

Two banned Hizb ut-Tahrir activists held with leaflets

Police yesterday arrested two activists of outlawed Hizb ut-Tahrir from Mendibag area of Sylhet city while they were distributing leaflets.

The arrested are Syed Tanvir Hasan alias Shifak of Lakshmi Narayanpur village in Begumganj upazila of Noakhali and former student of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology and Sadikul Islam, a first year MBBS student of Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College.

Two online journo held for 'extortion'

Police detained two online journalists while "demanding extortion" from a drug store in the capital's Mirpur yesterday.

Arrested Golam Mostafa, 36, claimed himself as the editor of online portal "crimenewsbd.com" while Ruman Chowdhury, 40, identified himself as a senior correspondent of the portal.

Sub-inspector Pradip Kumar Saha of Mirpur Police Station said the two took away one carton of medicine worth around Tk 5,000 from Genial Unani Laboratories at Kolarapara of Mirpur-1 on Saturday terming the drugs "adulterated".

Around 4:00pm yesterday, the two persons went to the drug store again and demanded Tk 50,000 from its owner Abdur Rashid over the phone and said that they found the drugs "adulterated by laboratory tests." The duo also threatened to publish reports if they were not given the demanded money, said the police officer.

On information, police rushed to the store and detained them with their motorcycle.

2 held with smuggled gold

Two persons were detained with 20 gold bars weighing around 7.7 kilogrammes at the capital's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport yesterday morning.

Shahnur Alam and Monjurul Haque came from Malaysia and Dubai respectively.

On a tip-off, customs officials searched Shahnur and found six gold bars, weighing 6kg, inside his socks, said Shampriti Pramanik, assistant commissioner of the airport customs.

Afterwards, Monjurul was detained with 14 gold bars, weighing 1.7kg, said the Customs Intelligence Deputy Commissioner Mustafizur Rahman.

Jamaat man held with gun in Ctg

Police arrested two persons, including a Jamaat-e-Islami activist, in separate incidents and seized arms and ammunition from their possession in Chittagong yesterday.

The arrestees are Jamaat man Kamal Uddin alias Dari Kamal and Nurul Alam alias Nuru.

On information that a gang of about 11 miscreants gathered in Sluice Gate area of Satkania upazila, a police team rushed to the area. However, sensing presence of the law enforcers, the miscreants opened fire on them triggering a gunfight, said police.

Kamal with a bullet injury in his right leg was arrested on the spot. Police seized a locally-made rifle and six rounds of bullet from the spot.

Kamal is accused in 14 cases.

Meanwhile, Nuru was arrested in Ispahani Rail Gate area of the port city while he along with about six others was preparing to commit robbery, said police.

Police seized a locally-made light gun, a single-barrel sawn-off rifle and five rounds of cartridges from the pot. Nuru is accused in several cases for land grabbing, extortion and carrying out subversive activities.

Zainul Abidin Farroque, also former opposition chief whip.

He came down hard on Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu for his alleged remarks that Khaleda had to be removed from the politics as she was a patron of militancy and Razakar.

"Inu can make such comment as he had fought against Sheikh Mujibur Rahman by forming Gono Bahini. He also 'removed' many people," Fakhruddin alleged.

The BNP leader also warned that the government would have to face dire consequence if anything happens to Khaleda Zia.

He urged the government to hold a fresh election under a non-party administration showing respect to the aspirations of the country's people.

Narrating the "brutal" attack on Farroque by police, he said the attack was not on any individual, rather it was on parliament.

But the government is yet to take any action against the responsible policemen, he added.
