

50 outsiders found in DU Jagannath Hall

Some house tutors claim they were freed after pressure from BCL; provost denies it DU CORRESPONDENT

The authorities of Dhaka University's Jagannath Hall in an overnight drive caught 50 outsiders living in the dormitory. They, however, were released with a warning yesterday. Some 15 house tutors led by hall provost Prof Ashim Sarker found at least 50 rooms occupied by outsiders, including former DU students, students of other dormitories and educational institutions. Some house tutors alleged that the 50 were freed after Bangladesh Chhatra League leaders intervened to the release of the detainees. Denying the BCL intervention, the provost said the outsiders were set free as the raid was conducted without giving prior notice. The raid was conducted following the incident where a trader was kept hostage for 15 hours in a room of the hall.

Principal runs illegal

FROM PAGE 5 BSTI, said Executive Magistrate Kholil Ahmed, who led the drive. During a raid two weeks ago, the factory was sealed off but Malek reopened it by breaking the lock, he added. On information, the mobile court reached the college but came under attack from Malek's students on his instigation. Two mobile court members and My TV videographer, Hasan Biswas, were injured during the attack, police said. Later, the court handed Malek and his factory employee Jasim Uddin over to Shahjahanpur police. The Dhaka Waza authorities filed two cases against them over running the factory illegally and barring government officials from discharging their duties, said Assistant Sub-inspector Mohammad Mohsin. Afterwards, the mobile court destroyed around 1,000 jars of water of the factory, which had no purification plants.

FROM PAGE 5 including a cardiac professor. In her complaint, Mahmuda said her husband was taken to Labaid for check-up on April 1. After check-up, Dr Sohrab and Lokman told her they found block in her husband's heart and there was an urgent open heart surgery.

As per their advice, the complainant admitted her husband for treatment the same day and the accused doctors operated on him on April 5. But her husband's condition deteriorated as there was water in his lung. Due to negligence of the doctors, her husband died on April 25, Mahmuda alleged.

Gunfight between cops, criminals

FROM PAGE 3 Chittagong city might have connection with the murder, and conducted a raid at the hotel around 10:00pm on Saturday, said Alamgir Hossain, the injured sub-inspector of Joraganj Police Station. Sensing the presence of law enforcers, the SI said, the criminals opened fire on them, leaving him and Habirul injured. Police also retaliated with gunshots, leaving Bacha injured, he said, adding that seven cohorts of Bacha were also arrested. During the primary interrogation, the arrestees had acknowledged that they were involved in the murder, the SI added. SI Alamgir said along with the body they had recovered a photograph of Habib with a woman, which they considered as a vital clue. The name of the studio written on the photo was located in Narayananj. Following that, a team of Joraganj police visited Narayananj's Sanarpar on May 5 and distributed leaflets among the locals to help them find out the woman, he said.

On May 8, locals held the woman, Parveen, and handed her over to Shiddhirganj Police Station. A team of Joraganj police again visited Narayananj on May 9, and interrogated Parveen, who claimed that the deceased was her husband, the SI said. The couple went to Chittagong and checked in Hotel Akash on May 2, the SI said quoting Parveen. On May 3 night, Habib exchanged heated arguments some people including Bacha, whom police suspected as the ringleader of a prostitution syndicate centring the hotel. The couple might have been involved in the syndicate, the SI said, adding that Habib might have been murdered over distribution of money of the prostitution business. Parveen told the police that she did not find her husband the following morning after waking up from sleep, the SI said. She is now under Joraganj police custody, he added.

Pak army killed 7

FROM PAGE 5 others went to Shaistaganj Food Godown to collect food for freedom fighters on April 29. Around 12:30pm, Qaisar and his brother Faisal and three or four cohorts arrived in the storehouse and left within a few minutes, but after sometime, the accused came with Pakistani army forcing them to take hideout, said Gour. As per the direction of Qaisar, his accomplices dragged out seven employees of the godown and Qaisar scolded them, said the witness. Qaisar and the army left the place leaving few army men to guard the employees. Around 4:30pm, when he hid himself inside a bush near his house in Shaistaganj Puran Bazar, he saw Qaisar and Pakistani army intercepted a jeep and Qaisar and his cohorts dragged out two persons from the jeep, said Gour. They were Awami League leaders Saleh Ahmed and Hirendranath Roy, said Gour, adding that Pakistani army had assaulted them physically following a signal of Qaisar before they took them to Laxmanpur. Gour said, being frightened, he took shelter in a house in Laxmanpur village and from people, he heard that Shaleh and Hirendranath were shot dead near one Ramjan Ali's house in Laxmanpur. He used to pass his days inside a big sugarcane field and nights inside the house, said Gour, adding that there was an army tent near Railway Bridge on Khoai River, which was 400/500 yards away from the house. "Around 4:30pm on May 29, 1971, I saw Qaisar Shaheb was standing on the approach road of the bridge and the seven employees of the food godown were lined up on the bank of the river," he said. "Then Qaisar Shaheb made some signal with his hand and Pakistani army opened fire leaving the seven persons dead," said Gour, adding that later the cohorts of Qaisar had dumped the bodies in the river. Gour said on June 2, he left the country for India, took training and joined the Liberation War under Sector 4. The three-member tribunal led by Justice Obaidul Hassan adjourned the case proceeding until today, when Gour will face cross-examination.

One found dead

FROM PAGE 3 that the abductors had been demanding Tk 50,000 as ransom. Being failed to secure the ransom, they killed Akhtarul, family members said. Police have arrested two persons suspecting their involvement in the murder. In Moulvibazar, police rescued a girl, who was abducted from Borolekha upazila on Thursday, from Tikerpara area in Bianibazar upazila of Sylhet around 4:00am yesterday. The victim was identified as Kulsuma Begum, 12, daughter of Islam Miah of Dojgiri village in Borolekha upazila. Police have arrested two persons in this connection. In Savar, police rescued a local BNP leader Rezwanul Haque, who remained missing from May 6, from Bipile area of Savar on the outskirts of Dhaka yesterday morning. In Lalmonirhat, paddy trader Jahabul Islam, 35, son of Tamzid Uddin at Mesirpar village of Patgram upazila, has been missing since December 25 last year. Police have arrested two ruling party men allegedly for their involvement in the abduction. The victim's family members alleged

that police had helped other abductors flee. In Chuadanga, farmer Inal Haque, 45, son of late Ajar Ali of Zumma Bazar Para in Kutuppur union of Sadar upazila, has remained missing for more than three days. Victim's family members alleged a group of unidentified miscreants numbering seven to eight had entered Inal's house around 2:00am Thursday night impersonating DB men. They picked up Inal at gun point. However, Faruk Hossain, sub-inspector of Chuadanga Sadar Police Station, denied the allegation, and said no DB men had gone to the house that night. In Mymensingh, police in the early hours of yesterday held two suspects from Char Sirta village in Sadar upazila of Mymensingh in connection with the disappearance of Sunamganj BNP leader Mujibur Rahman and his driver Rezaul Haque Sohel. The duo have been missing since May 4. Meanwhile, wife of Benapole Municipality panel mayor Salma Akhter yesterday claimed that Rab members had abducted her husband, who remained traceless for more than one year.

A retired cabinet secretary and a human rights activist will be the two other members of the body, he said.

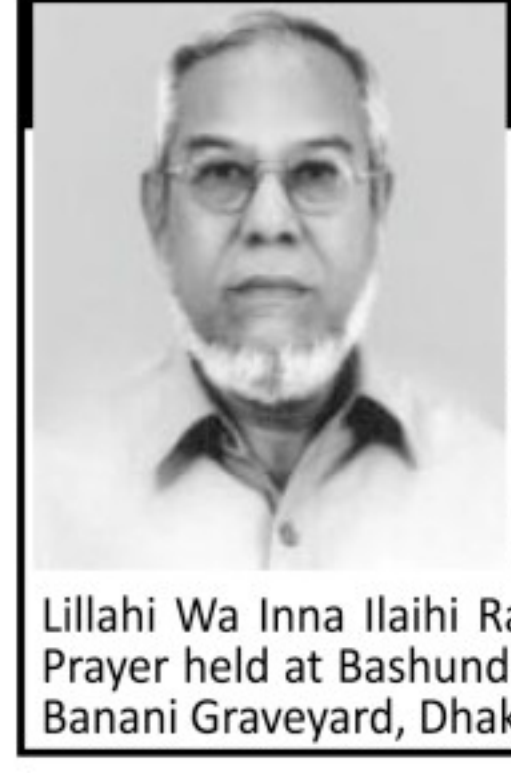
