Sadeque Hossain Khoka, now behind the bars, is the convener and MA Salam is the member secretary of the current Dhaka city committee formed in 2011.

"You have failed to form ward and thana committees with dedicated leaders. You put your own men in those committees, who did not take to the streets during the recent anti-government movement," Haji Yousuf, a Dhaka city leader, quoted Khaleda as saying in the hour and a half meeting.

When Salam blamed this on police oppression, Khaleda retorted, "Where were your men when I was forced out of my cantonment residence in 2010. Police did not open fire at that time?" At one stage, Salam admitted their failure and begged the party chief's pardon and requested her to let them form new committees with people from all groups. A fuming Khaleda then said, "You don't need to teach me how to form new committees," adding that she would prefer dedicated, honest and tested leaders this time.

She also said she would take advice from the standing committee whether to form two committees in Dhaka city's north and south. This was her latest initiative to inject fresh blood into the Dhaka city unit before going for a fresh movement for holding an election under a non-partisan administration.

Pallabi SI closed

A sub-inspector, Jahidur Rahman Khan, was temporarily withdrawn from Pallabi Police Station in the capital yesterday over allegations of having beaten a youth to death on Sunday, Deputy Commissioner of Mirpur division Intiaz Ahmed told The Daily Star.

Istiaq Ahmed Johnny, 28, a resident of Talab camp in Mirpur 11, was detained around 2:30am on Sunday for "assaulting a police informer". He was brought dead to Dhaka Medical College Hospital eight hours later. Police claimed that he died of chest pain.

DC Intiaz said a three-member probe was formed to confirm the cause of Johnny's death. The report is due in 10 days.

Meanwhile, locals continued their street protest against Johnny's death.

12 hurt as villagers clash with cops

2 'abductors' held in Dhamrai

Twelve people were injured, including four with bullets, in a clash between police and local people over confinement of two alleged women abductors at Nandeswari village in Dhamrai upazila of Dhaka yesterday.

Police and locals said the villagers caught two women Khulsum Akhter and her associate Shilpi Akter and confined the duo to a room of Nandeswari Govt Primary School when they were taking its five students to Satura Bus Stand alluring them of school bags and umbrellas.

On information, Kawalipara Outpost police rushed in and tried to take control of the situation. At one stage, locals broke open the door of the school room and started beating up the women. The agitators locked in the clash with police when they were trying to rescue the two, said in-charge of the outpost Mostafa Kamal who was injured along with four other cops in the clash.

Sattar, Mokhles, Akkas, and Alamin of the village received bullet wounds. The outpost police handed the two women over to Dhamrai Police Station.

Amar Ekushey Granthamela not only facilitates interaction among readers, writers and publishers but also hosts book publication ceremonies alongside providing free promotion.

Every day on average five books are launched at Nazrul Mancha on the fair's Bangla Academy portion through simple ceremonies organised by the publisher or writer and where a guest unwraps the book and briefly tells onlookers about the content.

However, Bangladesh Shishu Academy yesterday afternoon witnessed the publication ceremony of "Chotokakur Quarter Century" by children's litterateur Faridur Reza Sagar which was appropriately held among children and included a performance by them.

The book, published by Anyaprokash, is a collection of 25 stories centring on the adventures of a detective, "Chotokaku", and based on which a popular television series is aired in Channel i.

Cultural Affairs Minister Asaduzzaman Noor as chief guest asked children to read the book, adding in a jocular manner that the publication industry, including writers, was dependent on readers' habit of purchasing their favourite books.

Poet Shamsul Haque asked children not only to watch the television series but also to read the book. "For books help you reach near the mind of the writer," he said.

Khoka denied bail again

Judge's Court rejected Khoka's bail prayers after his lawyers submitted three petitions before the court challenging a lower court's bail rejection order, according to our court correspondent.

Khoka was shown arrested in a case filed for killing Shahjahan during the May 5 mayhem in Motijheel centring the Hefajat-e Islam rally.

He was also shown arrested in two other cases filed for attempting to murder cops by throwing cocktails, vandalising vehicles and preventing law enforcers from discharging

their duties in the capital's Jatrabari area during demonstrations in November and December.

On the other hand, Khandaker Mosharraf was sued for laundering over Tk 9.53 crore to the United Kingdom, reports our staff correspondent.

ACC Director Nasim Anwar filed the case on February 6 stating that the BNP leader, using the influence of his post, amassed the amount between 2001 and 2006 and deposited that in a bank account in the UK.

The HC yesterday granted the bail after hearing a petition filed by the defendant.

Misti, a mother of one, used to date Rafiq at his residence in the absence of his wife.

She told detectives that Rafiq often forced her to have sex with his friends, threatening to put their sex videos on the internet. Due to such threats, Misti planned the killing.

On December 30, Misti convinced Rafiq to make love in a different way and tied his hands, legs with her scarf and a towel to a chair before stabbing him to death.

Then, she took away his laptop and deleted the video clips from it. Detectives seized the laptop, Rafiq's phone, and the scarf.
