

# RIVALRY OVER EXTORTION Swechchhasebak League goon killed by BCL goons

## At RU, two leaders attack each other

A hired goon of Swechchhasebak League in Sylhet city was killed by the hired goons of Bangladesh Chhatra League in Akhalia area on Monday night because of rivalry over collecting extortion money from the easy bike stand at Madina market.

Police said the deceased, Abdullah Alias Kochi, 22, was a carpenter.

His rivals, Gulzar Ahmed and Sumon Talukder, who are locally known as BCL goons, stabbed him and his friend Sunny near Dhobabari bridge around 9:30pm before fleeing, said local shop owners who witnessed the incident.

The two were taken to Osmani Medical College Hospital where Kochi was declared dead.

Kochi was a follower of the city unit Swechchhasebak League publicity secretary

Imran Ahmed, said residents of the area and the city BCL general secretary Emrul Hasan.

Police said they were trying to arrest the killers.

Meanwhile, two BCL leaders were injured at Rajshahi University yesterday as they attacked each other following an altercation.

The reason of the conflict was not known immediately.

Vice president Atikur Rahman and organising secretary Kawser Ahmed Kaushik were hospitalised, and both declined to comment.

They had a heated exchange in front of Madar Bux Hall in the afternoon. At one point, Kaushik hit Atik with an iron rod in the head, and in retaliation, Atik stabbed him in the back.

Police rushed in and took them to hospital.

## Tarique's personal secy denied bail again

A Dhaka court yesterday again rejected a bail petition of Mia Nur Uddin Apu, personal secretary to BNP Senior Vice-Chairman Tarique Rahman, in an extortion case.

Earlier on June 18, Apu surrendered before the same court and sought bail in the case, but the court rejected his bail and sent him to jail.

Amin Ahmed, proprietor of Al Amin Construction Company Ltd, filed the case on December 30, 2006 against Tarique and Apu on charge of extorting over Tk 1 crore from him. Following this, Tarique was arrested on March 7, 2007 but later got bail in the case.

which is a central element of the UN human rights machinery, Prof Rahman said Bangladesh should let in UN's special rapporteurs, who visit different countries and report on human rights issues there.

Before the discussion, Sayeed Ahmed of the Human Rights Forum said there were only two visits of special rapporteurs in the last 10 years while nine requests of visits were awaiting response.

Sadia Muna Tasneem, director general (UN and Human Rights) of the foreign ministry, however, said the government was never in denial, and it would try to let in one rapporteur every year.

Dina M Siddiqi, professor of Brac University, and Ranjan Karmakar, executive director of Steps Towards Development (STD), also spoke.

Meanwhile, in Chittagong, cultural activists, journalists, and general people formed a human chain in front of Chittagong Press Club under the banner Sacheton Nagorik Samaj, calling the killings by Israel genocide.

The court ordered the government to set up chemical test units at all land and sea ports in six months and to release the imported fruits from the ports after chemical tests to make sure that no chemical-laced fruits can enter the land.

The HC issued the directives in a full judgement released yesterday. The verdict came on February 29, 2012 following a writ petition filed by Human Rights and Peace for Bangladesh to stop the use of chemicals in fruits.

The petitioner's counsel Manzill Murshid told The Daily Star that it was possible to stop the use of chemicals in fruits if the HC directives were followed properly. He also said the government had set up food courts in every district to deal with the cases filed for adulteration of food, but those courts had not become functional, as food analysts, who are supposed to file cases, had not been appointed yet.

In the verdict, the HC asked police to deploy personnel at mango

orchards (commercial) in Rajshahi and in major harvesting areas to stop the use of chemicals to ripen mangoes.

It ordered the authorities to monitor fruit markets and warehouses through surveillance committees in every month all over the country to check sales of chemical-laced fruits.

The government has been asked to issue a circular to take legal steps against such practice and to ensure that the perpetrators will be indicted.

The HC bench of Justice AHM Shamsuddin Choudhury Manik and Justice Jahangir Hossain also directed the government to prepare guidelines to stop the use of chemicals in ripening fruits in six months and circulate the guidelines to the local administrations.

"...the petitioner brought the allegation against the respondents (official concerned of the government) that they have failed to take necessary measures against some corrupted-businessmen who used to ripen fruits by using chemical which are abso-

team, which filed the contempt petition, attended the proceedings on the HRW.

On July 15, 2013, the tribunal-1 sentenced Ghulam Azam to 90 years in jail for crimes against humanity and genocide during the Liberation War.

A month later, on August 16, the HRW posted an article on its website claiming that Azam's trial was "deeply flawed" and "had not met international standards".

It also said the "judges had improperly conducted an investigation on behalf of the prosecution" and expressed worries over "collusion and bias among prosecutors and judges".
