Jamaat leader killed in gunfight

A ward-level Jamaat-e-Islami leader was killed in a gunfight between law enforcers and Jamaat-Shibir men in Sadar upazila of Meherpur early yesterday.

Abdul Jabbar, member of Amjhupi union parishad, was the Jamaat ameer (chief) of ward no. 9 in the union.

Jamaat called a daylong hartal in the district today protesting the death, confirmed Abu Bakar Siddique, office secretary of the

Subhan indicted

Tribunal frames 9 war crimes charges against the Jamaat leader; trial begins Jan 28

Jamaat-e-Islami Nayeb-e-Ameer Abdus Subhan has been charged for involvement in genocide and murders of unarmed people along with looting, setting houses on fire and complicity to commit crimes against humanity during the Liberation War.

After framing nine charges against Subhan, the International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday set January 28 for beginning his trial with opening statement from the prosecution.

The charges are based on separate incidents of crimes against humanity committed between April 13 and October 30 in 1971 in Pabna. About 450 unarmed people were killed in those incidents.

The 77-year-old Jamaat leader was the vice-president of Pabna Peace Committee, an associate organisation of the Pakistani army at that time of war in 1971. He was the founder ameer of Jamaat in Pabna and a Majlish-e-Sura member of the central



unit of Jamaat in undivided Pakistan.

The most notable of the nine charges brought against Subhan is killing of 300-400 people including Hindus by the Pakistani army and its local collaborators under his leadership at several villages in Satbaria union of Sujanagar upazila on May 12, 1971.

Justice ATM Fazle Kabir, chairman of the tribunal, which also has members

Arrest order for Delwar, 5 others

Court accepts homicide charges against 13 over Tazreen fire disaster

A Dhaka court yesterday ordered police to arrest Tazreen Fashions Managing Director Delwar Hossain, his wife Mahmuda Akhter and four others on homicide charges over one of the country's worst industrial disasters in 2012.

Senior Judicial Magistrate Wasim Sheikh passed the order after he accepted the charges brought against 13 people by Criminal Investigation Department Inspector AKM Mohsinuzzaman in the case linked with the blaze.

Mohsinuzzaman, investigation officer of the case, on

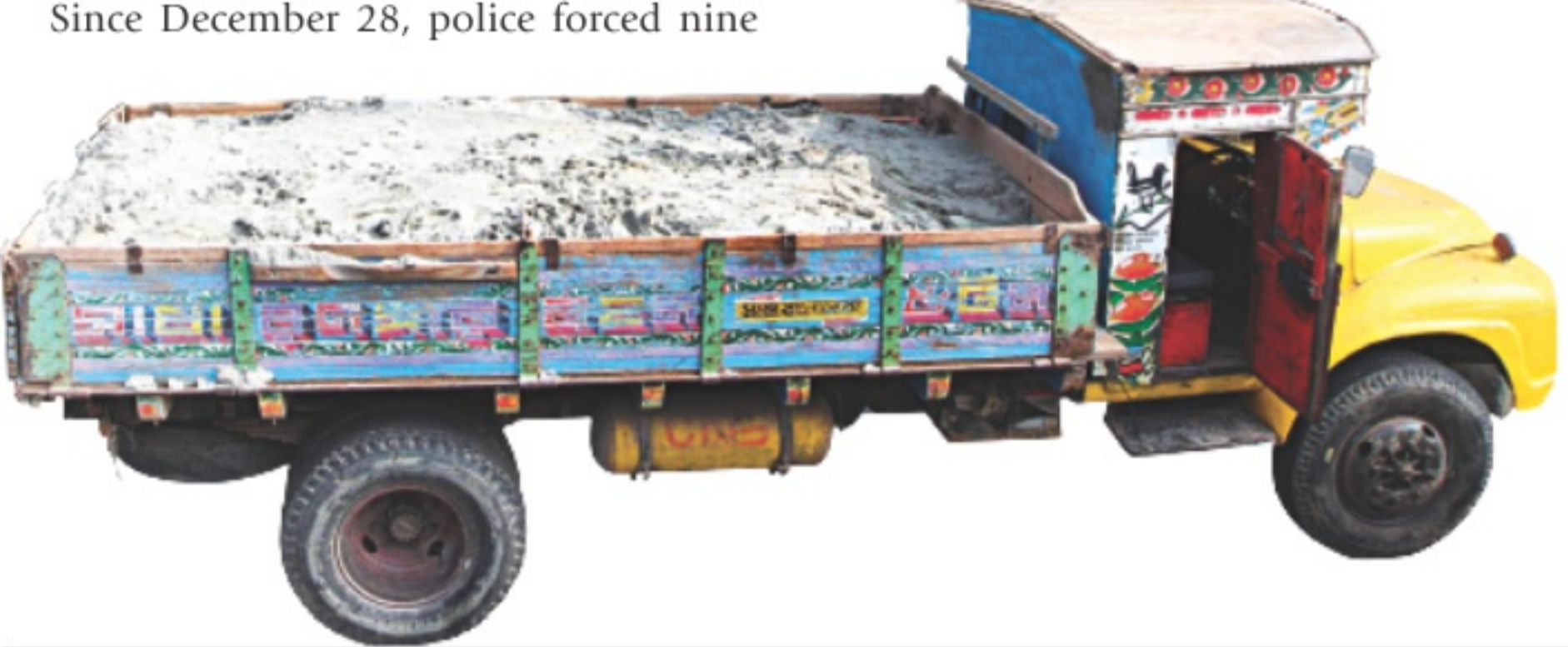
