



Thirty" actor Jason Clarke. The film, which is due to be released in July 2015, is being directed by Thor filmmaker Alan Taylor.


The Terminator franchise was launched in 1984 with Schwarzenegger as the



title character, a cyborg sent back through time to kill the mother of the unborn leader of the human resistance in the war against machines. The film, directed by James Cameron, has since spawned three subsequent films, which have earned more than \$1 billion at the worldwide box office.

When legendary Swedish film director Ingmar Bergman died, a large archive of his notes was donated to the Swedish Film Institute. Among the notes are several unpublished and unfinished scripts both for stage and films, and many more ideas for works in different stages of development. A never-performed play has the title "Kärlek utan älskare" ("Love without lovers"), and has the note "Complete disaster!" written on the envelope. There is also a play about a cannibal, some loose scenes set inside a womb, a film about the life of Jesus and a film about The Merry Widow. Swedish director Marcus Lindeen went through the material, and took samples from many of the works and turned them



into a play that premiered

on May 28, 2012.

celebrate the 153rd birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore (1861-1941) at the Shawkat Osman Memorial Auditorium, Central Public Library, Shahbagh. The theme for this year's festival is "Dibey Ar Nibey, Milabey Milibey, Jabey Na Phirey."

Chief guest, Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu, will inaugurate the 25th installment of the festival at 6pm today. The organisers will honour Professor Emeritus Anisuzzaman on the inaugural day.

Artistes of the organisation will celebrate Kobiguru's birth anniversary with renditions of his songs and recitations of his poems and writings every day. Apart from this, Professor Bishwajit Ghosh will deliver a lecture on "Rabindra Sangeet-e Baul Bhabna" at 6pm tomorrow while Professor Soumitra Shekhar of the same department will speak on "Jugomanob Rabindranath" at 6pm on May 8. Marking the 90th birth anniversary of

Tagore exponent and artiste Kalim Sharafi, the final round of a Rabindra Sangeet competition for bestowing artistes with "Kalim Sharafi Memorial Award" will be held at 9am on May 9. Speaker of the National Parliament Dr. Shirin Sharmin Chowdhury, as chief guest, will hand over awards at 5pm that day. The organisers will also honour Shadhin Bangla Betar Kendra artiste, noted composer and music director Sujeyo Shyam at the event.

Exhibition "Nature and Craft" ends **Zhuma** goes solo

A six-day solo art exhibition titled "Nature and Craft" by talented artist Jakia Ahmad Zhuma concluded yesterday at Zainul Gallery-1, Faculty of Fine Arts (FFA) of University of Dhaka (DU). Cultural Affairs Minister Asaduzzaman Noor, as chief guest, inaugurated the exhibition on April 30.

Pro-Vice Chancellor of DU Dr. Nasreen Ahmad attended the opening ceremony as guest while Dean of FFA, DU Professor Syed Abul Barq Alvi presided over the inaugural function.

Zhuma displayed around 30 artworks in diverse media including tapestry, woodwork, serigraph, metal work, batik and appliqué at her first solo exhibition. The works were a concentrated effort at showcasing elements of nature with the conspicuous connotations of craft. Zhuma focuses on her culture and heritage.

Several of her works retold the saga of time-honoured Bengali folk culture. One of her metal works, titled "Golpo Chitra-4", effectively portrayed the tales of opulent Bengal. An appliqué work titled "Baul Gaan" and a serigraph, depicting mongol shobhajatra of Pahela Baishakh, are reminders of the celebrations of heritage and secular spirit. One of her woodwork titled "Kichirmichir" is aesthetically engraved. The exhibition also showcased multifaceted expressions of life, season, nature and her elements and floral motifs.

Zhuma is an MFA first part student at the Department of Craft of FFA, DU. She topped the BFA examination. The artist has so far bagged several awards. She is also a presenter at Desh TV.
