Listed criminal found dead

UNB, Sirajganj

Police recovered the body of an alleged listed criminal from Konagati area on the Jamuna Bridge Bypass Road in Sadar upazila early yesterday. The deceased was identified as Joban Ali, 35, one of the accused in local Awami League leader Saiful murder case and son of late Azizur Rahman of Bawatara village. Habibul Islam, officer-in-charge of Sadar police station, said a patrol police team spotted the bullet-hit body of Joban in a field in the area around 1:45am. The reason behind the murder could not be known immediately, said police. Meanwhile, family members of the deceased claimed that Joban was arrested by police on Wednesday afternoon.

Jhenidah BNP expels leader

A local leader of BNP was expelled from the party on Wednesday for contesting the upazila elections going against the party decision. The expelled leader is Munsi Kamal Azad Pannu, president of Jhenidah sadar upazila unit BNP. Jhenidah district unit BNP general secretary Abdul Malek disclosed the matter of Pannu's expulsion at a press conference at the party office around 11:00am. The expulsion followed a decision at an emergency meeting of the party with the unit's senior vice president Nazrul Islam presiding. BNP nominated its Jhenidah sadar upazila unit general secretary Abdul Alim to participate in the upcoming upazila elections for the post of chairmanship. On the other hand, Munsi Kamal Azad submitted nomination papers to vie for the same post defying party decision.

Youth held for 'killing sister'

Police arrested a youth at Chokmukundu Gholagari village in Sherpur upazila early yesterday on charge of killing his sister. Arrestee Mohammad Ali alias Lalor, 27, son of Azizul Haque of the village is a drug addict. Officer in-charge of Sherpur police station Mizanur Rahman said Lalor attacked his younger sister Jannati Khatun, 13, a class eight student of a local high school, with a spade following an altercation over a trivial matter on February 1. She was rushed to Dhaka Medical College and Hospital in critical condition where she died on February 3. Azizul Haque then filed a murder case accusing his son Lalor in this connection, said the OC.

3 held in Nayan killing case

Police arrested three people at Gyanarpura village under Mithapukur upazila on Wednesday night on charge of killing a young man. The arrestees are Tariful Islam alias Chanchal Mian, 40, his wife Parul Begum, 30, and Abdul Hakim, 45, of the village. Nayan Mondal, 25, son of Shamsul Alam Mondal of the area was killed in a clash over a land dispute on Wednesday morning. Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Shamsul Alam Mondal and Chanchal Mian over the land in the area.

'Missing' AL leader found murdered in Noakhali

A local Awami League leader and union parishad (UP) member was hacked to death by criminals at Naldoi village in Sadar upazila early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Mohammad Ullah, 38, a member of Kuchakhali UP and also joint secretary of the union unit of Awami

League and son of late Nurul Islam of the village.

Locals saw the body of Mohammad Ullah near Poakhali canal in the area and informed police. Ahmed Ullah Nasir, chairman of UP, said Mohammad Ullah went 'missing' after he had come out of home for Kuchakhali Bazar on Wednesday.

Relatives looked for him at probable places but failed

to trace him till late at night.

Police recovered the body in the morning and sent it to Sadar Hospital morgue for an autopsy.

Iqbal Hossain, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said criminals might have killed Mohammad Ullah some time after Wednesday midnight and dumped the body in the area.

The reason behind the murder could not be known immediately.

Kidnapped boy rescued, woman held

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) on Wednesday rescued a 6-year-old boy, kidnapped on Monday from Phulgazi upazila in the district.

Abdullah Al Mahmud alias Duranta, son of Italy expatriate Abdus Sattar of Penapushkarni village under Amjadhat union was kidnapped by two local goons on February 6 when the boy was playing in a field near his house in the afternoon.

Later they demanded Tk 6 lakh from the family of Duranta, a Class I student, and threatened his family of dire consequences if they informed the matter to the law enforcers.

However, Shahadat Hossain, uncle to the child, filed a general diary with Phulgazi Police Station and informed Rab-7 about the incident.

Following the information, a Rab team rescued the boy from Laksham area in Comilla district on Wednesday evening and detained a woman, identified as Jahana Begum, in this connection.

BSF hands over 3 kids trafficked to India months ago

Indian Border Security Forces (BSF) yesterday handed over three schoolboys who were abducted and trafficked to India 32 months ago.

BGB sources said that the BSF returned them after a flag meeting held at Darshana in Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga district.

Abdul Awal Khan, Commander of Darshana BGB Camp told this correspondent that a gang abducted the three schoolboys from their areas in Kushtia and Faridpur and took them to India through Hili border point on May 15, 2011.

The boys were identified as Pintu Mia, 15, son of Reaz Uddin of Mathpara in Daulatpur upazila of Kushtia, Monirul Mondol, 16, son of Firoz Mondol of Hogolkanti and Rubel Hossain, 15, son of Bishu Mia of Natkhola in Salokha upazila of Faridpur district.

A BSF team arrested them the same day and handed the boys over to Nadia police in Paschimbanga and since then they had been languishing at Nadia jail.

After a long legal process

involving both countries, a decision was taken to return the boys.

'At first I did not know the whereabouts of my son', said Pintu's father Reaz Uddin to journalists who were present during the flag meeting.

'After three months I came to know that my son was in Indian jail', he said.

"We will hand over the boys to their family after a few legal procedures," said Ahsan Habib, officer-in-charge of Damurhuda police station.

A Jhenidah report adds: BSF yesterday noon picked up a Bangladeshi cattle trader from Joluli border area under Moheshpur upazila.

The arrestee is Lalto Mia, 20, son of Aminul Islam of Gopalpur village under the upazila, reports our correspondent.

On Tuesday morning, five other Bangladeshi nationals were picked up by Indian police from Khosalpur bordering area in same upazila.

BGB says, they have sent a letter to BSF for a flat meeting for returning the arrestee.

Jubo Dal leader shot dead in Sirajganj

A Jubo Dal leader was shot dead in Konagati area under Sirajganj Sadar upazila for yesterday.

The victim, Md Zoban Ali, 45, was vice president of Syedabad union unit of Jubo Dal, youth front of BNP, and the main accused in upazila-Awami League leader Saiful Islam murder case.

Saiful, youth and sports secretary of Sadar upazila unit of Awami League, was stabbed to death at Baitara village in the upazila on December 30 last year.

Officer in-charge (OC) Md Habibul Islam of Sadar Police Station said locals found the bullet-hit body of Zoban under a bridge in Konagati area in the morning and informed

the police.

Police reached the spot at around 6:00am, recovered the body and sent it to Sirajganj Sadar Hospital for autopsy.

Zoban was also wanted in seven other criminal cases, the OC said, adding that they are trying to unearth clues to the murder.

He was a fugitive. His rivals might have killed him over previous enmity, locals said.

Bablu, another accused in AL leader Saiful murder case, was killed during a 'shootout' with Rab in the upazila on January 13.


