Two 'abducted' kids found murdered

Police recovered the bodies of two schoolboys yesterday who were abducted in Dinajpur and Natore districts.

The body of a schoolboy, who was abducted for Tk 50 lakh ransom four days ago, was recovered in Sadar upazila of Dinajpur early yesterday.

The law enforcers arrested one Obaidul Haque, his wife Rawshan Ara and Md Abbas Ali of Mohabbatpur village in connection with the incident, reports our correspon-

The deceased is Md Saiadul Mursalin, 14, son of Moksedul Islam of the vil-

He was a class IX student of Cheradangi High School in the upazila.

At 2:30am, some locals saw a few men removing something stinky from the house of one Abbas Ali, about 20 metres away from Mursalin's residence, and informed the police.

Later, police recovered the body of Mursalin with his hands and legs tied up from behind and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College



In Natore, police recovered the body of a 'missing' schoolboy from Dhulauri village in Singra upazila early yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The deceased was identified as Hridoy, 10, son of Helal Uddin of Parshaoil village in the upazila and a class four student at Dhulauri Primary School.

He remained missing since Sunday night, said Shafigul Islam, officer incharge of Singra police

Locals found the body of the boy at a place beside Barnoi River and informed the police who sent it to hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

Deceased's father Moksedul Islam, a deed writer at Dinajpur registry office, said Rashidul Islam, son of Obaidul Haque, called Mursalin out of home on Thursday afternoon and since his son remained missing.

The abductors then demanded Tk 50 lakh ransom for his release over mobile phone, he said.

Following an abduction case filed by Mursalin's brother-in-law Md Morshedul Islam, police arrested Rashidul Islam and one Sabuj on Thursday and Friday.

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) picked up two youths from two border points in Thakurgaon and Jhenidah districts early yesterday.

A rule has also been issued, asking the government to explain in four weeks why it should not be directed to form an authority as per the Nirapad Khaddyo Ain (Safe Food Act), 2013 to take necessary action to ensure

safe food for people. The HC bench of Justice Quazi Reza-Ul Hoque and Justice ABM Altaf Hossain Nimai returned home on came up with the order and Saturday night. Hearing the rule after hearing the writ news, loan shark Babul and his petition filed by rights hired goons vandalised Nimai's organisation, Legal Action house, beat up his wife and

Bangladesh Foundation. On May 21, the rights body filed the writ petition, seeking its directives on the government to take necessary measures to ensure safe food for the commoners.

It said parliament has passed a bill on the Safe Food Act in 2013 to stop the widespread food adulteration through forming courts for disposal of cases against the food-related crimes.

The act has not yet come into effect, as the government does not issue a gazette notification in this regard, the petitioner said, adding that the law has a provision for five years' jail and a Tk 10 lakh fine as maximum punishment for food adultera-

tion.

According to the act, the government is supposed to form a 30-member National Safe Food Management Advisory Council headed by the food minister to coordinate the action and decisions of the Safe Food Authority.

The rights body has also prayed for necessary instructions for the authorities concerned to operate mobile courts against food adulteration in all district towns and metropolitan areas.

The organisation has also urged the court to form a committee, "Safe Food Authority", in compliance with the safe food act to take necessary decisions and action to stop the adultera-



BRUR teacher dismissed

Begum Rokeya University, Rangpur (BRUR) authorities have dismissed a teacher of the university on charge of producing fake certificates to get the job.

On Friday night, the decision was taken at a syndicate meeting with vice chancellor AKM Nurun Nabi in the chair, said Muhammad Ali, public relations and information officer of the university.

The syndicate also decided to file a forgery case against Abu Zafar Md Imran, lecturer at finance and banking department of the university.

Imran joined the department as a lecturer following submission of his academic certificates which claimed that he completed his master's degree from the finance and banking department of Rajshahi University (RU). On April 20, the finance

and banking department at BRUR received an anonymous letter which claimed that Imran joined the university using forged BBA and MBA certificates. The letter also stated that Imran secured CGPA 2.73 in

his BBA final examination and 2.60 in the MBA first semester exam.

Later, the university

authorities sought the details of Imran's educational background from RU authorities concerned. In reply, the RU authori-

ties said that Imran got CGPA 2.73 in his BBA final examinations and 2.60 in the MBA first semester exam while the accused in his forged certificates claimed that out of 4 points, he secured CGPA 3.63 and 3.54 in BBA and MBA exams. They also confirmed that Imran is yet to complete his
