



Demolish risky buildings

Suggests Jica team to avoid potential devastation during disasters

To avoid the potential devastation, the government should identify and demolish buildings in Dhaka Chittagong and Sylhet cities which are most vulnerable to natural disasters like earthquakes, said a Jica study team leader yesterday. Many buildings in Bangladesh, despite being rein-

forced concrete structures, are three to five times more vulnerable to such disasters than those of Japan or the United States," added Fumio Kaneko. He was presenting a paper at a workshop in a hotel in the capital, revealing three years' findings of a four-year

project, "Capacity development on natural disaster resistant techniques of construction and retrofitting for public buildings" (CNCRP). Assessing the condition of public buildings in the three cities, the project, being conducted by Public Works

Department (PWD) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (Jica), is expected to be completed by February 2015. An earthquake measuring 7.5 on the Richter scale near

Dhaka city may cause 72,000 buildings in the capital to collapse, said Kaneko, referring to a 2009 study of Comprehensive Disaster Management Programme under the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief. Moreover, some 158,000 buildings will be damaged,

organisational tour in Kurigram, came up with the remarks while talking to journalists at the local Circuit House. SEE PAGE 4 COL 6



ATIKULLAH MURDER

Former ward councillor Shahid on remand

A Dhaka court yesterday placed former councillor of ward-83 Saidur Rahman Shahid on a four-day remand in the Atikullah murder case.

Atikullah Chowdhury, 65, chairman of Kunda Union Parishad of South Keraniganj and a local Awami League leader, was killed by miscreants on December 10 last year. Senior Judicial

Magistrate Taibul Hassan passed the order after South Keraniganj police Sub-Inspector Afzal Hussain, also the investigation officer, produced him before the court with a 10day remand prayer.

The defence submitted a bail petition and sought an order for cancelling the remand prayer saying Shahid was implicated in the case as part of a conspiracy to harass him.

Teacher jailed, suspended


A teacher in Rajshahi's Godagari was suspended after being jailed for two years by a mobile court on Saturday for editing and publishing a bimonthly magazine containing a poem "which hurt religious sentiments of Hindus and Muslims".

Titumir Rishav, an assistant teacher of Pirijpur Secondary School, had not taken permission from the deputy commissioner's office for the publication, "Kheya", said Godagari Upazila Nirbahi Officer Muhammad Khalid Hossain who headed the mobile court.

Police arrested and took Titumir before the court, which jailed him under Penal Code 295, on finding
