

# Storms damage 400 houses in Habiganj, Netrakona

Storms lashed Netrakona and Habiganj districts on Wednesday night, damaging over 400 houses and injuring 30 people.

Our Netrakona correspondent reported that at least 400 houses were damaged as nor'wester swept through 22 villages in Netrakona municipality, Sadar and Durgapur upazilas.

The affected villages are Khotibnagua, Bolainagua under Netrakona municipality; Tator and Kumiri in Sadar upazila; and Shreepur, Rambari and Jhail in Durgapur upazila.

Several hundred trees and electric poles were uprooted during the storm that continued for an hour from 11:00pm. Power supply in storm-hit areas could not be restored as 2:00 pm yesterday.

In Habiganj, storm lashed four villages under Madhabpur upazila of Habiganj district, damaging at least 30 houses and injuring ten people, reports our Moulvibazar correspondent.

The affected villages were Paromanandapur, Rosulpur Itakhola and Surma Tea garden area.

The twister accompanied by hail and rain hit the areas

at around 11:00pm and lasted for an hour. Irriboro paddy was badly damaged while a good number of trees and electric poles were uprooted.

Palli Bidyut Samity reinstalled the electric polls and restored power supply in the storm-hit areas yesterday noon.

Local union parishad chairman has prepared a list of the affected families to submit it to the upazila Nirbahi officer.

Madhabpur Upazila Parishad Chairman Syed Md Shahjahan visited the villages yesterday and assured the affected families of all possible help.

# Transport strike on in Thakurgaon, Panchagarh

Workers vandalise several battery-run three-wheelers

Buses went off the roads and highways in Thakurgaon and Panchagarh districts as transport owners and workers continued strike for the second day yesterday.

In Thakurgaon, transport workers put up barricades on different roads and damaged several battery-run three-wheelers in the town. They also blocked roads by turning tyres at different points.

A group of transport workers led by Md Babul and Entazul Haque, leaders of Thakurgaon Transport Owners Association and Thakurgaon Transport Workers Association, vandalised the three-wheelers on the road in front of Art Gallery and at Muthurapur intersection at around 11:30am.

On information, police rushed to the spot and dispersed the transport workers.

Transport owners and workers enforced an indefinite bus strike on all routes in

Thakurgaon and Panchagarh districts from Tuesday morning, demanding immediate ban on plying of unauthorised shallow engine-run Nasiman, Kariman and Bhotbhoti on roads and highways.

Transport Owners and Workers Coordination Committee announced the strike programme after an emergency meeting held at the office of Thakurgaon Transport Owners Association at 8:00pm on Monday.

The strike caused immense sufferings to the commuters and the HSC examinees.

In Panchagarh, local and long route buses did not left Panchagarh yesterday. Transport workers took out processions in different areas of the districts and put up barricades on roads.

Leaders of Panchagarh Transport Owners Association and Workers Union also demanded immediate steps to stop toll collection from trucks at Banglabandha Land Port by port Workers Union.

# Land disputes leave 2 dead in Rajshahi, Sirajganj

Two people were killed in clashes over land dispute in Sirajganj and Rajshahi districts on Tuesday.

In Sirajganj, a man was killed and five others were injured in a clash over taking control of a disputed land in Kazipur upazila on Tuesday night.

The deceased is Dudu Miah, 70, of Shalgram village in the upazila, reports our Pabna correspondent.

Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Dudu Miah Gong and Musa Matobar Gong of the area over the land.

As a sequel to the conflict, the supporters of the duo attacked each other with lethal weapons, leaving at least six people from both sides injured at 6:30pm on Tuesday.

Of the injured, Dudu was rushed to the upazila health complex where he died at 7:30pm.

The body was sent to

Sirajganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy, said officer in-charge of Kazipur police station Md Abdul Jalil.

Three people were arrested in connection with the incident, said the OC.

Away in Rajshahi, a man was hacked to death allegedly by his neighbours over land dispute at Bhatpara Krishnapur village in Puthia upazila on Tuesday night.

The deceased was identified as Sadhan Kumar, 35, son of Bhoresh of the village, reports UNB.

Sadhan's wife Joytsna said there had been a longstanding conflict between her husband and their neighbour Nitai over the ownership of the land.

On the fateful day, Sadhan had an altercation with Nitai over the issue around 10:00pm.

At one stage, Nitai along with his wife, daughter and son attacked Sadhan with sharp weapons, leaving him dead on the spot.

# 3 BNP-Jaamat men held with bombs in Dinajpur

Police arrested two Shibir and one BNP activists along with four bombs in Ghoraghat upazila of the district yesterday.

The arrestees are Shibir men Md Humayun Kabir, 26, son of Enamul Haque of Nurpur village and Muktar Hossain, 25, son of Abdullah Al Kafi of Boldiyapara village and BNP activist Mofazzal Hossain of the area.

Police said upazila BNP held a programme to accord a reception to newly elected upazila parishad chairman Shah Md Shamim Hossain Chowdhury at upazila parishad complex.

The programme was scheduled to be held in the afternoon but a large number of BNP and Shibir men started gathering at the venue since morning in the name of providing security to the chairman.

On suspicion, the law enforcers challenged the trio and seized the bombs from their possession

around 1:00pm.

Following the incident, additional police personnel have been deployed in the area to avert further trouble, said Forhad Imrul Kayes, officer in-charge of Ghoraghat police station.

A process to file a case in this connection was underway till filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday, said the OC.

Meanwhile, police arrested Kotchandpur upazila vice chairman in Jhenidah district yesterday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

Arrestee Moabia Hossain, also the upazila Jamaat secretary, is son of late Mohammad Ali of Kotchandpur railway stationpara.

Officer in-charge Fazlur Rahman of Kotchandpur police station said the newly elected vice chairman was arrested on the upazila premises around 1:00pm.

The OC, however, could not give any details immediately regarding his arrest.
