.

With the hanging of the Jamaat-e-Islami leader, the anti-war criminal movement met with its first success. And the activists greeted it by hugging each other, dancing, flashing V signs, shouting "Joy Bangla", bringing out processions and some shedding tears of joy. "I've waited for this day

for 42 years. Perhaps, Allah has kept me alive till date to see this," said an elated freedom fighter, waving the national flag. "This is the happiest day

of my life," said a protester in tears. "We can go to sleep tonight knowing that we didn't let our predecessors' sacrifices go in vain." After a special tribunal

jailed Mollah for life on February 5, youths started pouring into the capital's Shahbagh intersection, terming the sentence too lenient for the man who killed people, including children, and raped women SEE PAGE 4 COL 7


