Doctors and staffs at Thakurgaon Swasthoseba Hospital (diabetic) formed an hour-long human chain yesterday at a road intersection in the town, demanding arrear salaries for nine months.

The human chain followed a discussion where medical officer of the hospital Dr Nur Alam Mondal, junior technical assistant Madhab Chandra Roy, cleaner Anthony and others spoke.

They sought the prime minister's intervention for steps to regularise their salaries as per service rules.

The speakers said the doctors and staffs of the hospital had been passing hard days with their family members as they were not



Two arrested on charge of killing their daughters

Two people were arrested in Bogra and Manikganj districts on charge of killing their daughters on Saturday and the day before.

Police arrested an elderly man on charge of killing his teenage daughter in Shantibagh area of Bogra town on Friday night, reports our correspondent.

During an interrogation, arrestee Hazrat Ali, 50, confessed to his involvement in the killing.

Mother of the deceased Amena Begum filed a case against Hazrat and his cohort Jamir Hossain, 35, an auto-rickshaw driver of Jaiguli village in Gabtoli upazila of the district.

Hazrat disclosed to police that he killed his daughter Hasna Khatun, 15, as he disliked her way of life. Hazrat said she used to mix with some local bad boys despite his

repeated warnings.

In Manikganj, a teenage schoolgirl was strangled to death allegedly by her father at Garakul village in Sadar upazila on Saturday night, reports our correspondent.

The deceased was identified as Jerin Akhter, 13, a student of class VI at Muktijuddha Smriti High School.

Police quoting the victim's family said when Jerin was sleeping with her grandmother Sona Banu, her father Fazlul Haque called her in his room.

Yesterday morning, family members found her dead in her father's room.

SI Shafiqul Islam of Sadar PS said, they suspect that Fazlul Haque strangled her daughter. They arrested him from the house. However, police could not say the reason behind her killing.

JCD leader 'missing' in Jhenidah

Jhenidah Sadar upazila Chhatra Dal member and Paglakanai union Chhatra Dal joint secretary went missing a week ago, alleged his family members.

The victim is Ilyas Hossain, 20, son of Sanaruddin Mollah of Berbari village under the upazila. Ilyas appeared at the HSC examination this year from Government KC College in the district.

Ilyas allegedly disappeared on May 26 from his Berbari village. The same night, police recovered his mobile phone, bi-cycle and sandals from Rajapur village in an abandoned state, sources said.

Victim's father Sanaruddin Mollah said, a rival group might have taken him hostage over recent upazila elections.

Ashraful Islam Pintu, student affairs secretary of Jhenidah district BNP unit, said Ilyas was the member of district JCD unit and Paglakanai union Chhatra Dal joint secretary. He demanded urgent probe into his disappearance.

Second Officer at Jhenidah Sadar police station SI Daud Hossain said, after the recent upazila polls, Ilyas had been living at Paglakanai of the district town.

Last Monday he went to his village home at Berbari where he went missing.

Ilyas had a conflict with an opposition group over upazila polls. We are trying to find clues by tracking the call list in his recovered SIM, the SI added.

A few days ago, a rival group hacked and injured Ilyas over election issue, he told this correspondent.

Two shot dead in Madaripur

Criminals hacked and later shot two people including a madrasa teacher dead in Tekerhat area under Rajoir upazila of the district on Saturday night.

The deceased were identified as Maulana Abdul Bashar, 55, a teacher of local Rashida Fazil Madrasa and resident of Bara Ballandi in Shaltha upazila of Faridpur district and Billal Mollah, 22, son of Kawsar Mollah of Madhukhali upazila.

Police and Shahnur Begum, wife of Abdul Bashar, said there was a longstanding feud between two Awami League leaders Shahin Khandaker and Delwar Kazi in Shaltha.

At stage, Jamaat activist Abdul Bashar joined AL with the support of Delwar Kazi.

Officer-in-charge (OC) of Rajoir Police Station Moniruzzaman said, police detained a man in connection with the double murder. A locally made pistol and a Chinese machete were seized from the spot.

Abu Bakar Munshi, brother to Abdul Bashar, filed a murder case with Rajoir Police Station accusing Shahin Khandaker as key suspect and six to seven others in connection with the murder.

Arshed Ali, OC (investigation), said Billal might be one of the perpetrators who took part in the killing.

Billal along with three others, using fake identity, had rented a boarding house four days ago and locked in a fierce altercation over share of money.

Later two of them left the boarding, Arshed Ali added.

Fratricide

A man was stabbed to death allegedly by his elder brother over a trifling matter at Dhanakusha village in Nakla upazila early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Riton Miah, 24, son of Mujibar Rahman of the village.

Quoting witnesses, police said Rubel Hossain had an altercation with his younger brother Riton over stealing of a fan of his poultry farm around 12 am on Saturday night.

At one stage of altercation, Rubel stabbed Riton indiscriminately, causing his death at hospital.

Grabbers capture land of govt school in Gaibandha

Two local influential people have captured 21 decimals of land of a government primary school in Gaibandha Sadar Upazila and started construction of a boundary wall, trespassing on the school playground.

According to Headmistress

The alleged land grabbers continue to erect the wall, encroaching upon the playground of Trimohoni Government Primary School despite protest by the headmistress and the president of the school managing committee.

Claiming ownership of 21 decimals of land of the school, the heirs of Nawab Hossain, Nurul Hossain and Nur Mohammed recently

Sharifunnessa, the school was built in 1871 on 71 decimals of land donated by some locals. The government nationalised the institution in 1973.

On the basis of a registered deed, the duo have occupied the land and started construction of the boundary wall. "We have purchased the land through a legal deed and taken possession of it," said Noor Hossain, one of the occupiers.

The school managing committee has informed the authorities concerned of the matter and also filed a complaint with the Sadar upazila nirbahi officer (UNO), seeking his intervention into the matter.

Contacted, the UNO said the assistant commissioner (land) will investigate the matter and take necessary steps in this regard.

In an emergency meeting held two days ago, the school managing committee decided to take legal steps against the alleged land grabbers.

Accordingly, donor member Shariful Huq Sarker has been assigned to file a case against the grabbers, said Shamsul Alam Khandker, president of school managing committee.





Murder, to become rich overnight Rashidul says he abducted Mursalin after falling in love with a rich man's daughter

The accused in schoolboy Saiyadul Mursalin abduction and murder case gave a confessional statement before a Dinaipur court on Saturday.

The accused, Md Rashidul Islam, an HSC student of Dinaipur KBM College, made the statement before the Judicial Magistrate's Court under Section 164, saying that he had abducted Mursalin for Tk 50 lakh ransom as he wanted to be a rich man overnight after falling in love with the daughter of a rich man,

police said.

Rashidul told the court that he tied Mursalin's hands and legs with ropes, confined him to his house and later strangled him.

Mursalin, 14, son of Moksedul Islam of Mohabbatpur village under the upazila, was a class IX student of Cheradangi High School. He was abducted by his neighbour Rashidul, son of a richshawpuller Obaidur Rahman, in the afternoon of May 22.

In the evening, Rashidul demanded Tk 50 lakhs as ransom from Mursalin's father Moksedul over his cellphone. Later, Moksedul filed a case with Sadar Police Station, accusing Rashidul.

Moksedul talked with the abductor over phone Friday

afternoon and said that he could only pay Tk 10 lakh. Since then, the kidnapper's mobile phone was switched off.

Informed by locals, police recovered the body of Mursalin with his hands and legs tied up from a paddy field at Mohabbatpur Purbopara village on May 26.

They (police) arrested Rashidul the same day and produced him in the court that placed him on a five-day remand.

Police also arrested Rashidul's father Obaidur and mother Raushan Ara as they have been made accused
