taking every benefit from Ershad. Mother (Khaleda) and son should be taken on remand in the Ziaur Rahman killing trial and to know their level of involvement in the murder," she said in response to journalists' queries.

Sheikh Hasina, also the ruling Awami League president, made her remarks at a press conference at her official residence Gono Bhaban. The conference was organised to inform the media about the outcomes of her recent six-day visit to China.

Recently at a discussion in Kuala Lumpur of Malaysia, BNP senior vice-chairman Tarique demanded "remand" for Hasina to "crack the mystery" of his father Ziaur Rahman's killing.

Sheikh Hasina also raised question why Khaleda and Tarique did not want to see the corpse of Zia.

Responding to a query about BNP chief's offer for talks, she said, "Mother is talking about dialogue and son is demanding my remand. First, they have to settle what they want actually...I personally phoned her and talked to her. Now with whom will I talk?"

Criticising Khaleda for her bid to resist the January 5 national polls through violence, Hasina said, "She killed hundreds of people to resist the election. Will she return the lives of those victims?"

About talks with Khaleda, the PM reminded the foreign people and organisations, including the European Union, that Khaleda was no longer the opposition leader and she did not have any official status and that they should keep it in mind.

Responding to a query about the construction of a deep-sea port off Cox's Bazar coast, Hasina said her government had received several proposals from different countries. "We will go for the country, which can construct it at the earliest."

When asked that a section of civil and military administration feels that they have brought the Awami League to power, the PM said it was the people who only can determine who would come to power. "An election was held in the country where 40 percent of the people voted, and through their votes we came to power. If anyone casts votes in favour of us and thinks of bringing us power, then I have nothing to say."

The premier termed her China visit successful.

The two ships continuously have a crew of 640. In the last four years, 1,280 crew members served in the UNIFIL MTF.

The speakers said the government has recently issued a notice declaring that CMC hospital will remain a government hospital but the college will be upgraded into an autonomous university. However, the government did not mention which hospital will be affiliated with the university, they added.

Moreover, the government proposal suggests that the university will offer both MBBS and post graduation programmes. But the speakers feared that like Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University, it will be impossible to maintain standard of both the programmes if the medical college becomes a university and will result in closing of CMC, the lone medical college in Chittagong district.

Delwar Majumder, an engineer; Salehuddin Haider Siddique, a lawyer; Obaidul Karim Dulal, a professor of sociology department of Chittagong University; Dr Shushanta Barua, a physician of Chittagong City Corporation Memon Hospital; and Dr Mahfuzur Rahman, convener of the committee, also spoke.

### Rajshahi mango traders

Forhad Hossain said the traders attacked police as they started destroying 20 maunds of treated mangoes (about 80kg).

The agitators also confined five policemen to the Kachari room of Baneshwar land office for half an hour till 7:00pm before senior police officials intervened, said witnesses.

A mobile court led by three magistrates raided Baneshwar Bazar, one of the largest mango markets in Rajshahi, and seized the treated mangoes. In the hour-long drive, the court also fined four mango vendors a total of Tk 18,000. The UNO said the mangoes contained over 3.5ppm of formalin, which is extremely harmful for human body.

After the drive began, around 1,500 mango traders blocked Dhaka-Rajshahi highway at Baneshwar Bazar around 6:00pm and vandalised several vehicles, including a Dhaka-bound coach, said police and witnesses.

The fining of the four sellers angered the traders, and the mobile court did not feel safe to proceed with the raid, said an official of the court, preferring anonymity. Additional police were deployed there to avert violence.

Later, the mobile court moved to Biraldaha market where they fined two mango hoarders—Azahar Uddin and Abu Taher—Tk 50,000 each and damaged some 50 maunds of formalin-laced mangoes. There, they seized stored formalin and sprayers.

Azizul Bari Mukta, president of Baneshwar Bonik Samity, said, "Some traders got angry as they claimed they were not responsible for mixing formalin...the police men were not confined; they were taken to the Kachari ghar for protection from an unwanted situation."
