## Ex-principal arrested on extortion charge

Abdul Malek Akand, former principal of Moukaran BLP Degree College in Patuakhali Sadar upazila, was arrested yesterday on extortion charge.

Police arrested him from a house in Shantibagh area of Patuakhali town at around 6:00am. He was produced in a court that sent him to jail.

Police sources said Abdul Malek went on retirement on December 31, 2013, but he didn't hand over the charge to acting principal Syed Md. Babur.

Later, he handed over the charge to the acting principal as per directive of the deputy commissioner, also the chairman of the college governing body.

On January 16, a gang led by Noor Ahmed Evan, son of Abdul Malek, entered the college at around 11:00am and gave life threat to the acting principal for taking over the charge from his father. At that time, Jasim Uddin, a lecturer of the college, was present in the principal's room and protested the incident.

On March 15, Abdul

Malek and his son Evan demanded Tk 2 lakh from Jasim Uddin. As he refused to pay heed to the demand, Malek and his son assaulted Jasim on the college campus snatched Tk 10,500 from him.

Jasim filed a case with Patuakhali Police Station on the day, accusing Malek and his son. Police arrested Malek from Shantibagh area while Evan is at large.

Contacted, Officer-in-Charge Md Monirul Islam of Patuakhali Police Station said they are looking for Malek's son Evan.

## One killed, 20 hurt in clash over land dispute

A man was killed and 20 others were injured in a clash between two rival groups over land dispute at Dighirpara village in Pirganj upazila on Tuesday.

The deceased was identified as Abdul Halim, 35, son of Abbas Ali of the village in the upazila.

Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Abdul Halim and Mizanur Rahman, 40, son of Abdur Rahman of Potnichara village over the land.

On Tuesday afternoon, a group of men, allegedly led by Mizanur, equipped with sharp weapons went to damage the standing crops on the land but they were resisted by Halim and his brothers, prompting the clash.

At least 21 people from both sides were injured during the incident. Of them, Halim died on way to the upazila health complex.

Two other injured--Shahanur Alam, 30, and Raju Mian, 28--were admitted to Rangpur Medical College and Hospital in critical condition.

Four people were arrested in connection with the murder, said MM Moinul Islam, officer in-charge of Pirganj police station.

The arrestees are Bablu Mian, 45, son of late Amiruddin, Mobasser Mian, 35, son of Mozahar Ali, Shamsul Haque, 32, son of Bachchu Mian of Baro Alampur village and Faruk Ahmed, 29, son of Kofil Uddin of Ullagari village in the upazila.

The body was sent to the hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

## 7 idols burnt as criminals set temple afire

Seven idols were burnt as criminals set a Hindu temple ablaze at Adhuna village in Gournadi upazila of the district early yesterday.

After worshipping, the priest left the tin-shed Durga-Kali temple at 10:30pm on Monday, said Satindranath Chakraborty, president of Senerhut Durga-Kali Mandir management committee.

In the morning, the worshippers found the burnt idols of Durga, Sarswati, Laxmi, Kartik, Ganesh, Ashur and Kali and informed the police.

A gang set the temple to fire by pouring petrol at midnight, said Satindranath Chakraborty.

A case was filed in connection with the incident, said Abul Kalam, officer in-charge of Gournadi police station.

## Body exhumed one month after burial

The body of a man was exhumed for autopsy yesterday, over a month after his burial.

Following a court order, the body of Shahinur Rahman, 35, of Purbo Kanaipara village in Puthia upazila was exhumed from the family graveyard and taken to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital morgue and buried back in the afternoon after examination, said Abu Obaida Khan, OC of Puthia police station.

On November 1 last year, Shahinur was seriously injured in an attack allegedly by his relatives over land dispute.

He was admitted to the upazila health complex where he died on February 19 this year, said deceased's brother Mizanur Rahman.

## 14 get infected with anthrax

At least 14 people have been infected with anthrax, a bacterial disease that spreads from cattle, at Raghunathpur village in Raiganj upazila of Sirajganj district.

On information, a medical team from the Institute of Epidemiology, Disease Control and Research (IEDCR) visited the village on Tuesday and found them infected with the viral disease after the test.

"They contacted the disease while slaughtering a sick cow," Dr M Mushtuq Husain, principal scientific officer at the IEDCR in Dhaka yesterday said.

They are now undergoing treatment at Raiganj Upazila Health Complex, he said,

adding that "Relevant antibiotic can cure the infected patients in five to seven days."

The medical team urged the village not to slaughter any sick cow, he said.

Sirajganj Civil Surgeon Dr Mainuddin said experts from IEDCR collected samples from the patients for further test.

Health department, Raiganj upazila administration and livestock department officials held an urgent meeting in the upazila on Tuesday for creating awareness among the locals.

Livestock department will examine the animals of the village and take immediate initiatives, if necessary, Dr Mainuddin said.

## 40 houses gutted

At least 40 houses were gutted in a devastating fire at Munshiganj village in Daulatpur upazila on Tuesday.

Locals said the fire originated from a stove of kitchen of a house at the

bordering village around 2:00pm and soon engulfed the adjacent other houses.

Hearing the fire news, local people rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after one hour of frantic efforts as fire fighting unit did not come to the spot it being a remote area.

## Schoolgirl kidnapped in Bandarban

Boy rescued 4 days into abduction in Thakurgaon

Police are yet to rescue a schoolgirl, who was abducted from Jolpaitali area under Tombro mouja in Nykkhongchhari upazilla of Bandarban district five days ago.

The victim comes from a Hindu family, reports our correspondent.

Family sources said one Md Ibrahim, a tea shop owner of Tambru Bazar area, often teased the girl on her way to school.

On March 29, Ibrahim along with his associates Bashir Ahamad and Murshida Begum kidnapped the girl from Jolpaitali area while she was going to school, said the victim's father.

Contacted, sub-inspector Bachhu Mia, in-charge of Tambru police camp, said police are raiding different areas to rescue the girl.

Away in Panchagarh, the law enforcers rescued a minor boy from Phultala Bazar area in Boda upazila yesterday, four days after his abduction, reports our Thakurgaon correspondent.

They also arrested one Azharul Islam, 27, son of Md Khalilur Rahman of Sardarpara village in Sadar upazila in connection with the abduction.

The victim is Md Soyaeb Rahman Saad, 6, son of Md Mazedur Rahman of Dhamor village in Atwary upazila.

Police and locals said Azharul picked up the boy from a wedding ceremony of the victim's cousin at Dhamor on Saturday afternoon and took him to Phultala Bazar area.

Azharul then demanded Tk 10 lakh ransom from the family members of Soyaeb. After the incident, the victim's family contacted the abductor's relatives.

A general diary was also filed with Atwary police station in connection with the abduction, said the inspector (investigation) of the PS.

With the help of Azharul's younger brother Ahsan Habib, Soyaeb was rescued from the area. The law enforcers also arrested the abductor, said the inspector.
