BSF picks up two from Jhenidah, Lalmonirhat

Two Bangladeshi cattle traders were picked up by Indian Border Security Force (BSF) from borders in Jhenidah and Lalmonirhat districts on Wednesday and early yesterday.

Our Chuadanga correspondent reported that BSF members of Sutipur camp, detained a Bangladeshi national from Sreenathpur border in Nadia district of Paschim Banga on Wednesday night, reports our Chuadanga correspon-

dent.

The arrestee is Shariful Islam, 26, son of Khoka Tarafdar of Moheshpur upazila of the district.

L t C o l S M Moniruzzaman, commanding officer (CO) of BGB 6 Battalion, said a BSF patrol team from Sutipur camp picked up Shariful when he entered the Indian territory through Sreenathpur border at around 11:00pm on Wednesday night.

Khorshed Alam, commander of BGB's Kushumpur Camp had sent

a letter to its Indian counterpart, demanding return of Shariful, added the CO.

In Lalmonirhat, BSF men picked up a Bangladeshi cattle trader from Islampur border in Patgram upazila of Lalmonirhat district early yesterday, according to UNB.

The detainee is Javed Ali, 35, son of Umar Ali of Islampur village of the upazila.

Lt Col Safiul Alam, commanding officer (CO) of BGB 15 Battalion in Lalmonirhat quoted locals as saying that the BSF men from Chengrabandha camp in Cooch Bihar district in Paschim Banga detained Javed from the border while he was moving suspiciously in the area around 5:00am.

BGB has sent a letter to their counterpart protesting the detention, the CO said.

Three Shibir men held

Police arrested three Shibir men at a house at Kalmegh village in Baliadangi upazila yesterday. Lightning kills one

A man was killed by lightning at Kaliti Tea Garden in Kulaura upazila of the district yesterday. The deceased was identified as Kumar Rajbhar, 45, of the village. Police said the thunderbolt struck him when he was cutting the grass in the area. He was rushed to the upazila health complex where on duty doctors declared him dead.

Body recovered

Police recovered the body of a man from Mohadipur in Palashbari upazila on Thutiapukur-Parbatipur road yesterday. The deceased is Rustom Ali, 35, son of late Moinul Huq Minshi of the village. Locals found his body in the area and informed the police. The body was sent to Gaibandha Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. Criminals might have killed Rustom and dumped the body in the area, said Gopal Chandra Chakravarti, officer-in-charge of Palashbari police station.

Jamaat activist stabbed to death

An activist of Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami was stabbed to death by criminals at Thutiapukur in Palashbari upazila early yesterday. The deceased was identified as Rustom Ali, a resident of the village. Gopal Chandra, officer-in-charge of Palashbari Police Station, said Rustom was wanted in several cases filed with the police station. He had been absconding since long. Abu Taleb, vice-president of Palashbari upazila unit Jamaat, said a gang attacked Rustom and stabbed him indiscriminately in the dead of night while he was returning home from the hideout after a long time, leaving him dead on the spot. Informed, police recovered the body and sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy.

15 houses gutted

At least 15 houses were gutted when a fire broke out at Bongaon village in Ranishankol upazila yesterday. Locals said the fire broke out from one Robul's house of the village around 11:00am and soon engulfed adjacent 14 houses. On information, a fire fighting unit from Pirganj went to the spot and douse the flames with the help of locals.

One electrocuted

A man was electrocuted at Char Khalifa village in Daulatkhon Upazila on Wednesday night. The victim is Nizam Uddin, 28, son of Nasir Uddin of the village. Mir Khairul Kabir, officer-in-charge of Daulatkhon Police Station quoted locals as saying that Nizam came in contact with a live electric wire while repairing the electric line at his shop on Wednesday night. Locals rushed Nizam to Daultakhan Upazila Health Complex, where on-duty doctor declared him death.

Man killed as villagers clash

A man killed in an attack, allegedly centring a clash over a friendly football match at Koirdhari village in Chaudhagram upazila on Wednesday night. The victim is Abdul Halim, 45, a resident of the village. Police quoted locals as saying that an altercation occurred between Din Islam, 18, son of Abdul Halim, and Parvez, 20, over a friendly football match and at one stage the duo attacked each other. At around 9:00pm, Parvez attacked Halim and beat him mercilessly while he was returning home along with his son, leaving him critically injured. Locals rescued him but he died on his way to Comilla Medical College Hospital.

KHANSAMA UPAZILA IN DINAJPUR

Primary teachers suffer as edn officer is virtually absent for 45 days

Important works including salaries and other bills disbursement and execution of transfer and joining order in Khansama upazila under the district are being hampered due to virtual absence of the upazila primary education officer since March 25.

Amid the situation, other officials of the upazila primary education office are allegedly harassing the teachers and staffs to realise bribe, said the teachers and staff.

The teachers and staffs of 140 primary schools in Khansama upazila submitted a memorandum to the district primary education officer yesterday demanding an end to their harassment.

They alleged that Md Azmal Hossain, assistant upazila education officer in Khansama upazila, is harassing them in absence of his boss.

Shah Alam Bulbul, headmaster of Khansama Model Primary School, also president of Khansama upazila unit of Bangladesh Primary School Teachers Association, categorically said about the harassment.

Four AL men sued for killing BNP leader Ismail

Four Awami league (AL) activists have been sued on charge of killing Kaliganj upazila BNP leader Ismail Hossain.

The accused are Shahjahan Ali, his brother Azizar Rahman, Atiar Rahman, son of Lutfur Rahman and Abbas Ali, son of Abu Taleb of Chapali village in the upazila.

Jahanara Begum, wife of the slain BNP leader, filed the case with Kaliganj Police Station on Wednesday night, accusing the four identified and five unnamed people.

None of the accused was arrested as of 5:00pm yesterday. Contacted, Officer-in-Charge Anwar Hossain said they have launched a drive to arrest the accused.

Ismail Hossain, 59, president of ward number one unit of BNP under Kaliganj municipality, was killed allegedly by Awami League activist Shahjahan Ali on Tuesday morning.

refuted the allegation.

Abducted SSC examinee rescued

Police rescued a SSC candidate of the district from Balurghat area in Sadar upazila of Narayanganj yesterday, two days after his abduction.

They also arrested one Shafique, 19, of Charshishua village in Sarishabari upazila of Jamalpur, for his alleged involvement in the abduction.

The victim is Md Sharif, 17, son of Aziz Mandol of the village. He appeared in this year's SSC examination from Reaz Uddin Talukdar High School in the upazila.

Police and family sources said Sharif went out of house around 9:00pm on Tuesday after receiving a phone call and did not return since.

The abductors later demanded Tk 1.20 lakh ransom from his family over mobile phone.

After tracking the location of the call, police raided a house in the area yesterday morning and rescued Sharif.

They later arrested Shafique, neighbour of the victim, from the spot, said Billal Uddin, officer-in-charge of Sarishabari Police Station.
