beat him to death in a temporary shelter at Bandar Abbas on December 14, blaming him for their abduction.  
The six alleged that Jewel, himself a victim of abduction, helped criminals abduct them in the United Arab Emirates and send them to Iran.  
The 29 men returned to Dhaka on December 22.  
It was an unbearable shock for Jewel's family to receive his body while he was supposed to come back alive with other compatriots.  
His sister Kalpana Akter and father Shahjahan Mollah were lamenting at the airport, and the sight of this lifeless body only added to their grief.  
"I am an ill-fated father on earth. I could not save my son. I have to live with the anguish of losing him," said the wretched old man.

Shahjahan thinks he should not have sent her son abroad spending a huge sum of money. "I lost everything-my son as well as my money. I pray nobody else faces such a tragedy."  
The thought of what her poor parents will go through now exacerbates the agony of Jewel's sister Kalpana.  
"My brother went to the afterworld leaving my father and mother in distress. Mother has been passing her days in bed crying for Jewel since she heard the news of his death," she said.  
Now, there is nothing but seeking justice for his death, Kalpana added.  
The six migrants responsible for Jewel's death are now in jail after they were arrested in a murder case filed with Airport Police Station by Jewel's father.  
Jewel will be buried at his village home in Bhederganj upazila in Shariatpur today.

Bangladesh is experiencing a severe cold wave sweeping almost all over the country putting normal life and day to day business to almost stand still. The sufferings of the distressed and vulnerable people particularly the disabled, elderly men, women and children is heightened by the biting cold owing to lack of warm clothes.  
The lowest temperature recorded so far stood at 8.5 degrees Celsius in Iswardi on December 28. The trend in drastic fall in temperature and the forecast by the Bangladesh Meteorological Department suggest that another two spell of cold wave are likely to hit the country by the middle of January and beginning February of 2014.  
As in the past, Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) has already started distributing blankets from the joint stock maintained with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC).  
● All the 64 districts are affected by cold wave with varying degrees.  
● About 200,000 (two hundred thousand) blankets are still needed to cater to the needs of the affected people.  
● A pool of 486,500 trained volunteers is ready to serve the affected people in 68 BDRCS Units.

hearing, he added.  
The ACC submitted the appeal on December 5 last year urging the HC to scrap the judgment of a lower court which acquitted Tarique of the money laundering charge on November 17 the same year.  
The Dhaka court, however, sentenced Tarique's business partner, Giasuddin Al Mamun, to seven years in prison and fined him Tk 40 crore in the same case.  
In October 2009, the ACC had filed the case against Tarique and Mamun for laundering Tk 20.41 crore to Singapore between 2003 and 2007.

# SC judges set to get hiked salaries soon

allowances of judges of the Appellate and High Court divisions.  
Six months before that, the parliamentary sub-committee had recommended Tk 1.52 lakh as monthly salary for the chief justice, Tk 1.20 lakh for an appellate judge, and Tk 1.08 lakh for an HC judge.  
The June 15 order came after two SC lawyers filed a public interest writ petition with the HC requesting the court to direct the government to implement the parliamentary sub-committee's recommendations.

Manzill Murshid, one of the lawyers, said the SC had stayed the HC verdict for some time following a government petition in late 2011, and also asked the government to file an appeal with it against the HC verdict on getting its

full text.  
The government then filed an appeal against the HC verdict, he said, adding that during hearing on the appeal on December 12 last year, Attorney General Mahbubey Alam told the SC that the government had taken steps to increase the salary of the judges.  
On December 12 last year, the apex court fixed January 30 this year for

further hearing, and after that the government decided to increase the salary by 50 percent, said Manzill.  
In April last year, the law ministry had sent a letter to the finance ministry proposing to give an additional 70 percent risk allowance to each of the nine appellate judges on their salaries, but the finance ministry rejected it, said the ministry sources.
