Dharla devours 650 metres of a road

About 650 metres of Lalmonirhat-Phulbari road have been devoured by the Dharla River in Char Kulaghat area in Sadar upazila.

The erosion continued unabated while sufferings of thousands of local commuters mounted everyday.

Roads and Highway (RHD) officials said, of the 650 metres 400 meters were devoured between last week of September and first week of October last year and the rest 250 meters were devoured in the last one week.

Kulaghat union parishad (UP) chairman Idris Ali said, about 100 bighas of cropland have been devoured by Dharla near the road.

At least 500 bighas of cropland, many orchards and homesteads are under the threat of erosion, he said, adding if no protection work was immediately taken up, the Dharla will devour these 500 bighas by this year.

"I have already contacted the RHD and WDB officials for protection work to save people's homesteads and croplands but to no effect yet for unknown reason," the UP chairman said.

We have already lost our

croplands, orchards and the river will devour more areas if no protection work was taken up, said erosion hit farmers Nazrul Islam, Abdul Khalrque, Mazibar Rahman and others at Char Kulaghat village.

Contacted, Executive Engineer of Lalmonirhat Roads and Highways Department Suruz Miah said, without checking Dharla erosion, RHD can not re-construct the road.

"If we start reconstruction work of the road it will be devoured in again", he said, adding that his office had already informed the matter to the WDB authorities concerned.

BSF picks up youth in Sunamganj

Members of Indian Border Security Force (BSF) picked up a Bangladeshi young man from near Chargaon border in Tahirpur upazila of Sunamganj on Wednesday night.

The youth was identified as Musa Mia, 22, son of Mubarak Mia of Baherchar village in Raipur upazila of Narsingdi district.

Locals said Musa was picked up when he went to his relative's house at Kolagaon village in the upazila.

Musa was arrested by BSF at 8:30pm when he along with his three relatives was moving near Chargaon border. However, the three others managed to flee the scene.

Strike at Hili land port called off

PM to look into workers' demands, says local MP

Traders and Hili land port users of Hakimpur upazila yesterday withdrew their indefinite strike following an assurance from the government to meet their demands.

The prime minister will look into the matter, said Shibli Sadiq, lawmaker of Dinajpur-6 constituency.

Abul Kashem, president of Hili Land Port C & F Agent Association, said "On Wednesday, a five-member team, led by himself, met the premier at her office where she assured them of resolving the problem within two weeks".

Later, the decision to call off the strike came at a meeting at his office yesterday.

Meanwhile, the traders and port users threatened to go for fresh agitation if the

demands were not met within the deadline.

On May 14, the port users called the strike to press home their three-point demand.

The demands include putting an end to giving seal on the manifest of imported goods, harassment by members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB), and filing of cases by BGB without informing the C&F agents and importers.

BGB members started checking import documents since April 27 at Zero Line, killing time. They also harass truckers and helpers at the time of checking documents, said the leaders at the association.

However, Lt Col Abdur Razzak Tarafdar of the battalion said the border guards started checking the documents for security

Newly wed housewife tortured for dowry

A newly wed housewife was tortured and her hair shaved off allegedly by her husband and in-laws at Molankhori Miajipara village in Sadar upazila on Friday last.

Police arrested the victim's husband Moshir Rahman on Wednesday night after her father Yasin Ali filed a case with Thakurgaon Police Station in this connection the same day.

According to the case, Khadiza Begum, 19, daughter of Yasin Ali of Bothina village in Rajagaon union under Sadar upazila was married with Moshir, 28, son of Sirajul Islam of Molankhori Miajipara village eight months ago.

Khadiza's father gave Tk 1.15-lakh during her marriage to her husband, family sources said.

After a month of their marriage, Moshir and his

family members demanded an additional Tk 2.5-lakh from her father.

As she failed to bring the amount, Moshir and her family members started to torture her physically and mentally to realise the dowry.

On Friday, Moshir and his family members started to torture Khadiza. At one stage, they shaved her hair and confined her to the house.

Hearing the news from neighbours, Khadiza's parents rescued her from her in-laws house and admitted her to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital on Tuesday.

Contacted, the victim's elder brother Ariful Islam told this correspondent over cell phone that Khadiza herself got released from the hospital as she was unable to bear the shame of replying to various questions by people and newspaper reporters.

Over three hundred people from all walks of life took part in the two hour human chain from 11:00am.

One of the inhabitants of the area, Md Fazor Ali, said the authorities always ignored it when the beel was being grabbed and polluted and the eviction drives often stopped midway due to 'unknown reasons'.

Aroj Ali, another resident of the area, said protecting the beel from grabbers and pollution is a must to save the life and living of the local people.

Later, they submitted a memorandum of understanding (MoU) in this regards to the deputy commissioner in Moulvibazar.
