INT'L MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY Security beefed up at Shaheed Minar

With the recent audiovisual of al-Qaeda in mind, Dhaka Metropolitan Police has beefed up security at the Central Shaheed Minar in the capital and its surrounding areas ahead of International Mother Language Day on February 21.

DMP Commissioner Benazir Ahmed said this, addressing a press briefing at the DMP media centre yesterday.

Replying to a query, Benazir said there is no place for militant outfits in Bangladesh. He said they were also investigating whether any group in the country has links to al-Qaeda.

Benazir said 57 CCTV cameras and 28 security stops will be set up for security at the Shaheed Minar and its surrounding areas.

DMP will deploy plainclothes officers, patrols and striking forces besides the regular force. Women police in plainclothes, a bomb-disposal team, a dog squad, and SWAT personnel will also guard the areas.

ATTEMPTED LAND GRAB Govt assures language martyr Barkat's family of legal assistance


Officials concerned yesterday assured the family of Language Movement martyr Shaheed Barkat of providing them legal assistance on a dispute over a piece of land given to them by the government.

Following a report published Tuesday in different dailies, including The Daily Star, Gazipur Nezarat Deputy Collector Sazid Anwar and Sadar Upazila Nirbahi Officer Fouzia Khanam visited them.

The report said Safar Ali, councillor of ward no-18 in the city, had been demanding extortion money from them, an allegation he denied.

Barkat's nephew Ain Uddin Barkat said Safar filed a case with the land office concerned saying that the people, who had been possessing the 0.68 acres of land at Kacharibari, were not the heirs of Shaheed Barkat.

US officials meet Hefajat leaders in Ctg

Officials of the US embassy in Dhaka yesterday met with the leaders of Hefajat-e-Islam at Darul Ulum Muinul Islam Madrasa, the central office of the organisation in Hathazari upazila of Chittagong.

The officials inquired about various issues including the 13-point demand of Hefajat, its organisational activities, Shapla Chittar incident of May 5 last year, and curriculum of the madrasa and Qawmi education, said a press release.

US embassy's political officer Kathleen Gabilico and assistant political expert Lubain Chowdhury Masum went to the madrasa around 10:00am and held a two-and-a-half-hour discussion.

MJF condemns Sabita Chakma's murder

Manusher Jonno Foundation (MJF) yesterday condemned the killing of indigenous woman Sabita Chakma and demanded justice in the incident.

Expressing grave concern over recurrence of such violence in Chittagong Hill Tracts, the rights body called for immediate steps to put an end to human rights violation there.

Sabita, 30, was allegedly murdered after rape at Chengi Char in Khagrachhari sadar upazila on February 15.

MOVEMENT FOR DORM RECOVERY JnU students boycott classes, exams

Jagannath University (JnU) students yesterday boycotted classes, examinations and kept the three entrances to the campus locked for nearly three hours, demanding recovery of what they claimed to be their 11 dormitories from illegal occupation.

Vice Chancellor Mizanur Rahman said they were concerned over the agitation, and informed the government authorities about the accommodation problem.

"I have informed different ministries, including land, about the illegal occupation of the dormitories. I hope a solution will come out soon," he told The Daily Star.

The agitated students said they would continue their demonstration until their halls were returned. Sirajul Islam, general secretary of JnU uni Bangladesh Chhatra League, said they would besiege the administrative

Commonwealth again calls for fresh JS polls

Its top official meets Tarique
Rahman in London

The Commonwealth has reiterated its call for a meaningful dialogue urgently among major political parties to hold a fresh, free, fair and inclusive general election in Bangladesh.

Commonwealth Deputy Secretary-General Mmasekgaoa Masire-Mwamba made the call during her meeting with BNP Senior Vice President Tarique Rahman at Commonwealth Secretariat in Marlborough House, London on Tuesday.

They discussed elaborately Bangladesh's latest political and human rights situation, and expressed grave concern
