

Jamuna devours 200 homesteads, 4 schools

Erosion by the River Jamuna has taken an alarming turn in the last few days, devouring at least 200 homesteads, four schools and a vast tract of cropland in Sadar and Chowhali upazilas of Sirajganj district.

Government Primary school and Beel Mashuka Government Primary School, said Chowhali Upazila Primary Education Officer Md Abdul Khaleque.

Apart from this, seven or eight schools are now under threat of erosion, said the education officer.

Over 100 houses in Chowhali upazila and a vast tract of farmland have gone into the river. Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Abdullah said he urged the Water Development Board

to take immediate steps to protect the area from further erosion.

The river also devoured the boundary wall of the government food godown, the UNO added.

The worst affected villages in Sadar upazila are Bahuka, Balighugri, Paththakuri, Chandnagar and Shuvogasa.

Local Water Development Board (WDB) authorities have been urged to take immediate steps to save the upazilas from the

onslaught of the river.

Expressing deep concern, Md Yeakub Ali, a resident of Balighugri village, said the river is now just 10 metres away from the flood protection dam.

The mighty Jamuna eroded more than 500 acres of farmland in the upazila in the last couple of days, he said.

Contacted, WDB officials said they sought funds from the higher authorities to protect the villages of the two upazilas from the

BOMB ATTACK ON POLICE

12 BCL men among 191 accused held in Bogra

Police arrested 12 leaders and activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) from different areas of Bogra town in connection with Wednesday night's bomb attack that injured seven men including the officer in charge (OC) of Sadar police station at Shatmatha in the town.

Sub-inspector (SI) Aslam Hossain of Sadar police station filed the case against 191 BCL men including 41 named ones with Sadar police station in Bogra on Wednesday night on charge of attack on police, creating obstacle to their conducting official duty and injuring the seven men on Wednesday.

"The 12 arrestees among the accused, all belonging to Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), were sent to jail today [Thursday] noon. Police have continued drives to arrest rest of the accused as zero tolerance will be shown for their attack on law enforcers," said Senior ASP (A Circle) of Bogra Nazir Ahmed Khan.

Earlier on Wednesday evening, two factions of BCL took position at Satmatha in Bogra town for showing strength centring the formation of district, Azizul Haque College and Shah Sultan College unit committees.

At one stage, some people from a group of BCL activists hurled a crude bomb targeting the policemen.

The bomb attack left Bogra Sadar police station OC AHM Foyjur Rahman, Habilder Shajahan Ali, constables Delwar Hossain, Shahrir Hossain, Shaphan Mia and Ashiker Rahman, and local trader Badal Mia injured.

Following the incident, police conducted drives at different places of Bogra town the same night and arrested Alamgir, 27, Don, 24, Bipul, 20, Ansar, 26, Asad, 27, Shamim, 21, Liton, 25, Akramul, 26, Rakib, 21, Ovi, 25, Rahman, 24, and Hashibur, 25, -- all leaders and activists of BCL in Bogra.

The seven injured were immediately sent to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital and their condition is well now.

One brickfield closed, 3 others fined in Rajshahi

Smoke from kilns wreaks havoc on farmland

A mobile court yesterday fined owners of four brick fields in Poba upazila under the district and closed one of those for causing huge losses to agricultural products by emitting black smoke.

The brick field of Abdus Salam at Horian village was closed and the owner fined Tk 50,000 for causing maximum losses to agricultural products while Joynal Abedin, Hasibur Rahman and Alamgir Kabir were fined Tk 40,000 each.

Joynal and Hasibur's brick kilns are at Horian village and Alamgir Kabir's at Kukhandi village.

"Due to black smokes from the brick fields, mangoes borne in almost all the orchards of the two villages got burnt and turned inedible. The banana trees and sugar-

cane plants are also turning yellowish and chilli plants dying," said Poba Upazila Nirbahi Officer Razzakul Islam who led the drive with the assistance of Motihar Police Station of Rajshahi city.

Conducting the raid on the World Environment Day yesterday, the mobile court also warned local officials the Department of Environment for giving Abdus Salam environmental clearance although his brick field does not comply with the necessary condition of setting up kilns within three kilometres of another kiln.

During the raid from 11:00am to 2:00pm, the mobile court found that all the four brick fields were operating without licenses and there were three brick kilns just beside one another at Horian village.

Mofidul Islam Bachchu,

chairman of Harian union parishad, said the brick kiln owners were fined Tk 72,000 a week ago for compensating local growers who suffered losses due to burnt crops and fruits.

'Missing' girl found murdered

Police recovered the decomposed body of a 'missing' madrasa girl from a maize field at Ronsia village in Pirganj upazila of the district on Wednesday.

Daughter of Abdul Quader of the village, Bristhi Khatun, 13, was a Class V student at Ronsia Dakhil Madrasa in the upazila.

On June 1, Bristhi went out of her house to bring cattle and since then she did not return home, said police and family sources.

Locals found her body in the field in the evening and informed the police who sent it to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Criminals might have killed the girl two or three days ago and dumped the body in the area, said Murshidul Karim Mohammad, officer-in-charge of Pirganj police station.

Deceased's father filed a murder case accusing nine people, including his neighbour, said sub-inspector Nazrul Islam of the PS.

Seven rescued from traffickers

Police rescued two women and five children from Dakhin Basudebpur area while they were being trafficked to India through Hili border in Hakimpur upazila on Wednesday morning.

Police also arrested one Nurul Salam, 40, an alleged trafficker.

Locals intercepted a van carrying the women and children near the border at around 11:00am and informed the police.

On information, police went there, arrested Nurul Islam and rescued the

2 schoolgirls killed as train rams van

Two schoolgirls were killed and five others injured as a commuter train hit a school van carrying 11 students at Krittipur level crossing in Jhikargachha upazila of Jessore yesterday.

The deceased are Mohua Khatun, 13, daughter of Khokon Mia of Karim Alivillage, and Mili Khatun, 13, daughter of Habibur Rahman of Gulnagar village of the upazila.

All the victims were class VIII students of Navaran Burujagan Girls' School.

A Jessore-bound commuter train from Benapole hit the vehicle carrying the schoolgirls when it was crossing the level crossing around 1:10pm, leaving Mohua and Mili dead on the spot and five others injured, Mosharraf Hossain, officer in-charge of Jhikargachha Police Station said.

Injured Sumaya, 12, Roksana, 13, Rima, 14, Joba, 13, and Kabita, 12, were admitted to the Jessore Medical College Hospital.

Condition of Rima was stated to be critical, added the OC.

The accident occurred as the level crossing has no gateman for security, said

Two accused in Ataikula killing case remanded

A Pabna court yesterday placed two accused on a tree-day remand in the case for killing four AL men at Pushpopara Bazar in Ataikula upazila on Saturday.

The accused are Md Yunus Ali, 45 and Akkas Ali, 40. Police arrested Yunus Ali from Goyeshpur area of Pabna early Monday and Akkas Ali from Kaliakoir in Gazipur district the same day.

The investigating officer of the case produced the arrestees to the Judicial Magistrate's Court in the afternoon, seeking a 10-day remand. After hearing, Senior Judicial Magistrate Kumar Shipon Modok granted three days' remand.

A gang of criminals opened fire on an AL meeting at Pushpopara Bazar on Saturday night, leaving Abdus Salam, 30, Fazlur Rahman, 32, Sultan Mahamud, 30, and Rafiqul Islam, 36, dead.

Md Johurul Islam, brother of one of the victims, filed a case with Ataikula Police station, accusing 39 people, including Yunus and Akkas. The rest of the accused are still at large.

Fighting all odds, six boys and girls belonging to neglected and marginalised Harijon community in the district have come out successful with good results in the SSC examinations this year.

They are Jhinuk Rani (GPA-4.81), Protima Rani (GPA-4.06), Sikha Rani (GPA-2.69), Priya Rani Biswas (GPA-4.00), Asha Bashphore (GPA-3.61), Cupin Kumar Sarker (GPA-3.25).

"My parents wanted to marry me off at an early age but I remained firm in my

decision to continue study. Now I have got the result of my endeavour," said Jhinuk Rani as tear of joy rolled down from her eyes.

"Earlier schools did not allow admission of Harijan students. Even if a few were allowed enrolment, they were neglected by teachers and fellow students. Now the situation has changed," Cupin Kumar said.

The Harijon people, struggling for ages to claim their rightful place in the mainstream society, now see gradual improvement in their condition, thanks to the initiative of local NGO

FAIR that works with the financial cooperation of Manusher Jonno Foundation.

A group of local people under the banner of Advocacy Group have extended support for the purpose.

Their initiative has already ensured hundred percent schooling for all the children of around 3500 people of the community living in seven 'colonies' at different places of the district.

Now 240 boys and girls of the community are studying in schools and

UP member shot dead in Pabna

Nine sued, chairman arrested

A union parishad (UP) member was shot dead by unidentified assailants at his house in Chatmohar upazila of the district early yesterday.

The deceased, Md Faruque Hossain, 40, was a member of Fajlana Union Parishad and also the general secretary of BNP ward No 2 unit of the union, according to police.

Police arrested Shahjahan Ali, chairman of the union parishad and also the president of BNP Fajlana unit, and his associate Amirul Islam for their alleged involvement in the killing.

Police quoted family sources as saying that a gang of criminals opened fire on Faruque through the window of his house while he was asleep at around 1:00am.

He was admitted to

Pabna Medical College Hospital and then referred to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH) as his condition deteriorated.

Faruque succumbed to his injuries on way to RMCH at around 6:00am, said Officer-in-Charge Subrata Kumar of Chatmohar Police Station. The body was sent to Pabna General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Victim's brother Md Mahabubur Rahman filed a case yesterday with the police station, accusing nine people, including the UP chairman. Police arrested UP chairman Shahjahan and his associate Amirul from their houses at Nengri villages.

Mahabubur Rahman alleged that chairmen Shahjahan's men killed his brother as he protested criminal activities of Amirul, an associate of the chairman.

Bullet-hit body of listed criminal found

Police recovered the bullet-hit body of a listed criminal from a roadside ditch in Kacharitek area in Sadar upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased Md Nayeab Ali, 38, ringleader of a local criminal gang 'Nayeab Bahini' was son of late Sohrab Ali Mondal of Boithakhali village of the upazila.

Sajal Mondal, nephew of the victim, said some unidentified man picked up Nayeab in a microbus from his village home around 2:00am.

Raziur Rahman, sub-inspector Sadar Police Station, said locals spotted the body and informed the police around 6:30am. He received bullet wounds in the head.

The body was sent to the Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, the SI added.
