He left behind two daughters, two sons, and grandchildren.
His first namaz-e-janaza will be held today at 1:30pm at Taqwa mosque on 12/A Dhanmondi in the capital.
He will be buried in Mirpur martyrs intellectuals' graveyard the same day following his second namaz-e-janaza on Bangla Academy premises at 2:30pm.
Many intellectuals like Binoi Kumar Sarkar, Niharranjan Ray and Shubodh Sengupta appreciated his first poetry book published in 1940.
He has over 30 books including Birosh Shonglap (Unpleasant Dialogues, 1969) and Hawa Tomarkee

N'GANJ-7 MURDER CASES Three ex-Rab officials produced before court

IO asked to submit report on Aug 20

A court yesterday ordered the investigation officer to submit the investigation report of Narayanganj seven murders on August 20.
Senior Judicial Magistrate HM Shafiqul Islam of the district asked the investigation officer of the cases, Mamunur Rashid Mondal, to submit the report and directed the jail authorities to produce before it on the same day the 13 persons made accused in two cases filed in connection with the seven murders.
Three former Rapid Action Battalion officers Major Arif Hossain, Lt Col Tareque Sayeed, and Lt Commander MM Rana, who earlier confessed to the killings before the court, were in the dock. The court also relieved the three former Rab officials from the charges under section 54 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as they were shown arrested in the murder cases. Police arrested the three on May 16-18 under this section following a High Court order.
Progress reports on the murders submitted by four probe bodies of Rab, Criminal Investigation Department (CID), the inspector general of police and the High Court had earlier said that no evidence of Rab's involvement in the killing was found. The four probe bodies will have to submit their final investigation reports to the High Court on July 9.

DU celebrates founding anniversary today

Dhaka University is set to celebrate its 93rd founding anniversary today with a series of programmes.
The theme for this year's celebrations is higher education for all to ensure social justice and for economic development, said a press release.
The university has planned a colourful rally, a debate competition and a science exhibition, among other programmes, to observe the day.
Students and teachers of different dormitories will bring out processions on the campus in the morning.
Although no classes will be held today, offices will remain open.
Founded in 1921 with just 847 students in three faculties and 12 departments, the university now has a total of 35,590 students and 1,840 teachers in 74 departments under 13 faculties and 11 institutes.

home of his neighbour Dilbar Sheikh.
"I saw Moulana Subhan Shaheb and Bander Chairman step down from the white car, and Subhan Moulana, along with six/seven Pakistani soldiers, entered Delbar Sheikh's residence and brought him out."
When Subhan saw Aziz, he took him with Delbar and marched west of the village, said the witness, adding that after some time, the army detained Siraj Sheikh at his home.
Apart from the two, Gedan Sarder, Kadu Sheikh, Keta Sarder, Rustam, Majid, Jabbar Sheikh, Taleb Sheikh, Akbar Sheikh, Harun Sheikh, Manik Kha and Utken Sheikh were also picked up the same way and taken to Bharara Shahi Masjid, said the witness.
At one stage, the Pakistani army killed one Kali Kamol of their village, he added.
"We were queued up. Then, I saw a white paper in Subhan Shaheb's hand, and Moulana Subhan read out Delbar's name from the paper. Those whose names were announced [by Subhan] were put in a separate queue," he said.
At one point, as Majid Sheikh responded when his name was called for the third time, the Pakistani army killed him following Subhan's order, said Aziz.
Then, 17 detainees were taken to Pabna in army vehicles, he added.
Aziz said the next afternoon, he heard that Delbar Sheikh and Akbar Sheikh had returned home with injuries while Siraj Sheikh was freed considering his age.
Quoting Delbar, Aziz said the 17 were first taken to Nurpur Power Station, and the next day, 11 detainees were taken to Debottar village and Siraj Sheikh was released at Debottar Bazar.
"The remaining 10 detainees were sprayed with bullets beside a bamboo bush near Debottar Bazar. The Pakistani army opened the fire at the direction of Moulana Subhan," said Aziz, quoting Delbar.
The witness said six detainees were killed on spot, and four including Delbar were injured, and they died after a few days. He, however, did not tell about the fate of the remaining detainees.
After his testimony, Subhan's lawyer Mizanul Islam completed his cross-examination with a suggestion that the witness gave a "false testimony being tutored", which Aziz denied.
The three-member tribunal led by Justice Obaidul Hassan adjourned the proceeding till July 8.
ICT-1
The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday asked a prosecutor to submit the formal charges against fugitive war crimes suspect Syed Md Hassan Ali on August 5.
The three-member tribunal Chairman Justice M Enayetur Rahim fixed the date after prosecutor Abul Kalam Azad sought time to prepare the charges.
Hassan faces allegations of involvement in crimes against humanity in Tarail upazila of Kishoreganj.
The tribunal yesterday also deferred till August 31 the delivery of the order on a contempt petition filed against Fakhrul Islam, a lawyer for convicted BNP leader Salauddin Quadir Chowdhury.
Meanwhile, the defence counsel yesterday continued cross-examining the investigation officer SM Idris Ali of the war crimes case against Jamaat leader ATM Azharul Islam.

The Vehicle Theft and Recovery Database will gather details and police records of the theft vehicles and help the owners recover their vehicles, said Babul Akter, additional deputy commissioner (Detective Branch) of CMP.
Besides, CMP has beefed up security measures in the city during the month of Ramadan, said Mahmuda Begum, assistant commissioner (headquarters) of CMP, adding that mobile teams of police had been increased in the city's important points and areas where shopping malls were located.

He said the students were suspended for violating academic discipline.
The authorities also formed a six-member probe committee led by syndicate member Prof Md Hanif to delve deep into the affairs.
The committee has been asked to submit a report within next four weeks, said Prof Akhtaruzzaman.
BU Vice-chancellor Prof Dr Harunor Rashid said stern disciplinary action would be taken against the troublemakers on the basis of the probe committee report and replies of show-cause notices issued against the accused.
On June 7, BU Estate Officer Saiduzzaman lodged the case with Kotwali Police Station, accusing the above mentioned ones and 50 others unnamed.
