3 forest robbers surrender to Rab with arms, ammo

Three forest robbers surrendered with arms and ammunition to the members of Rapid Action during four and a half hours special drive by the elite force on Mirgamari canal near Shela River under Chandpai Forest Station in Sunderbans early yesterday.
Receiving information that infamous "Farid Bahini" took position in the deep forest for looting some trawlers in the canal, a special team of Rab-8

launched the drive at around 3.00am. As Rab personnel cordoned off the area, the robbers sent a message to operation officer captain Guljar, saying that they would surrender.
At around 4.00am, three robbers surrendered at around 9.00am the robbers surrendered to the Rab personnel.
They gang members are Md Farid Lahiri, 20, chief of the bahini of Boddhwomari village under Mongla Police Station in Bagerhat, Md

Asad Shikder, 27, of Niklapur village under Rupsha Police Station in Khulna, and Md Jewel J a m a d d e r, 20, of Joymonighol village under Mongla Police Station.
They also handed over two rifles, three guns and 994 bullets to Rab-8 Operation Officer Lt Col Faridul Alam who later briefed the journalists about the operation at Rab-6 headquarters in Khulna city.

'Missing' trader found murdered

A 'missing' trader was found murdered beside a canal in Porkot union under Chatkhil upazila of the district yesterday. The dead is Shuvo Chandra Kuri, 25, son of Makhan Lal Kuri of Badur village in Ramgonj upazila of Laxmipur. He ran a jewellery shop at Sonapur Bazar in Laxmipur. Aminul Islam, officer in-charge of Chatkhil police station, said locals found the body around 10:00am and informed the police. Family sources said Shuvo went out of house on Wednesday night and did not return since. Criminals might have strangled Shuvo and dumped the body, said the OC.

Man commits 'suicide'

A man allegedly committed suicide Madhobpur upazila of Habiganj district yesterday. Abul Hashem, 35, of Bhatpara village in Sujanagar upazila of Pabna, was a member of Destiny 2000 Ltd. He lived in a rented house of the area. Police said when Destiny suspended its operation locals pressed Hashem to refund their money but he failed. Due to this, he took his life by hanging himself from a tree at the garden.

Land dispute kills villager

A man was stabbed to death allegedly by his cousin over land dispute in Raozan upazila of the district on Wednesday night. The deceased was identified as Kiran Mohajan, 45, of Bania Para in the upazila. Police said Bishu Mohajan attacked Kiran with a sharp weapon, leaving him critically injured following an altercation over the land. He died on way to hospital, police said.

Arms, bullets seized

Police arrested a man along with a pistol and four bullets at Sultanpur village in Damurhuda upazila of the district on Wednesday night. The arrestee is Md Mizanur, 36, of Natipota village in the upazila. On information, a police team raided the bordering village and arrested Mizanur along with the arms and bullets. He was accused in several cases including one for murder, said Shikder Moshir Rahman, officer in-charge of Damurhuda police station.

Robbers loot bus passengers on Dhaka-Ctg highway

Robbers looted valuables from the passengers of a bus in Putia area under Daudkandi upazila on Wednesday night.
Police quoted passengers as saying that, a gang of eight to ten robbers boarded on a Raipur-bound bus of 'Jonaki Paribahan', in the guise of passengers from Saidabad bus terminal in the capital around 9:00pm.
As the bus crossed the Meghna Bridge in Sonargang around 10:00pm, the gang took control over the steering at gunpoint.
They looted money, cell-phones, laptop-computer and other valuables from all the 44 passengers of the bus.
Later, the gang drove the bus to Putia-bypass road and forced the passengers to get down from the vehicle and then fled the scene along with the bus.
Following information, Daudkandi and Highway Police visited the spot.
Abu Salam Mia, officer-in-charge of Daudkandi Police Station, said they are trying to recover the vehicle.

POLLS IN FOUR RANGPUR UPAZILAS ON MAY 19 24 to vie for chairman posts

As many as 61 candidates will vie for the posts of chairman, vice-chairman and woman vice-chairman in the elections to Rangpur Sadar, Gangachara, Kaunia and Pirgachha upazila parishads scheduled for May 19.
Of them, 24 are contesting for chairman post, 21 for four vice-chairmen posts and 16 for woman vice-chairman posts in the upazilas, district election office sources said.
In Rangpur Sadar upazila, six candidates are contesting for chairman, six for vice chairman and three for woman vice chairmen posts.
Five people are in the race for chairman post, three for vice-chairman post and three for vice chairmen post reserved for women in Kaunia upazila.
In Pirgachha upazila, three will vie for the post of chairman, three for vice chairman and four for female vice chairmen posts.
Nine candidates are contesting for chairman post, nine for vice chairman post and seven for woman vice chairman post at Gangachara upazila.
Saturday was the last day for withdrawal of nomination papers. According to election officer Md Ashrafur Islam, chairman candidates Abdul Gani, Masudur Rahman and Mahub Chawdhury of Rangpur Sadar, Abdur Rauf and Nuruzzaman Kazol of Gangachara, Selina Begum and Rezwanul Haque Bablu of Pirgachha, and Abdul Halim Suruj of Kaunia upazilas withdrew their nomination papers on the last

CASES FOR VANDALISM, ARSON ATTACKS 24 Jamaat-Shibir men arrested in Ctg

Law enforcers arrested 24 Jamaat-Shibir men, including a union level ameer of Jamaat, raiding different areas of Banshkhalia and Lohagara upazilas of the district on Wednesday night to early yesterday.
Quamrul Islam, officer-in-charge (OC) of Banshkhalia Police Station, said police conducted drives in five unions of the upazila and arrested 20 Jamaat-Shibir men including Mohammad Mohiuddin, 47, ameer of Sadhanpur union unit of Jamaat-e-Islami.
Of the 20 arrestees-- 12 are Jamaat activists while the rest are Shibir men and all the arrestees are accused in number of cases including vandalism, arson and attacks on on-duty police-men, the OC added.
In Lohagara, said police in separate drives arrested four Shibir men from different unions of the upazila early yesterday, said Abu Bakar, sub-inspector of Lohagara Police Station.
They are accused in cases filed with the police station on charge of vandalism and arson attacks, added the OC.

accord and the human rights of Rohingya refugees.
Expressing concern at the recent disappearance of British national Mujibur Rahman Mujib in Sunamganj, Nick Low, acting High Commissioner of the UK, demanded that the government apprise them of the circumstances of his disappearance and the progress in the probe.
He urged the authorities concerned to do whatever was necessary to find Mujib and his driver.
Human rights are at the heart of the relationship between the EU and Bangladesh, he said.
Nick Low also called upon the authorities to take steps for Ilias Ali's safe return to his family, and clarify the circumstances of the BNP leader's disappearance two years ago.
Echoing his view, Hanna said there was a need for proper probe in every case no matter whether the person is a citizen of the UK or Bangladesh.
"Justice is very important," he said.
The EU envoy said all cases of abductions and killings should be properly investigated and justice should be done. Universal values of democracy and respect for human rights are the fundamentals of the cooperation agreement.
"Rule of law is so important to the lives of the people. We really feel this is so important and justice should be done. That is why we did take up these questions with the government."
The EU also renewed its stand on the need for a dialogue between the major political parties to resolve current problems before going for a fresh national election.
Hanna said the EU made clear its position by a number of statements, including the one in December last year when it decided not to send observers to the January 5 polls, and another on January 9.
The EU sticks to its January 9 statement that said the Bangladeshi people were not given an opportunity to express fully their democratic choice in the January 5 national elections, said the EU ambassador.
In the statement, the EU urged all parties to refrain from violence and engage in genuine dialogue to find a way towards a transparent, inclusive and credible election.
On labour issues, Hanna said substantial progress in that area is important for Bangladesh to continue its preferential access to the EU market, not only for RMG products but also for all the goods it exports to the EU market.
All need to work together to ensure that the commitments made by stakeholders last year are met and that the Rana Plaza victims are fully compensated, he added.
Danish Ambassador Hanne Fugl Eskær laid stress on the role of civil society and the media in raising the voice on human rights issues.
French Ambassador Michel Trinquier, German Ambassador Albrecht Conze, Spanish Ambassador Luis Tejada Chacon, Dutch Ambassador Gerben Sjoerd de Jong, Charge d'Affaires of Sweden Karin Rohlin and Charge d'Affaires of Italy Edmondo Falconi were also present at the press conference.
