Request for Expressions of Interest (REOI)

For Selection of a Consulting Firm for the Design, Development, Implementation and Support of a Web-based Management Information System (MIS) (Package No. SD 20)

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) (IDA Credit No. 448.BD) towards the cost of the Services for Children at Risk (SCAR) Project.

The objectives of the assignment are to design, develop, test, pilot and implement a Management Information System (MIS) for managing and supporting the services provided by the JPUF through the IDSCs, and for supporting three social protection allowance programmes that are administered through the DSS's District offices.

The MIS Firm must undertake a full system requirements study in close cooperation with relevant DSS and JPUF staff, as one of the first parts of the assignment, to establish and capture in detail in a System Requirements Specification (SRS) document the user and technical requirements that must be met by the MIS.

- i) Beneficiary registration and case management support for disability services provided by the JPUF and the IDSCs;
ii) Beneficiary registration support for social protection programme allowances provided by the DSS;
iii) Improving the broader institutional capacity of the MoSW for training, monitoring and evaluation of child protection and disability issues.

The services shall be completed over approximately eighteen (18) months which is expected to commence in September 2014 and end by February 2016.

The Department of Social Services (DSS) of the MoSW now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to submit their Expressions of Interest (EOI) for providing the required services. Interested consultants must provide information with documentary evidences (Brochures, description of assignments of similar nature, experience in similar conditions, financial resources, availability of appropriate skills among the staff, etc.) demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services.

- a) Registration of the firm (Country of Registration).
b) Age of the firm in business specific to assignment.
c) Availability of key professional staff members of the firm (list of management and key personnel), indication whether the staff is a member of the firm or an independent consultant, and the number of years spent working for the firm.
d) Turnover of the consultant.
e) Experience of the consultant in similar field.
f) Experience of the consultant in other works/assignments.
g) Experience in providing consulting services and excellent track record of completion of tasks according to time lines.
h) Experience with donor-funded projects.
i) Support services of the consultant.

Minimum qualification and experience of key professional staffs whose detailed CVs with background of education and experience, staff time to be spent on the project must be submitted along with the expression of interest. Agencies with (i) prior knowledge, experience of child protection and or related social welfare issues; and (ii) government procedures including a proven track record of working with government, will be given, preference.

Consultants (firms) may associate to enhance their qualification, but should mention whether the association is in the form of a 'joint venture' or a 'sub-consultancy'. In the case of an association, all number of firms including the associates should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment and in such 'association,' it is preferable to limit the total number of firms including the associates to a maximum of four.

A consultant (firm) will be selected using the Quality & Cost Based Selection (QCBS) sub-method as set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011. A short list of firm will be prepared from the expressions of interest for issuing Request for Proposals (RFP) for this assignment.

Interested consultants may obtain the Terms of Reference (TOR) to have detail information on the scope of service key personnel requirements, deliverables and others from the address below from 9:00am to 5:00pm local time or through email upon request. The authority reserves the right to accept any, or reject any or all EOIs, of annuls the procurement process without assigning any reason thereof.

Expressions of Interest shall be submitted on or before May 05, 2014 during office hours in sealed envelopes delivered to the address below and be clearly marked 'Request for Expression of Interest for Selection of a Consulting Firm for 'Design, Development, Implementation and Support of a Web-based Management Information System (MIS) Package No. SD 20'.
