India. Of them, only the people of one enclave Dahagram-Angarpota in Lamonirhat are registered on electoral roll because the dispute over this enclave with India has been resolved.

The EC on May 15 started electoral roll updating programme in around 180 upazilas. The programme will be conducted in rest of the upazilas in phases.

Electoral Symbols

The EC plans to introduce a new system for allocating electoral symbols to the candidates of local government bodies--city corporations, upazila parishads, union parishads and municipalities.

As per the existing system, the commis-

sion has preserved over one hundred electoral symbols exclusively for national election. These symbols are not used in other polls.

But other symbols are used in local government body elections by turns. Now, the EC plans to preserve symbols separately for separate local government polls.

Women's Reserved Seats

The EC yesterday decided to give directives to district election officers for preparing voter list to hold elections to women's reserved seats in upazilas parishads who will be the member of the parishads.

The election to around 127 upazilas may be held after Ramadan, said acting secretary of the EC Secretariat Sirazul Islam.

Torture by Subhan left two

that then they went to their home.

"I hid myself in a bush beside our home as I saw Moulana Subhan and Khoda Bakhs approaching towards our house," said Riaz. "As they [Subhan and his cohorts] didn't find me and my brother, they looted our houses and burnt them down."

Later, Subhan, the Pakistani army and Biharies looted and torched the houses of the Hindu-dominated area in the village, said Riaz.

On the first day of second Bangla month Jaishtha, Subhan, Khoda Bakhs and some Razakars came to Arankhola Cattle Market, and picked his brother and Alauddin from a tea stall and started beating them to know about their arms, said Riaz.

Then, they were taken to a Razakar camp in Iswardi, which was controlled by Khoda Bakhs and subsequently, they were taken to

the Pakistani army camp at Iswardi Rest House, said Riaz.

Following the advice of local people, family members of the victims met Khoda to have the duo released but Khoda asked them to put the request to Subhan, said Riaz.

The witness said the duo were freed later following Subhan's recommendations, and after their release, the victims said Subhan, Khoda, Biharies and the occupation army tortured them.

Both were treated but they became physically disabled and died 10/12 years after the war, said an emotion-choked Riaz.

Subhan's lawyer Shahjahan Kabir asked the witness two questions before the three-member tribunal led by Justice Obaidul Hassan adjourned the proceedings until today when Riaz will face further cross-examination.

students, and introducing a bus stoppage in front of the campus gate.

Meanwhile, Vice Chancellor of Barisal University Prof Md Harunor Rashid Khan said resignation letters of the assistant proctors were not accepted, so they will continue carrying out their duties.

He said each student will be charged Tk 3,000 per session with an additional Tk 500 as transportation fee.

He further said that works for constructing speed humps and boundary walls have started.

The agitating students threatened to boycott classes again and go for other agitation programmes if the decisions are not implemented properly.

On May 29, at least eight students were injured as transport workers swooped on them on the campus following an altercation between a group of students and some transport workers over refusal to drop students in front of the campus and give them a concession in bus fare.

in Karnaphuli River from 3rd Karnaphuli Bridge to Sadarghat Jetty".

The deadline for completing the project was January 2013. Rear Admiral Nizamuddin Ahmed, chairman of CPA, said due to friendly relations between the two countries, the CPA last year extended the timeframe by one year for completing the project, but the firm still failed to do so.

So far, the firm has completed 98 percent work of construction of a jetty and 95 percent work of the embank protection, but over 60 percent of the dredging is yet to be completed, he said.
