

2 Shibir, 1 BNP men held in Ctg

Police arrested two activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir and one of BNP from different upazilas in Chittagong yesterday.

Shibir activist Obaidul Haque, of Adunagar, and BNP activist Nazir Ahmed alias Burma Nazir were arrested in Lohagara and in Sitakunda's Fauzderhat area respectively in connection with several cases filed for vandalism, arson and attacks on on-duty police personnel.

Meanwhile, police arrested Shibir activist Saleh Jangi, in Fatikhkhari's Lelang Shah Nagar village in four cases, including a murder case, and seized a gun and four bullets from him.

In his 70-minute testimony before International Crimes Tribunal-2, Helal Uddin, the 27th witness, said he visited all spots of crimes allegedly committed by the Jamaat nayeb-e-ameer and recorded witnesses' statements between October 5, 2012 and April 21, 2013.

Besides, he had seized relevant newspaper reports, books, video footages and documents to prove the 13 charges of Yusuf's involvement in crimes against humanity and genocide committed in the greater Khulna region during the Liberation War, Helal said.

As the evidence "preliminarily proved" Yusuf's involvement in the crimes, he had submitted the probe reports and other documents to the chief prosecutor on April 21, 2013, he added.

Afterwards, Yusuf's counsel Mizanul Islam started cross-examining Helal before the three-member tribunal led by Justice Obaidul Hassan adjourned it for continuation tomorrow.

Meanwhile, the prosecution informed that they had filed a petition on Sunday to curtail the number of defence witnesses. In September, 2013, the defence submitted a list of 56 witness.

Helal said the evidence "preliminarily proved" that Yusuf formed the Peace Committee, an anti-liberation organisation, in Khulna and he instated himself as its chairman.

Afterwards, he held meetings in all police stations and unions of the greater Khulna region (Khulna, Bagerhat and Satkhira) and formed peace committees there, he said.

Then, Yusuf gathered Jamaat and Muslim League men and other anti-liberation elements and gave them a short training in Khulna Ansar camp before establishing the armed Razakar force, an auxiliary force of the Pakistan occupation army, formally on May 5, 1971, said Helal.

"He also named the force Razakar," said Helal.

The ACC has also summoned office assistants Abul Kalam Azad of Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 and Md Ariful Islam of Special Judges Court-3 in Dhaka, the two courts where Hossain served, to quiz them tomorrow.

Yesterday, Motahar Hossain's bodyguard Badal Dewan and chauffeur Sohrab Hossain were interrogated by the ACC at its office in the capital's Segunbagicha. On January 23, the stenographers of Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 and Special Judges Court-3 were interrogated.

Motahar Hossain also acquitted BNP Senior Vice-chairman Tarique Rahman in a money laundering case last November.

The graft watchdog opened investigation against the judge on January 20 after it received allegations that Motahar, who retired last December and left for Malaysia on January 8, amassed huge wealth illegally and laundered money abroad during his service term.

As a special tribunal judge, Motahar dropped the charges against Tarique, elder son of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia, in the laundering of Tk 20.41 crore to Singapore. In the same case, he sentenced Tarique's friend and business partner Giasuddin Al Mamun to seven years in prison and fined him Tk 40 crore.

In the judgment, Motahar said Tarique spent a portion of Tk 20.41 crore from Mamun's

Singapore account and mentioned it in his wealth statement, so he could not be charged.

The authorities also have been asked to realise compensation from Pran Agro Ltd for damaging the river, and submit a report to it after complying with the order in four weeks.

The court also issued a rule upon the government authorities and Pran Agro Ltd to explain in four weeks why they should not be directed to relocate the factories to other places to stop the pollution.

The High Court bench of Justice Mirza Hussain Haider and Justice Muhammad Khurshid Alam Sarkar came up with the order and rule after hearing the writ petition filed by Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (Bela).

The organisation filed the petition on Sunday saying that the factories of Pran Agro Ltd have been dumping wastes into the river Narod at Sadar upazila of the district and polluting its environment.

The company has been running the factories without establishing effluent treatment plants to save the river from pollution, it said.

Bela prayed to the court to pass necessary orders to save the river from pollution.

Iqbal Kabir Lytton appeared for the petitioner.
