Govt to issue smart ID cards from next year

Says law minister

The government will start providing the country's citizens with smart identification cards, which will replace the existing national ID cards, from the beginning of next year, Law Minister Anisul Huq told the parliament yesterday.

Replying to a lawmaker's question, Anisul said to provide the smart ID cards, the government undertook a project "Identification System for Enhancing Access", which is being implemented by the Election Commission.

Anisul, also minister in-charge of election commission secretariat in parliament affairs, said the project will be completed on June 30, 2016.
