This is the best time to kill the insects by spraying pesticides, he said.
Prof Razzab said mealybugs might have migrated to Bangladesh in plants smuggled from African countries or in large military convoys.
The expert advised that the government seriously consider curbing the pest before it spreads all over the country and affects crop production.
In Bangladesh, mealybug infestations are seen in host plants like mango, jackfruit, citrus, papaya, brinjal, guava, tamarind, and rain tree.
Infested plants or plant parts grow weak and then wither or may die eventually.

Sunday when Sirajul was facing breathing complications, and did not shift him to the incentive care unit (ICU) as required. All these led to his death, they said.
Doctors denied the allegation, and observed work stoppage on Tuesday-Wednesday, protesting the alleged assault.

They called off the strike, which caused immense sufferings to hundreds of patients, after withdrawal of Dhaka district Additional Superintendent of Police ABM Masud Hossain, a cousin of Nasrinn, who allegedly instigated the assault on Sunday.
The Birdem doctors will observe an hour of symbolic work abstention today and wear black badges, protesting the "attack" on physicians, said Dr Purabi Devnath of the hospital. They are going to file a court case tomorrow, she told The Daily Star.

Birdem authorities, meanwhile, formed a committee to probe the matter.
