Jamaat-Shibir men torch 7 trucks in C'nawabganj

Vandalise 20 vehicles in Chandpur

Jamaat-Shibir men torched seven orange-laden trucks at Pailing intersection on Chapainawabganj-Sonamasjid land port highway in Shibganj upazila of Chapainawabganj on Saturday night.

Being informed, fire fighters from Chapainawabganj fire station rushed to the spot and extinguished the blaze, according to our correspondent.

Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Shibganj Police Station said when the Dhaka-bound trucks from Sonamasjid land port reached Pailing intersection at around 6:30pm, Jamaat-Shibir activists set fire to the trucks.

Law enforcers arrested 25 BNP and Jamaat-Shibir men, raiding different areas of the upazila the same night on charge of torching seven fruit-laden trucks, said Motiur Rahman, ASP of Sadar Circle.

In Kasat area of the upazila, unidentified criminals stabbed at least six Awami League activists at around 7:30pm on the day.

Locals said, a gang swooped on the AL men while they were returning homes from local Awami League leader Golam Rabbani's house at Pukuria in the upazila.

They injured AL men were admitted to Shibganj Upazila Health Complex and later shifted to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital as their condition deteriorated.

Our Chandpur correspondent reported that BNP and Jamaat-Shibir activists vandalised at least 20 vehicles, including a police van, in the district town and Hajiganj upazila yesterday afternoon.

They also set a stone-laden truck afire in front of Chandpur Government College.

In Dinajpur, at least three ruling party men were injured in a clash with BNP activists in Dinajpur Sadar upazila yesterday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The injured are Md. Anwar Hossain 50, Afaz Uddin, 60 and Md Shawkat Ali, 50, of Jamtoli area under Sadar upazila. They were admitted to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital.

2 killed as rival villagers clash in B'baria

Two people were killed and at least 25 others, including two constables -- Monir and Jahangir -- were injured in a clash between two rival groups at Sohagpur village under Ashuganj upazila in the district yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Hira Mia, 55, and Sharif Mia, 15, of Molla Bari at the village.

According to villagers and police, two groups of youths of Molla Bari and Chowdhury Bari locked in an altercation over bathing in a local pond.

At a stage, both groups,

who had longstanding enmity, attacked each other with lethal weapons.

At least 27 people, including two constables -- Monir and Jahangir -- were injured in the hour-long clash.

Hira Mia and Sharif Mia, who were hit by spears in the chest, succumbed to their injuries on the way to hospital.

The other injured were sent to Brahmanbaria Sadar Hospital and Ashuganj Day Night Private Hospital.

In Jhenidah, at least 35 people were injured in a clash between two groups at Nauapara village in Shaikupa upazila of the district on Sunday morning, reports our correspondent.

Of the injured, six including Nawab Ali and Mizan Ali were being treated at Jessore Sadar Hospital.

Locals and police said, at around 10:00, the family members of UP member Ratan Mia and his neighbour Moktar Matabbar locked in an altercation over throwing dirt by the side of each other's house.

It followed a bloody clash between the loyalists of Ratan Mia and Moktar Matabbar who used lethal weapons like spears, billhooks and daggers.

Bombs hurled at MP's house

Two held with arms

The arrestees are Tantu Moni Chakma, 33, son of late Savash Kanti Chakma and Tapash Khisha, 25, son of Sikhi Das of Modhupur area in the district town.

Robbers loot houses

Robbers looted cash, gold ornaments and other valuables worth Tk 10 lakh from three houses at Dakkhin Daudpur village in Nawabganj upazila early Saturday after injuring four people. Police said a gang of 20/25 swooped on the house of Md Hafizur Rahman and took away valuables worth Tk 3 lakh. Later, the robbers entered the houses of Md Abdul Matin and Abdul Hakim by breaking the doors open and looted valuables worth Tk 6.1 lakh respectively. Before leaving the spot, the robbers, who were resisted by the villagers, carried out an attack, leaving the four injured.

Five shops torched

At least five shops were torched allegedly by criminals near the house of war criminal Saydee at Dhepshabunia village in Zianagar upazila on Saturday night. The loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk two lakh, claimed the affected shop owners. The reason behind the fire could not be known immediately, said Md Kamruzzaman Talukder, officer in-charge of Indur Kani police station. We are investigating the matter, said the OC.
