MP assaults newsman at C'nawabganj

Journalists of Chapainawabganj have decided to boycott all programmes of Abdul Odud, lawmaker from Chapainawabganj-3 (Sadar) constituency, as he assaulted a local journalist at the office of Sadar upazila primary education office in the town yesterday.

Around 10:30am, Emran Faruk Masum, district correspondent of the Dainik Jugantor and private television channel RTV, went to collect news as Debesh Sarkar, assistant director of the Directorate of Primary Education, came to investi-

gate alleged irregularities and corruption of a primary school headmaster in the town, said Masum and witnesses.

Local lawmaker Abdul Odud and Emran Faruk Masum engaged in a heated exchange in presence of the officials there.

"At one stage, the lawmaker and his associate assaulted me. Officials present there tried to save me, but failed. Then I fled away to the upazila chairman's office for safety," said Masum.

Contacted, Abdul Odud, lawmaker of Chapainawabganj-3 constituency said, "I beat Masum as he misbehaved

with me."

Immediately after the incident, journalists of Chapainawabganj Press Club and Chapainawabganj Zila Press Club gathered at Town Club and decided to form a human chain in the town today and boycott all programmes of the lawmaker in protest at the incident.

Abdus Sattar Sarkar, district primary education officer, said the investigation official came to Chapainawabganj for investigation after a man lodged complaint with the Directorate of Primary Education against the headmaster of a government primary school in the town.

Jamaat leader sent to jail

A court here on Wednesday sent Ishwardi Jamaat Ameer Golam Rabbani Khan Jubayer to jail after rejecting his bail prayer. He was defeated in the recent upazila parishad election on March 23 as chairman candidate. Jubayer was accused in 17 cases including for vandalism and arson attack, said officer in-charge of Ishwardi police station Biman Kumar Das. He was absconding since long, said the OC.

Driver strangled

Police recovered the body of a CNG run auto-rickshaw driver from Karatoa River area at Gokul in Bogra-Rangpur highway on Wednesday night. The deceased is Ali, 17, son of Rezaul Karim of Amtoli in Shibganj upazila. A gang of snatchers in guise of boarded Ali's vehicle from the town and strangled him and dumped the body in the area, suspected police. They are investigating the matter, said officer in-charge (investigation) of Sadar police station Nur-e-Alam Siddiki. The body was sent to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

13 hurt in clash

At least 13 people, including five women, were injured in clash between two rival groups over land dispute in Chirirbandar upazila yesterday. The injured Kalipada Roy, 67, Dipak Kumar Roy Babul, 48, Koilash Chandra Roy, 45, son of late Nrisingh Roy, Dulal Chandra Roy, 42 and Bhaskar Chandra Roy, sons of Kalipada, Hridoy Kumar Roy, 45, son of Hariprosad Chandra Roy, Ratan Kuman Roy, 44, son of Kalimohan Chandra Roy, Sandhya Rani Roy, 48, wife of Laxmi Kanta Roy, Ranu Bala Roy, wife of Ratan Kuman Roy, Ganobala Roy, 35, wife of Hridoy Chandra Roy of Chhoto Baul village and Khademul Islam, 30, son of Md Joynal Abedin, Monowara Begum, 40, wife of Md Alauddin and Moktara Begum, 42, wife of Md Azizur Rahman of Mohadi village. They were admitted to the upazila health complex. Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Kalipada Roy and Azizur Rahman of Chhoto Baul village over the land. As a sequel to the conflict, the supporters of the duo attacked each other with lethal weapons, leaving 13 from both sides injured.

Microbus torched

Criminals torched a microbus at Ruhea village in Sadar upazila early yesterday. Locals said the gang set fire to the vehicle of one businessman Shahirul Islam parked in front of his house by pouring petrol and fled the scene. Police suspected that the incident took place due to previous enmity.

Two 'commit suicide'

Two people, including a teenage girl, allegedly committed suicide in Bochaganj upazila yesterday. The deceased are Taposhi Roy, 14, daughter of Bardhan Roy, Borthapur village and Ashrafal Haque, 25, son of Abdul Haque of Krishthapur village. The two took their lives by hanging, said family members. The bodies were sent to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. However, the reason behind the suicides could not be known, said police.

13 bombs found in mosque

Police seized 13 petrol bombs from a mosque in Maniknagar area under Kolaroa upazila on Wednesday night. Munshi Mofazzal Hossain, officer in-charge of Kolaroa police station, said on information, a team seized the bombs from Maniknagar Jam-e-Masjid in an abandoned condition. However, none was arrested in this connection, said the OC.

Ten houses gutted

At least 10 houses were gutted in a fire at Porshurampur-Mulipara village under Pirganj upazila early Tuesday. Three people, including a minor boy, were also injured in the fire incident. Shahadat Hossain, acting station officer of Pirganj fire service and civil defense said the fire originated from mosquito coil at the cattle room of Golap Mian of the village at 1:30am and soon engulfed the adjoining houses. On information, fire fighters rushed in and doused the blaze after one hour of frantic efforts. The affected house owners claimed that the loss caused by the fire could go up to Tk 20 lakh.

'Robber' held with arms

Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested an alleged robber along with a revolver and one bullet from Adarsha Ayesha School ground at Hujarapur village in Sadar upazila early Wednesday. The arrestee is Anwar Hossain, son of Babar Ali, a resident of Ichhali village of the upazila. DB police sources said tipped off that a gang of robbers was preparing to commit a robbery in the area, a team of DB police launched a drive there at about 1:30 am and arrested the robber while others managed to flee.

Two accused in Saad murder case held

BAU students stage demonstration demanding expulsion of those involved in the killing

Police on Wednesday night arrested two of the accused in the case for killing BAU (Bangladesh Agricultural University) student Saad Ibney Momtaza from Patgudam area of Mymensingh.

The arrestees are Sujoy Kumar Kundu, ex-organising secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) Ashrafal Haque Hall unit of the university, and party activist Md Rukonuzzaman Rukon.

Police arrested them following a case filed by the university authorities with Mymensingh Sadar Police Station the same night.

Sujoy and Rokon were produced in a court that sent them to jail.

Contacted, Vice-Chancellor Prof Md Rafiqul Hoque said process is on to

expel the students involved in the killing of Saad.

Students of the university staged demonstration on the campus for the second day yesterday, demanding immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of all the accused in Saad murder case.

Thousands of students of all faculties boycotted their classes and examinations in the morning and staged a sit-in in front of the administrative building.

Expressing solidarity with the agitating students, Bangladesh Agricultural University Teachers' Association (BAUTA) also brought out a procession on the campus, demanding immediate arrest of the killers of Saad.

A gang of 10 to 12 BCL activists, led by Sujoy Kumar Kundu and Rukonuzzaman Rokon, called Saad, a final

year student of the fisheries faculty, to room No 205/A of the dormitory around 6:30pm on Monday and beat him up brutally with hockey sticks, cricket stumps and iron rods.

As the victim's condition deteriorated, the attackers called in Dr Abul Kalam Azad of the university healthcare centre. The physician sent Saad to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) for better treatment.

On information, police on Tuesday morning went to the Trauma Centre in the town and found the body of the BAU student. Law enforcers sent the body to the MMCH for an autopsy.

Sources at Trauma Centre said some students admitted Saad to the centre around 6:30am on Tuesday. But he succumbed to his injuries around 11:00am.
