2 warehouses gutted in old Dhaka

A fire gutted two warehouses of herbal and plastic goods in Old Dhaka's Becharam Deuri last night.

Witnesses and fire service sources said the fire originated from the one-storey tin-shed herbal warehouse around 9:10pm and spread to the adjacent warehouse for plastic, located on the first floor of a five-storey building.

Six units of fire brigade doused the flames around 11:35pm. None was hurt but smoke was coming out of the warehouses as of filing of this report around 12:30pm.

oscillated between 9C and 12.5C in Bhola, said MHM Mosaddek, officer-in-charge of Bhola Met Office. The moderate cold wave may continue for the next three or four days, he added.

Farm activities were being disrupted amid such extreme weather conditions. Amjad Ali, a 40-year-old farmer of West Charkali village in Bhola, said it was difficult for them to work in the field as the sun could not be seen.

Forecasters said the weather would prevail for two more days.

Low temperature was also reported in Keraniganj where Aati village resident Abdul Zalil said it was so cold that he could not fight it even after wearing a jacket, muffler and warm shirt.

In Nilphamari, temperature has drastically fallen these days and is fluctuating between 7C and 8C, crippling normal life, said Saidpur Met office.

Manik Saha, an ex-president of Khulna Press Club, also worked for the New Age, Ekushey TV, and BBC.

The trial of his murder opened in June 2008 against 14 people--three of them killed in "gunfights" with law enforcers, four imprisoned, and the rest absconding. The trial was being delayed due to repeated absences of an important prosecution witness, said police.

Born in Narail in 1956, Manik Saha began his career as Khulna district correspondent in the Sangbad in 1982. Before that, he was involved in leftist politics.

Obaidul Hassan and which includes Justice Md Mozibur Rahman Miah, said, "As a prosecutor you have to exhibit those (documents) concerning the accused...You did not do your homework."

"It seems you did not study properly," said Justice Hassan, adding, "This is not fair. You cannot keep us sitting idle. This is very valuable public time."

"We should impose a fine (on you)," said Justice Miah.

Another prosecutor, Saiful Islam, said, "They (the assigned prosecutors) did not go into the details and we need some more

time."

"Do not come to the court without preparation," Justice Hassan said. Azab is expected to resume giving his testimony on Sunday.

Man dies from burn injuries

A man from Chandpur died from burn injuries at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday.

Bachchu, 50, a farmer, died at the intensive care unit (ICU) around 6:00am, said its resident surgeon Partha Shankar Paul adding that he was receiving treatment facilities like other victims of political violence.

Doctors at DMCH said during admission it was said that Bachchu sustained injuries from a Molotov cocktail attack in Dakkhin Matalab January 6.

But his family members told The Daily Star yesterday that he received burn injuries on January 6 while getting himself warm sitting beside a furnace in his house at Dhakirgaon village in Dakkhin Matalab upazila of Chandpur.

Amir Zafar, superintendent of police in Chandpur, also confirmed that the incident occurred in Bachhu's house and it was not a bomb attack.

Jewel, son-in-law of Bachhu, told our Chandpur correspondent that during admission his in-laws told the lie to get the treatment facilities.
