Robbers loot bus passengers on Dhaka-Ctg highway

Robbers looted valuables from the passengers of a bus in Putia area under Daudkandi upazila on Wednesday night.

Police quoted passengers as saying that, a gang of eight to ten robbers boarded on a Raipur-bound bus of 'Jonaki Paribahan', in the guise of passengers from Saidabad bus terminal in the capital around 9:00pm. As the bus crossed the Meghna Bridge in

Sonargoan around 10:00pm, the gang took control over the steering at gunpoint.

They looted money, cell-phones, laptopcomputer and other valuables from all the 44 passengers of the bus. Later, the gang drove the bus to Putia-

bypass road and forced the passengers to get down from the vehicle and then fled the scene along with the bus.

Following information, Daudkandi and Highway Police visited the spot.

Abu Salam Mia, officer-in-charge of Daudkandi Police Station, said they are trying to recover the vehicle.
