PHULCHHARI, SAGHATA UPAZILAS IN GAIBANDHA Jamuna erosion makes 350 families homeless

Erosion by the River Jamuna took an alarming turn in the last three days, rendering at least 350 families in different areas under Phulchhari and Saghata upazilas homeless.

The affected areas are Uttar Digholkandi, Patilbari in Saghata upazila and old Phulchhari, Kaiyer Haat, Balashi, Singria, Ratanpur and Katlamari in Phulchhari

upazila.

The erosion-hit people have taken shelter on the embankment and roads, said Jainul Abedin, chairman of Fazlupur Union Parishad.

Patilbari flood shelter and Digholkandi Bazar have been badly affected due to the erosion.

The mighty Jamuna also eroded a number of homesteads and a vast tract of cropland during the period.

Flood control dyke at Ratanpur and Digholkandi Bazar are facing serious erosion threat, said locals.

The shop owners shifted their structures to safer places, fearing further onslaught by the river, said the market committee.

They urged the upazila nirbahi officer to take immediate steps to thwart the erosion, said the UP chairman.

'Missing' boy found dead

Police recovered the body of a 'missing' schoolboy from a jute field at Balarampur village in Tala upazila yesterday morning. The dead is Jahid Moral, son of farmer Shariful Moral of the village and a student of Class VI at Islamkati Parbatinath Secondary School. He remained missing since Monday. Locals found his body in the field and informed the police who sent it to Sathkira Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy. The body bore several injury marks, said Abu Bakkar Siddique, officer-in-charge of Tala Police Station.

70,440 chocolate bombs seized

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) seized at least 70,440 chocolate bombs from Phulbari upazila yesterday morning. However, none was arrested in this connection, said an official of BGB-40 Battalion. On secret information, the BGB men raided Krishnapur village and seized the chocolate bombs worth Tk 3.65 lakh, said Lt Col Zahidur Rashid, commanding officer of the battalion.

Man hacked to death

Police recovered the body of an unidentified man, aged about 60, from Thakurtak village of Sirajganj Sadar upazila yesterday morning. Md Habibur Islam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said locals found his body in the area beside Sirajganj-Mulibari bypass and informed the police who sent it to Sirajganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy. He was hacked to death, said the OC. The reason behind the killing could not be known immediately, he said.

Kid drowns in pond

A child drowned in a pond at Naduria village in Atghoria upazila on Wednesday afternoon. The dead is Md Abdullah, 3, son of Shentu Miah of the village. Locals said Abdullah accidentally fell into the pond near their house while playing on its bank and drowned. Later, family members recovered the body from the water.

Man gets life for killing wife

A Sirajganj court on Wednesday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for killing his wife for dowry in 2010. The lifer is Haider Ali, son of Jadab Ali, of Puma village in Raiganj upazila. According to the prosecution, Haider strangled his wife Asma Khatun following an altercation over dowry on March 29, 2010. Later a case was filed with Raiganj Police Station, accusing Haider in this connection. After investigation, police submitted charge sheet against Haider on August 31 the same year. After examining witnesses and evidence, Sirajganj Additional District and Sessions Judge Fazle Miah found him guilty and pronounced the verdict.

Three electrocuted

Three people were electrocuted and two others injured in Sadar upazila yesterday morning. The deceased are Sabbir Hossain Rahman Shuvo, 18, son of Mozibar Rahman, Mosaddeque Hossain, 45, son of Mozammel Hoque and Sadequul Islam, 18, son of Mofizur Rahman of Kismat Madhabpur village. Police said the five came in contact with an electric pole in the morning. Of them, the trio died on the spot. Injured Md Mofizur Rahman, 40, and Sohana Akter Mitu, 17, were admitted to Dinajpur Medical College and Hospital.

ASSAULT ON COLLEGE TEACHERS

Colleagues demand arrest of culprits

Teachers of Nasirabad University College in the district town yesterday demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the culprits who attacked their three colleagues, including the principal, on Monday.

The demand was made at a press conference organised by Shikkhakh Parishad, a teachers' forum of the college, at the auditorium of Mymensingh Press Club.

On Monday afternoon, a gang of 7/8 entered the

college campus and started catching fishes in a pond.

As Principal Md Ashraf Uddin and two other teachers--Masum Billah and Moudud Ahmed--asked them to stop fishing and leave the campus, the gang physically assaulted them.

Before leaving the scene, they threatened the teachers with dire consequences if they filed any complaint with the police station concerned in this regard, said the speakers at the press conference.

Although a case was filed with Sadar Police Station in connection with the attack,

police are yet to arrest the culprits, the teachers of the college alleged.

College teachers Sheikh Amjad Ali, Md Jalal Uddin, Manik Lal Saha, Reazul Katim, Lutfur Rahman, Azharul Islam and ATM Shafiqul Islam, among others, spoke.

Earlier on Tuesday, the teachers and employees of the college formed a human chain in the town, demanding immediate arrest to the attackers.

They also submitted a memorandum to the deputy commissioner and police superintendent, demanding immediate arrest of the culprits.

Land disputes leave 2 dead

Two people were killed over land disputes in Bogra and Rangpur districts yesterday and the day before.

Our Bogra correspondent reported that a young man was stabbed to death by his uncle during an altercation between his two cousins over a disputed land at Partekur Northpara in Shahjahanpur upazila of the district yesterday morning.

The deceased was identified as Md Arafat, 24, son of Chand Mia.

Police quoted locals as saying that there was a long-standing dispute between Mirajul Howlader, 25, and his brother

Abdul Malek Howlader, 27.

Malek and Mirajul locked in an altercation over planting trees on the disputed land at around 7:30am. As their nephew Arafat tried to pacify the both, Mirajul stabbed him.

Locals rushed Arafat to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital (SZMCH), where the doctors declared him dead.

In Rangpur, a man was killed by his younger brother following a feud over a piece of land at Madhabpur village under Rangpur Sadar upazila on Wednesday, reports our correspondent.

The deceased was identified Shekander Ali Badsha, 57, son of late Shahjahan Mia of the village.
