

HEAT WAVE MAY CONTINUE



Rain and thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Rangpur, Rajshahi, Dhaka and Sylhet divisions and the regions of Jessor, Kushtia, Comilla with isolated hails at places till 6:00pm today.

Weather may remain mainly dry with temporary partly cloudy skies elsewhere over the country, Met Office said.

Severe heat wave is sweeping over the regions of Rajshahi and Kushtia and moderate to mild heat wave is sweeping over Dhaka, Sylhet and Barisal divisions and the rest part of Khulna division and the region of Pabna, Rangamati, Comilla, Chandpur, Majidee Court, Feni and Cox's Bazar and it may continue.

Day temperature may remain nearly unchanged and night temperature may fall slightly over the country.

The sun sets in the capital today at 6:26pm and rises tomorrow at 5:26am.
