Hossain Panjer, 55 was vice-president of Mirpur Police recovered the body of a madrasa boy from upazila unit of JSD.

Police quoted witness as saying that a gang of four sprayed bullets on Panjer when he along with two others was sitting at a tea stall at the village around 6:00am. Panjer died instantly. One Safi Mondol, 40, of

the village received bullet wounds during the attack. He is undergoing treatment at Kushtia Medical College Hospital.

Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu, also JSD chief, visited the house of the slain JSD leader in the afternoon. Sahidul Islam, officer-in-

charge of Mirpur Police Station, said Panjer was a regional leader of outlawed Gono Bahini and involved in criminal activities.

Panjer was arrested twice-February 12, 2009 and September 1, 2011-with arms and ammunition. Later, he was granted bail in both cases.
