

Sheikh Selim urges India to hand over Jamaat 'terrorists'

Awami League Presidium Member Sheikh Fazlul Karim Selim yesterday requested the Indian authorities and West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee to hand over "Jamaat-e-Islami terrorists who have taken shelter in India".

Taking the floor on a point of order in the House, Selim urged India not to harbour these "terrorists", who he said fled to the neighbouring country during the joint force's recent operation in Satkhira.

Referring to a recent comment by Biman Basu, general secretary of CPM, West Bengal, that a Trinamool Congress MP is giving shelter to Jamaat "terrorists" that could deteriorate Bangladesh-India relations, Selim alleged that Trinamool MP Hasan Ahmed is the Kolkata correspondent of Jamaat-owned daily Naya Diganta.

Another ruling party MP, AKM Jahangir, urged the government to bring culprits involved in anti-state activities to book.

sentenced Selim, Hashim and Abdul Malik Soheli to life term imprisonment in the case and former general manager of KEPZ Abu Naser Chowdhury and former chief security officer Humayun Kabir Chowdhury to five years imprisonment.

Later, the accused filed appeals against the verdict with the High Court. The government filed two revision appeals with the HC in 2005 praying for the highest punishment for the accused. Meanwhile in 2008, the HC acquitted Hashim from the charge.

The HC bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Akram Hossain Chowdhury concluded the hearing on the appeals on June 19 last year, Assistant Attorney General Gazi Md Mamun-Ur Rashid told The Daily Star.

The bench on January 29 fixed today for delivering the verdict, he added.

Sobhan Sikder new principal secy to PM

The government yesterday appointed Abdus Sobhan Sikder as principal secretary to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and transferred two other secretaries.

Sikder, who had served as senior secretary to the public administration ministry since October 3, 2011, replaced Shaikh Md Wahid-uz Zaman on expiry of his tenure.

Sikder will retire from service on February 15 next year.

Meanwhile, Education Secretary Kamal Abdul Naser Chowdhury has been made the public administration secretary while Secretary to the Election Commission Secretariat Dr M Sadik will take over as the education secretary.

Additional Secretary to the EC Secretariat Md Sirajul Islam has been made acting secretary to the EC Secretariat. He has been replaced by Additional Divisional Commissioner of Dhaka and Additional Secretary Md Moklesur Rahman.

Sources in the government said more changes were in the offing both in the Prime Minister's Office and the Bangladesh Secretariat.

we rebuilt our homes with bricks and kept water in drums to fight fire. But we could do nothing this time too," lamented Mohammad Jasim, a private car driver.

Mohammad Ismail, treasurer of a co-operative society of the slum dwellers, said the 1 acre and 17 decimals of land belonged to the state-owned National House Authority and the inhabitants did not have to pay any rent.

The story of Laizu Begum, 32, is about a family that suddenly slid to misery from solventy. She worked hard to become an electrician alongside her husband and built a grocery and an electronics shop toiling over the last 15 years. All her belongings were gone in an hour. "Nobody will understand how much labour I and my family had to put for this," she said.

Deputy Commissioner of Dhaka district Shaikh Yusuf Harun said they victims would be temporarily sheltered in a nearby school building. He announced that they would distribute Tk 3,000, a blanket, and 20kg of rice among each of the affected families today.

that there was now no legal bar for holding the written test of the 34th BCS, including the 280 indigenous candidates, following the HC verdict.

On July 8 last year, the PSC first published the results of the preliminary test, in which 12,033, including the 280, passed. Later, amid students' demonstration against the quota system in BCS exams, the PSC on July 14 published a revised list of 46,250

qualified candidates but it excluded the names of the 280 indigenous candidates.

Following the petition, the HC on July 31 last year asked the PSC to explain why their exclusion would not be declared illegal. In its reply, the PSC said the exclusion occurred due to penalty marking and re-evaluation of answer sheets. The commission also withheld the written tests.

The HC bench of Justice Naima Haider and Justice Zafar Ahmed gave the verdict.
