Academic and administrative activities at Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) came to a halt as students began an indefinite strike yesterday, demanding immediate arrest and capital punishment of all the killers of Saad Ibney Momtaz.

Hundreds of students around 8:30am gathered in front of the administrative building and staged a sit-in there for an hour.

They later brought out a procession on the campus to press the demands.

The agitating students also locked the Animal Husbandry faculty after a scuffle with some security personnel of the university, when some students of the faculty were attending a

fishermen fined

A mobile court here yesterday fined 14 fishermen Tk 28 thousand for netting 1,320 kg Jatka (Hilsa fry less than 10 inches in length).

Coast Guard Commander Anisur Rahman said they launched a drive on Kirtankhola River near Taltali area in the city and seized 1,320 kg Jatka from four engine-driven boats and detained 14 fishermen.

The fishermen are Rafik Farazi, Masud Farazi, Nizam Farazi, Moslem, Azizul, Abdul

Hakim, Hasan, Nizam, Masud Ershad, Faisal Yunus, Moksed, and Momin. They all are from Bhashanchar area under Mehendiganj upazila of Barisal.

Coastguards later handed over the detained fishermen to the mobile court led by Magistrate Qumruzzamanthe. The court fined the fishermen Tk 2,000 each and released them with boats, the coastguard commander said.

Housewife killed for dowry, three arrested

A housewife was stabbed to death by her husband for dowry at Darshana Islampara village under Darshona Municipality area in Damurhuda upazila of

the district on Monday.

The deceased was identified as Mariom Khatun Rupa,30, wife of Shujan Sheikh.

Victim family, local people and police sources said Shujan Sheikh, son of Nuru Sheikh of Darshona Ajampur village, married Mariom Khatun Rupa, daughter of Khabir Uddin of the area three years ago. Recently, Shujan Sheikh and his family members

demanded money from Mariom's father as dowry.

As her father failed to pay the money, Shujan Sheikh and his family members beat up Mariom.

At around 5:30pm on Sunday, Shujan locked in an altercation with Rupa over the same issue. At one stage, he stabbed her in the throat and abdomen, leaving her critical injured. Mariom died on the way to a private clinic.

Shujan Sheikh had gone into hiding soon after the incident. A murder case was filed with Damurhuda Police station. Police arrested Shujan's father Nuru Sheikh, 62, his mother Sufiya Khatun, 55, and his younger brother Ripon, 28.
