DNA tests create scope for closure

"Though we were informed about the DNA results six months back, we only received the relevant paper in February," said Mohammad Abu Bakar, brother of Rashida.

Bakar said his sister-in-law and he had looked for the body desperately for one and a half months since the collapse on April 24 last year but failed and returned home empty handed.

"While staying in Dhaka, I spent Tk 10,000 from my savings and sold out two cows to bear the expenses of accommodation," said Bakar, who had to sell two other cows to run his family.

"My father wanted to come along with us to see the grave at least for once but failed because the money we had did not afford the cost of three."

About financial help, Bakar, an agricultural labourer, said they got Tk 1 lakh three months ago from the upazila parishad but spent all the money on prayers and distributing food among the poor and orphans.

"This is her money...I want her to rest in eternal peace in the afterlife," said he said, quoting his mother.

Rozina Khatun, sister of finishing operator Poppy Banu, another Rana Plaza deceased, fell to her knees by her sister's grave.

"I lost my mother just two years back, and my sister asked me to stay in the village with my paralysed father and would send money for the family," she said.

Rozina said she came to the graveyard with her uncle for the first time. "I'm now totally helpless as my sister was my only support after the death of my mother."

She said they not only lost their sister but their brother-in-law in the disaster that claimed some 1,135 lives. "Though I have a 20-year-old brother, he could not work for hearing impairment."

Different organisations placed wreaths at the victims' graves in Jurain, held prayers and Qurankwani, and distributed food among the poor.

SC upholds Shibir men's acquittal

The HC on April 17 acquitted Shibir men -- Sajjad Hossain Khan, Alamgir Kabir Manik, Azam and Md Solaiman -- condemned to death by a Chittagong court for killing eight people, including six Bangladesh Chhatra League activists, in the port city about 14 years ago.

The HC acquitted them saying that the charges brought against them were not proved, as none of the witnesses saw them shooting the eight people at Bahodderhat in the port city in July 2000.

Demanding the expulsion of Saad's killers from the university and their immediate arrest, the students have been continuing the agitation since April 2.

Meanwhile, the protesters placed a memorandum to BAU Vice-Chancellor Prof Dr Md Rafiqul Hoque Wednesday night.

They said they were not satisfied with the assurance given by the VC regarding restoration of congenial atmosphere on the campus, provoking them to pour blood.

The VC said he had asked the agitating students to go back to their classes. Earlier, on April 9, the BAU authorities expelled three students and suspended three others for their alleged involvement in the murder following the first investigation committee report submitted on April 8, said Md Abdul Khaled, registrar of the university.

Later police arrested two of the accused -- Md Rokonzaman and Shojoy Kumar Kundu -- on April 3, while four others are still on the run.

Govt misusing Rana Plaza

FROM PAGE 3 killed and scores more were injured when the mine-storey Rana Plaza building in Savar collapsed on April 24, 2013.

PM's Special Assistant Mahbulul Hoque Shakil on Wednesday said the Relief and Welfare Fund of the prime minister for the victims was operated with the "highest transparency and accountability." He said already Tk 22.13 crore was distributed among injured workers and families of the deceased.

Without giving any detail, Fakhrul also accused the government of destabilising the country's garments industry at present.

The defence also claimed that Hussain gave deposition against his client as per the instruction of former social welfare minister Enamul Haque Mostafa Shahid who lost to Qaisar in 1986's general election. Hussain refuted the claim.

Earlier, Hussain's younger brother Shah Hasan Ali, as the seventh prosecution witness in the case gave almost identical description of the incidents. Qaisar, a state minister during the regime of HM Ershad, is facing 16 war crimes charges. The proceeding of the case was adjourned until April 28.

He made the remarks during a discussion of Rumi Forum, a US think tank promoting global peace, in Washington DC.

Responding to a question, he said the 10th parliamentary elections saw a 40 per cent voter turnout and that the elections results had both domestic and international ramifications.

Domestically, he said, it was a victory of secular and democratic forces over the extremist and reactionary forces. He claimed that the new government had received significant international supports.

Qader also commended BNP's decision to cease violence and participate in upazila elections, which "proves the credibility of the existing election mechanism".

About the International Crime Tribunals-Bangladesh, he said the government incorporated suggestions from outside observers to ensure international legal standards.

He also said the government was steadfast to preserve human rights and freedom of media.

Police arrested a total of 21 persons involved in the collapse, he told the press conference at home ministry in the capital.

Eight of them got bail from the High Court, he added.

At least 1,135 people, mostly RMG workers, were killed and scores more were injured when the 10-storey building collapsed on April 24, 2013.

Assuring that the probe will be completed very soon, Inspector General of Police Hasan Mahmud Khandaker said a total of four cases had already been filed in this connection and charge sheets had been given in two cases.

High officials of different forces and security agencies were present.

A one-minute silence was observed for the Rana Plaza victims.

FROM PAGE 5 about the village level "lok adalat" (court of the common people), where disputes are settled across the table on consensus basis, and the legal aid clinics that give primary solution and advice.

He said women were given preference while recruiting paralegal volunteers for the legal aid clinics. "A man can only go up to the door. A woman has much more entry into the house, and it is easier for them to understand the problems."

In their efforts to make the legal system accessible, mobile vans with a little court inside and accommodation for judicial officers have been introduced, said the former judge. "These vans go to different haats (village markets), melas (fairs) and hold lok adalats."

Kabir shared several anecdotes from his life to illustrate how he utilised his position and vision as a legal practitioner to ensure that justice was provided to those who could not access it before.

Chairing the programme, Executive Director of Ain o Salish Kendra Sultana Kabir said access to justice for all had remained a distance dream in Bangladesh, and urged all to think about how "we can do from our respective positions to ensure justice for all".

Vice Chancellor of Brac University Prof Ainun Nishat was present during the speech also attended by eminent jurists, former lawmakers and bar council members.

Earlier, Altamas Kabir met with Chief Justice Md Mozammel Hossain and leaders of Bangladesh Supreme Court Bar Association.
