meetings yesterday, she stressed the importance of "free, fair and transparent elections next year, an election free from intimidation and violence."

She stressed that recent violence was damaging not only Bangladesh's reputation but also its economy and livelihoods of its people. "We all want to see sustainable elections that represent the will of the Bangladeshi people. It's therefore vital for all parties to refrain from any further acts of provocation and their leaders and senior officials participate in genuine and constructive dialogue," she said.

Asked about the

January 5 election, the UK minister said she was incredibly frank in her assessment of the consequences of the very fiction if these elections took place or did not in the format that the two parties would like them to be.

About the war crimes trial, Warsi said, "We believe that people who commit war crimes should face justice, there cannot be a culture of impunity for those who commit those horrendous crimes, and the people need to account for the crimes that they have committed."

But, the UK and the European Union "oppose the use of the death penalty in all circumstances in all countries", she added.

Hall-Mark chairperson sued

The Anti-Corruption Commission yesterday filed a case against Hall-Mark Group Chairperson Jasmine Islam for not submitting her wealth statement.

ACC Deputy Assistant Director Joyanal Abedin filed the case, said a source in the ACC.

According to the case statement, the commission on November 13 served a notice on Jasmine, asking her to submit her wealth statement to it within seven working days.

The deadline was extended to December 4 due to an appeal by Jasmine, but she still failed to submit the statement.

Jasmine, now free on bail, is charge-sheeted in all 11 cases lodged by the ACC in October last year on charges of misappropriating depositors' money of over Tk 1,568 crore.

The law says the EC is a constitutional body independent of any government or party influence and has

the sole responsibility of holding a free, fair and inclusive election, he said.

"While it sees that the election is not going to be inclusive, the EC could tell the government that it does not want to be responsible for holding an exclusive election. The general public must know that the EC has

been morally right," he said.

On the spread of pre-election violence, he said Bangladesh has the worst political culture in South Asia.

Even Pakistan, regarded by many as a failed state, has been able to hold an election and change the government without bloodshed, he said.
