

# Woman garments worker beaten up by official, hospitalised

Mercilessly beaten by boss, a female garments worker is groaning in pain at Nilphamari 100-bed hospital.

The victim is Mina Akhtar, 20, a worker (ID No 2308) of production section of 'Section Seven International Ltd', a garments factory in Uttara Export Processing Zone (EPZ) in Nilphamari.

She is the daughter of Hashem Munshi, 55, of Shalhati village of Dimla upazila in the district. "The floor in charge of the factory, Al Helal Khan

called me for some matter on Wednesday noon. As I made a little delay to reach him, he hurled abuses and beat me mercilessly, leaving me injured and unable to continue work that day," said Mina, lying on the floor of the female ward of the hospital, when this correspondent visited her yesterday morning.

"I came back to my rented house at Sangolshi village beside the EPZ. As I was crying in severe pain, some locals brought me to Nilphamari hospital," she said.

Rubi Begum, staff nurse working at the female ward

of the hospital, said there were injury marks on the victim's body.

As this correspondent talked to K Mamun-ur-Rashid, chief coordinator of 'Section Seven International Ltd', he admitted the incident and said the accused floor in charge was served warning notice for his offence.

Contacted over cell phone, SM Aktarul Alam Mostafi, general manager of Uttara EPZ, said he was too busy to talk on the matter.

The victim's family sources said they were preparing to file a case with the local police station.

## STORM LASHES GOURIPUR UPAZILA OF MYMENSINGH One killed, 10 injured in madrasa collapse

Storm lashed three villages in Gouripur upazila of the district early yesterday, killing a boy and injuring ten others.

The storm-hit villages are Teroshira, Kandulia and Pumbail under Ramgopalpur union of the upazila.

The dead was identified as Habibur Rahman Nayeem, 10, a student of Shahadat Uloom Madrasa at Teroshira village.

Police and locals said a norwester accompanied by hail hit the villages at around 4:00am and continued for half an hour. The worst affected village is

Teroshira where a madrasa and 25 tin-roofed houses were damaged.

Nayeem, son of Shamsul Haque of Teroshira village, died on the spot and 10 other students of the madrasa sustained injuries as the institution collapsed during the storm, said Md Hamidur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Gouripur Police Station.

The storm also damaged Irri-boro and other crops at the affected villages, said Aminul Islam Sidker, chairman of Ramgopalpur Union parishad.

Of the injured students, Baharul Islam, 12, Asad, 13, Manik, 9, Mustafiz, 12, Rewan, 14, Mehedi, 10 and

Russel, 11, were admitted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital while the rest were given first aid at the upazila health complex.

UNB reported that lightning killed two people in Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj and Rajnagar upazila of Moulvibazar districts on Wednesday.

The deceased were identified as Abdus Sobhan, 70, of Majumdarichar village in Chhatak upazila, and Rashed Ahmed, 13, son of Sayed Miah, of Sarampur village in Rajnagar upazila.

# Two forest robbers to die for murder

A court here yesterday sentenced two forest robbers to death for killing two brothers in Sharankhola upazila of the district in 2004.

Those awarded death penalty are Julfikar Ali alias Julfu, son of Habib Matabbor of Jaymoni village, and Oli alias Raju, son of Jalal Mollah of Amratala village in Mongla upazila.

District and Sessions Judge SM Solaiman of the court passed the verdict in absence of the duo.

According to the prosecution, the two siblings --

Anwar Hawlader and Harun Hawlader--went to Shela River near Sundarbans for fishing on October 17, 2004 and remained missing.

Six days later, the body of Anwar was recovered from the char area near the river.

Badsha Hawlader, elder brother of the deceased, filed a murder case with Mongla police station accusing some unidentified people.

Sub-Inspector Abul Hossain, also the investigation officer of the case submitted a charge sheet before the court against Julfikar and Oli on December 12 in 2005.

# Upazila health complex in poor health

Companiganj health complex in the district is miserably failing to provide proper services to the patients due to acute shortage of doctors and for want of other logistics.

Although there are posts of nine doctors at the health complex, only five doctors are struggling to provide treatment to a large number of patients in the upazila having a population of around 1.5 lakh people.

The health centre is running without resident medical officer for long.

The X-ray machine at the hospital has been lying out

of order for long, forcing the patients to go to the district town or private clinics to do the test, sources said.

A large number of patients, most of them women and children, every day come to the hospital as out-patients with different problems but most do not get treatment facilities due to shortage of doctors.

Moreover, the ambulance of the health complex also lying out of order for the last five years, adding to the sufferings of the patients.

The patients are being compelled to go to Sadar Hospital or private clinics, locals said.

During a recent visit to the hospital, this correspondent found that Nur Nahar, 26, of Chhanbaria Bazar village, who came to the hospital with severe gynecological problem, did not get any treatment due to non-availability of doctors.

Two other patients-Rina, 35 and Samiran, 45 - alleged that they were also not getting proper treatment at the hospital.

Medical officer Dr AKM Rezwatul Islam admitted that it had become difficult for them to attend a large number of patients everyday amid acute shortage of doctors.

A Jamaat man and a madrasa boy were hacked to death in Sirajganj and Jhenidah districts on Wednesday.

In Sirajganj, criminals killed a local activist of Jamaat-e-Islami at Chardhuli village in Belkuchi upazila on Wednesday night.

The deceased was identified as Alamgir Hossain, 35, son of Buddu Mia of the village, reports UNB.

Police said a gang attacked Alamgir with sharp weapons while he was returning home from a local market around 9:00pm. He died on the spot.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to Sirajganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Away in Jhenidah, a madrasa student, who sustained injuries in an attack by gang in the district town last month, died at Dhaka Medical College and Hospital (DMCH) on Wednesday, reports our correspondent.

The deceased is Jihad Hossain, 16, son of Abdur Rashid Mia of Baliadanga village in Saikupa upazila. He was a student of class ten at Aminia Alim Madrasa in the town.
