

One found dead, five still missing

Two rescued yesterday; eight arrested for involvement

Amid abduction panic across the country, law enforcers have recovered a body of an abducted person in Thakurgaon and rescued two other victims in Moulvibazar and Savar. Besides, five others remained traceless in different districts, report our correspondents. In Thakurgaon, police recovered the

decomposed body of an auto-bike driver, who was abducted on Tuesday, from a field of Chakhaldi village in Sadar upazila on Saturday. The victim was identified as Akhtarul Islam, 28, of Dakkhin Salondar Munshipara village in Sadar upazila. The victim's family members claimed

Gunfight between cops, criminals hurts 3 in Ctg

Inter-district murder investigation leads to incident; arrestees confess to killing

Two police personnel and a miscreant were injured in a gunfight between the law enforcers and a band of criminals at a hotel in Chittagong city Saturday night. The injured police men are Sub-inspector Alamgir Hossain and Constable Habirul Islam of Joraganj Police Station in Mirsarai upazila of Chittagong. The miscreant was identified as Mohammad Bacha, 30, a resident of Majhir Ghat area in the city. They were undergoing treatment at

Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH). Joraganj police said they recovered a body from a roadside bush on Dhaka-Chittagong Highway in Mirsarai on May 4. Later they ascertained that it was the body of Mohammad Habib, 35, hailing from Netrokona, who was murdered somewhere else and dumped there. After a series of enquiries, Joraganj police drew the conclusion that someone of Hotel Akash in Majhir Ghat area of

Nur Hossain might never be found

Fears Gonotantrik Bam Morcha

Several leftist parties yesterday expressed fear that Nur Hossain, the prime accused in the sensational Narayanganj seven murder case, might never be found. They claimed the public fear that Nur Hossain will either be murdered or abducted by law enforcers themselves to conceal the involvement of key figures of the government and the administration in the grisly crimes. Nur Hossain was a drug lord in Siddhirganj of Narayanganj and he operated right under the nose of the administration, they claimed. Leaders of Gonotantrik Bam Morcha, an alliance of eight leftist parties, were addressing a rally in front of the Jatiya

Khaleda reschedules N'ganj visit

Her party claims the change is due to PM's meeting with families of the slain 7 on previous date

Khaleda Zia last night rescheduled her visit to the family members of the seven slain victims of Narayanganj. She will now visit them tomorrow instead of May 14, since the latter date reportedly coincides with Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's plan to meet the families, party sources said. The BNP chief came up with the fresh schedule following her meeting with a delegation of Narayanganj district unit of BNP, led by its president Taimur Alam Khandaker, at her Gulshan office. Deceased panel mayor Nazrul's father-in-law Shahidul Islam earlier told reporters that the premier had invited the family members to the Prime Minister's Office on May 14. But last night he told The Daily Star that they were invited to the PMO today. However, officials at the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) could neither confirm the invitation nor the date. As BNP was denied permission to hold a rally in
