

# ROBBERY IN CAPITAL Three of a family severely injured

## Five detained for interrogation

Three members of a family were seriously injured in an attack by robbers who also looted valuables from their house in the capital's Jatrabari early yesterday.

The victims, Nargis Begum, 35, her husband Mullak Chan, 45, and their daughter Muna Akter, 18, were shifted to the National Institute of Traumatology and Orthopedic Rehabilitation (Nitor) from Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

All fingers of Nargis's right hand and the thumb of her left hand were cut off in the attack. Muna sustained severe head injury while her father in the face, said Akram Hossain, nephew of Mullak.

Six to seven masked robbers entered the house at Kazla breaking open its door around 3:00am. When they tried to resist the criminals, they hacked and beat them up mercilessly, he said.

The miscreants fled the house with the booties within a few moments, said Akram but he could not ascertain the amount of the valuables immediately.

Police detained four people in connection with the robbery for interrogation, said sub-inspector Shuvash Akter of Jatrabari Police Station.

# Destiny top bosses denied bail

A Dhaka court yesterday rejected bail petitions of Destiny Group Managing Director Mohammad Rafiqul Amin and Destiny 2000 Ltd Chairman Mohammad Hossain in two money laundering cases.

Metropolitan Magistrate Meher Nigar Suchona passed the order saying the court had no jurisdiction to grant bail to any accused in the money laundering cases.

Moreover, they duo had confessed their involvement in laundering investors money.

On July 31 of 2012, the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) filed the cases against 22 company officials, including the two, for laundering Tk 3,285.26 crore by cheating investors.

On August 6 the same year, Rafiqul Amin and Mohammad Hossain got bail from the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka on their surrender.

But Dhaka Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court on September 27 of 2012 cancelled their bail following appeals filed by the ACC challenging the legality of the lower court order.

Later on October 11 the same year, the same court sent them to jail after their surrender again before it seeking bail in the cases.

Our Chuadanga correspondent adds, Abdur Rashid, 38, succumbed to his injuries at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital Wednesday night after his running motorbike had skidded off Kushtia-Alamdanga road at Dambulpur in Alamdanga upazila Tuesday afternoon.

PRAYERS, PROTEST IN SYLHET



not forced to become taxi drivers." International Organisation for Migration organised the event.

The government should urge other countries to include domestic workers into their labour law, said the foreign secretary.

"In addition it must be brought to notice that when states discourage migrants even when there is a demand for migrant labour, they do not stop migration - they just make it more hazardous," he said.

Begum Shamsunnahar, director general of Bureau of Manpower, Employment and Training said asset transfer must be eased through.

She further said in many countries it is still not possible to send remittance beyond a certain amount.

The migrants must be given investment benefits so that they are encouraged to invest their remittances in their homeland, said Riaz Hamidullah, director general of Economic Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The home country must ensure that workers are not exploited, added Qazi Kholiuzzaman Ahmad, chairman of Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation.

Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment Minister Khandker Mosharraf Hossain also spoke in the event.

The global forum will be held from May 14 to 16.

will send a copy to the EC. If any candidate violates the law, he or she will face a punishment of two to seven years' imprisonment along with paying financial penalties, according to the law.

Although the 30-day deadline expired more than two months ago, the EC has no concrete information on how many candidates have submitted expenditure statements.

The returning officers have been asked to provide the information to the commission by April 30, according to a letter signed by Mizanur Rahman, senior assistant secretary of the EC Secretariat.

"It may be that many candidates submitted their expenditure statements to their respective returning officers, but the copy is yet to reach the commission. That is why we have directed the returning officers to give proper information," Mizanur Rahman told The Daily Star.


